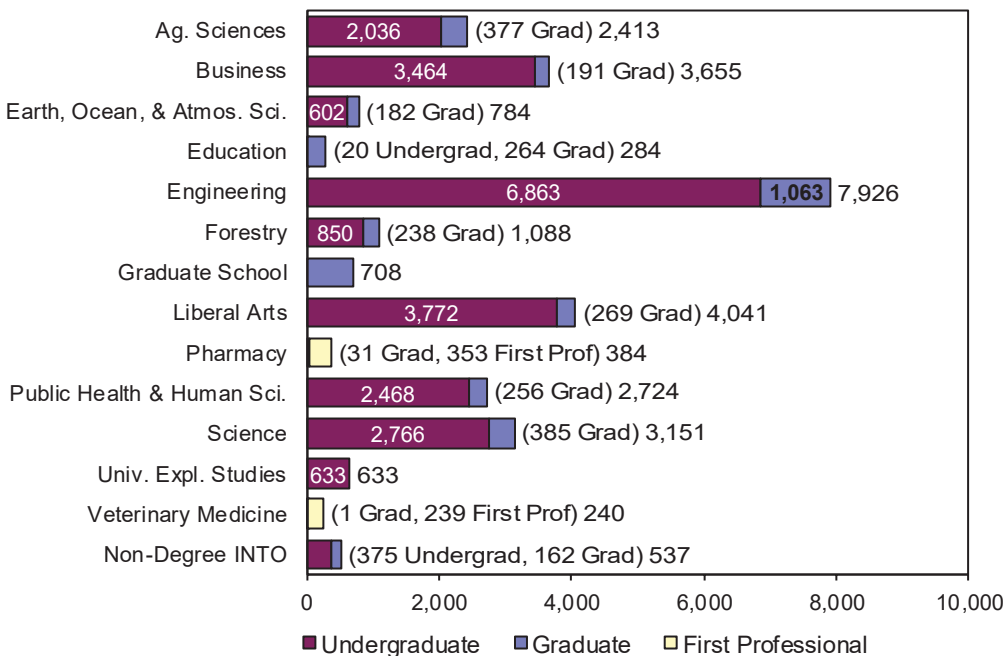

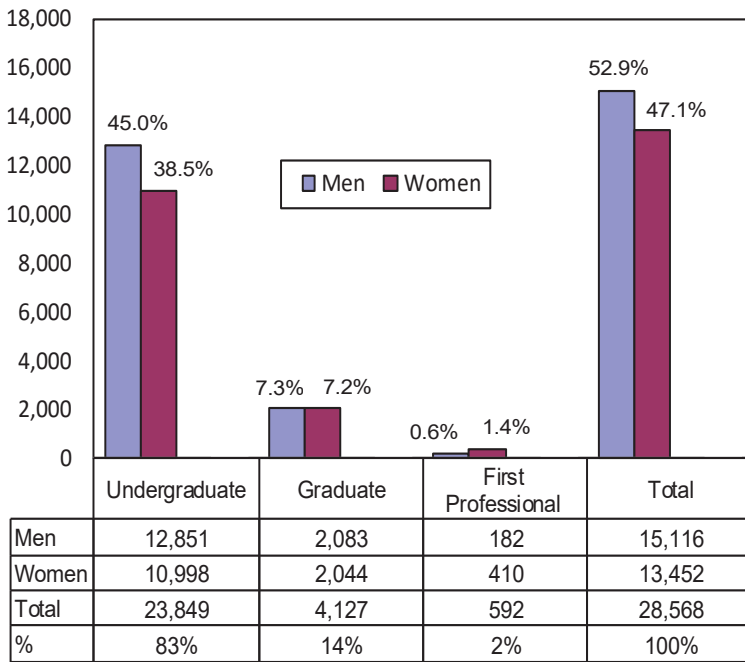

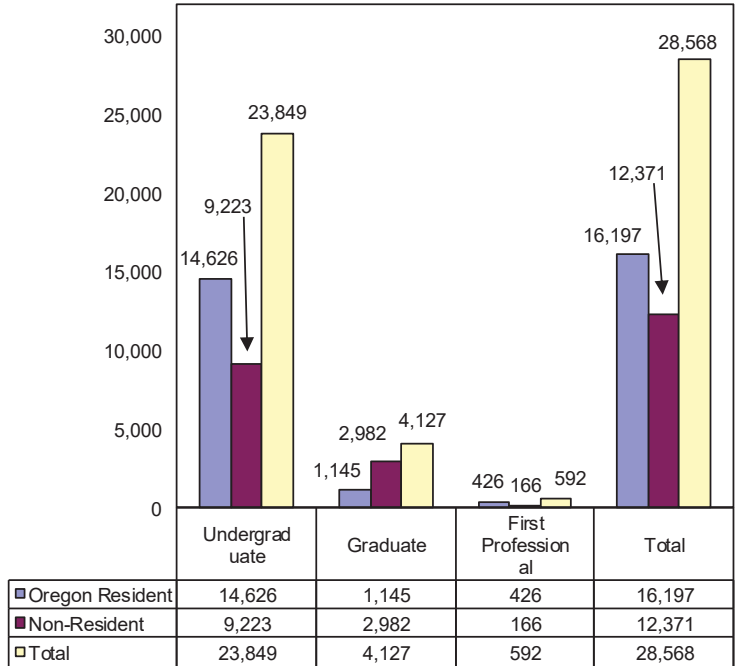

By Residency* and Student Level

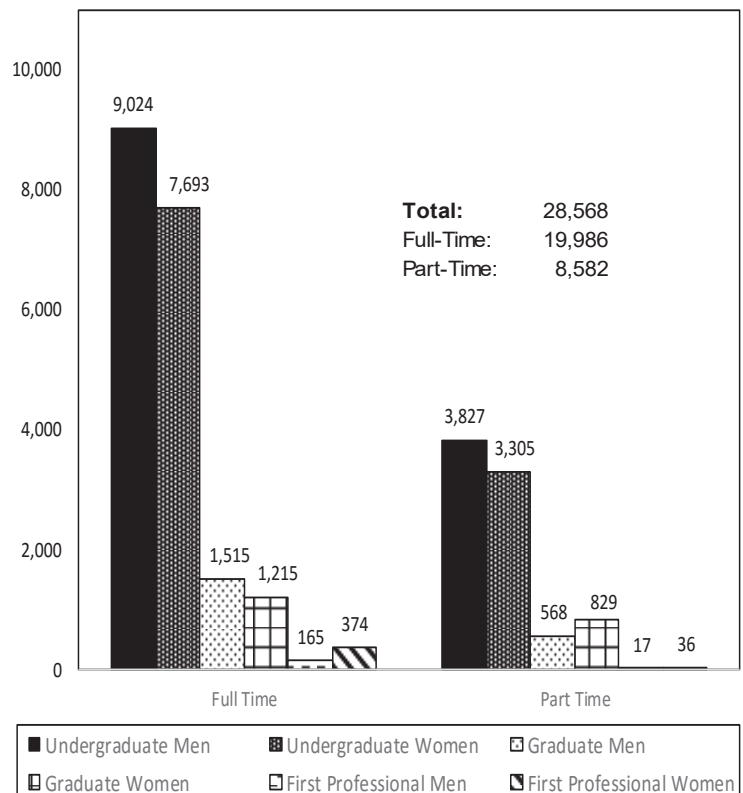

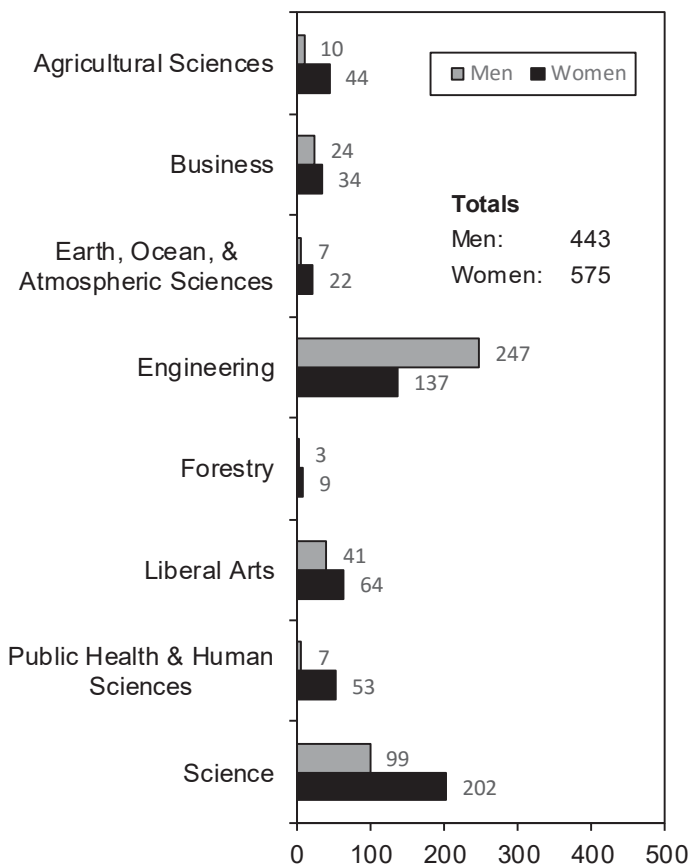

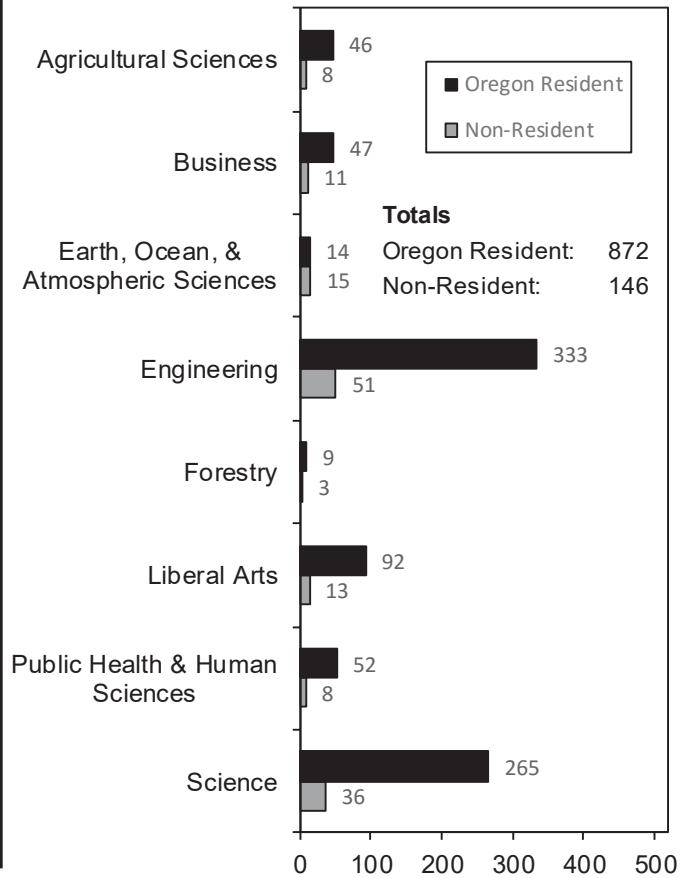

Highlights

■ When Spring 2017 and Spring 2018 are compared, the total enrollment increased by 487 students, or 1.7% (from 28,081 to 28,568). At the same time, the total student FTE increased by 308.7, or 1.3% (from 23,570.4 to 23,879.1), and the student credit hours increased by 4,245, or 1.3% (from 333,977 to 338,222).

■ When compared to Spring 2017, the undergraduate enrollment increased by 283 students, or 1.2% (from 23,566 to 23,849); the graduate enrollment increased by 4.3% (from 3,957 to 4,127); the first professional enrollment increased by 6.1% (from 558 to 592).

