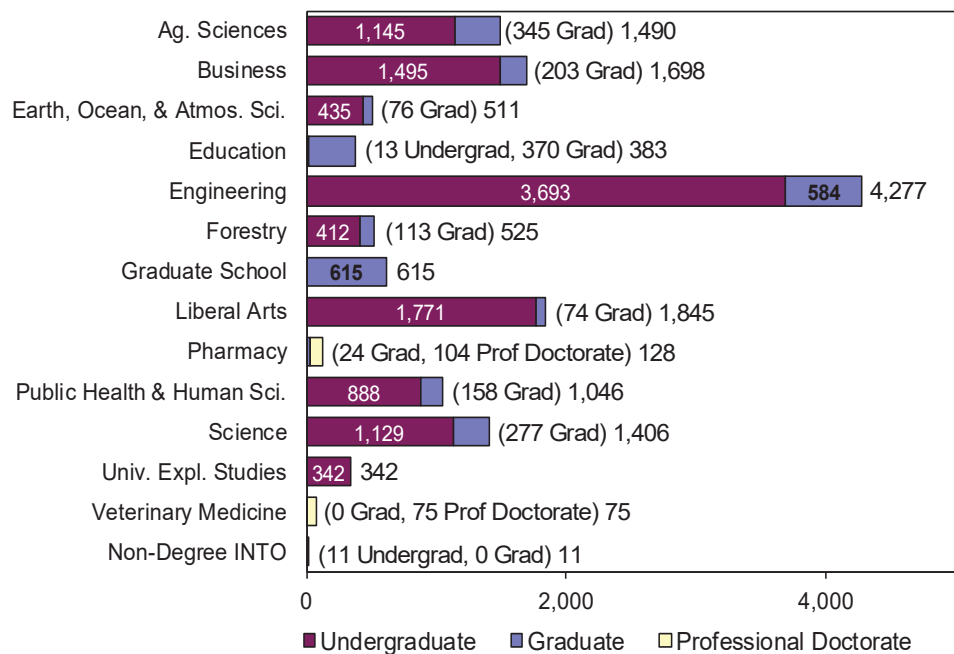

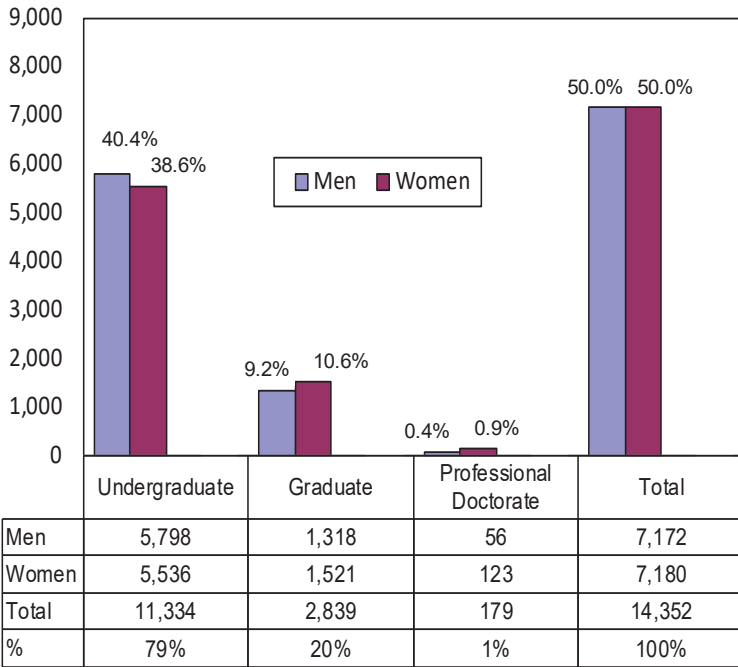

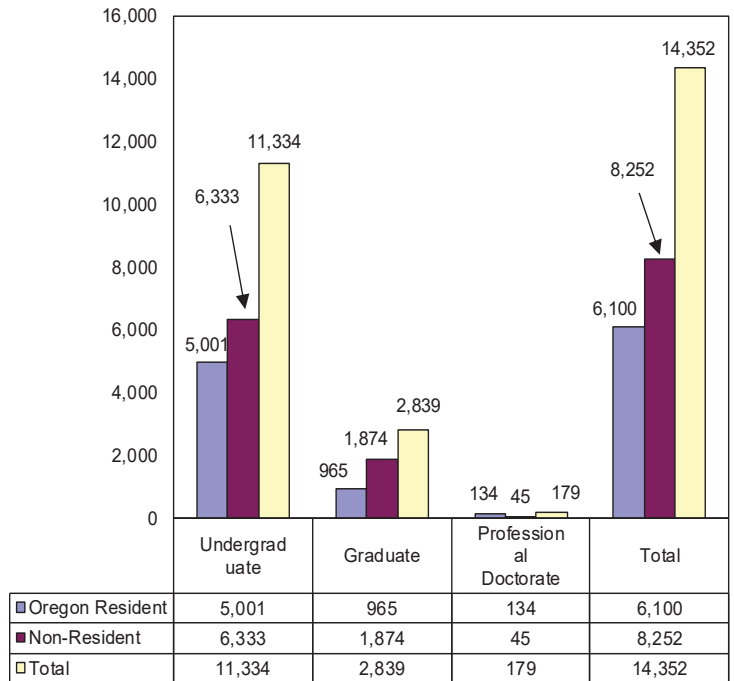

Enrollment by Sex—Binary and Student Level