■ When compared to Spring 2017, Oregon residents decreased by 2.1%; non-residents increased by 10.9%.

■ International student enrollment decreased by 1.6%.

■ For Spring 2018, the percentage of U.S. minority students was 24.8% of the total enrollment. The number of minority students increased by 4.4% when compared to Spring 2017 (from 6,772 to 7,073).

■ The College of Engineering, College of Liberal Arts, and College of Business had the largest student enrollments (7,926, 4,041, and 3,655 respectively) when compared to the other academic units.

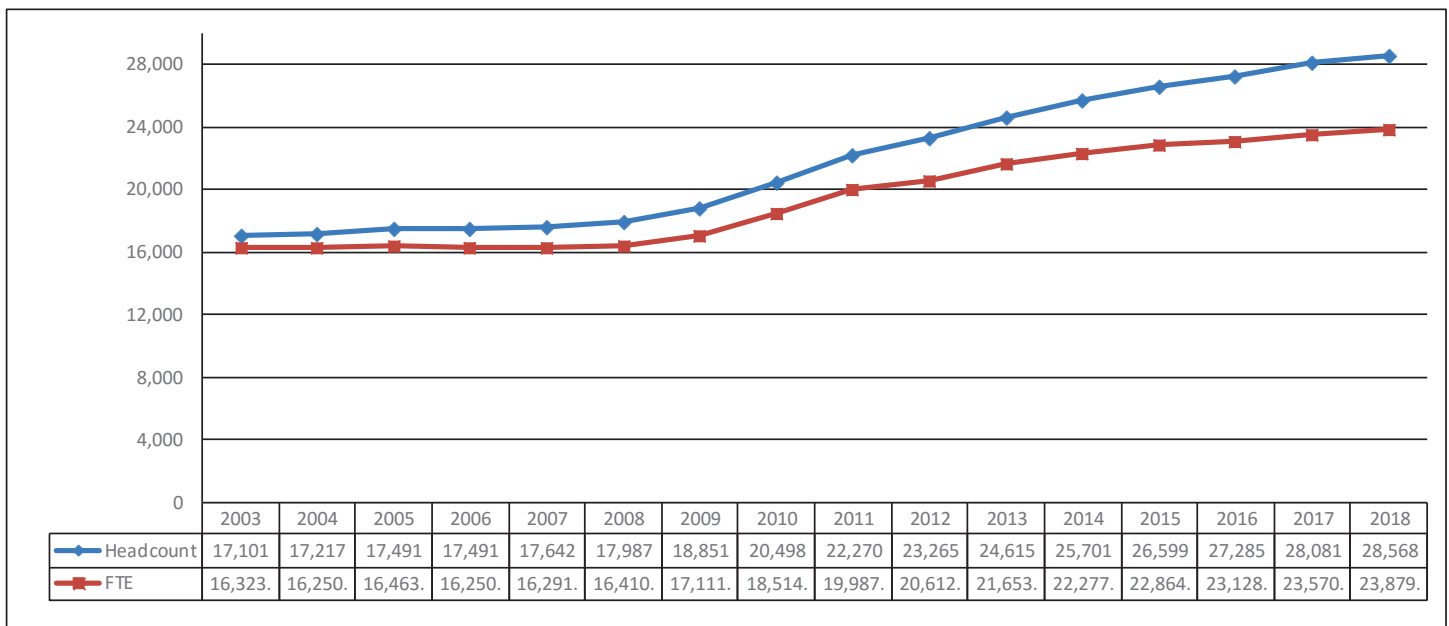
■ OSU Extended Campus had 14,151 students, an increase of 13.4% compared to Spring 2017. These students took 78,805 credits, of which 29.1% were from the College of Liberal Arts, while 16.9% were from the College of Agriculture.

■ During Spring 2018, a total of 1,117 students received services from OSU Cascades Campus.

■ Other increases that occurred when comparing Spring 2017 and Spring 2018 are as follows:

- Part-time students: 5.1%
- Full-time students: 0.4%
- Female students: 2.6%
- Male students: 1.0%
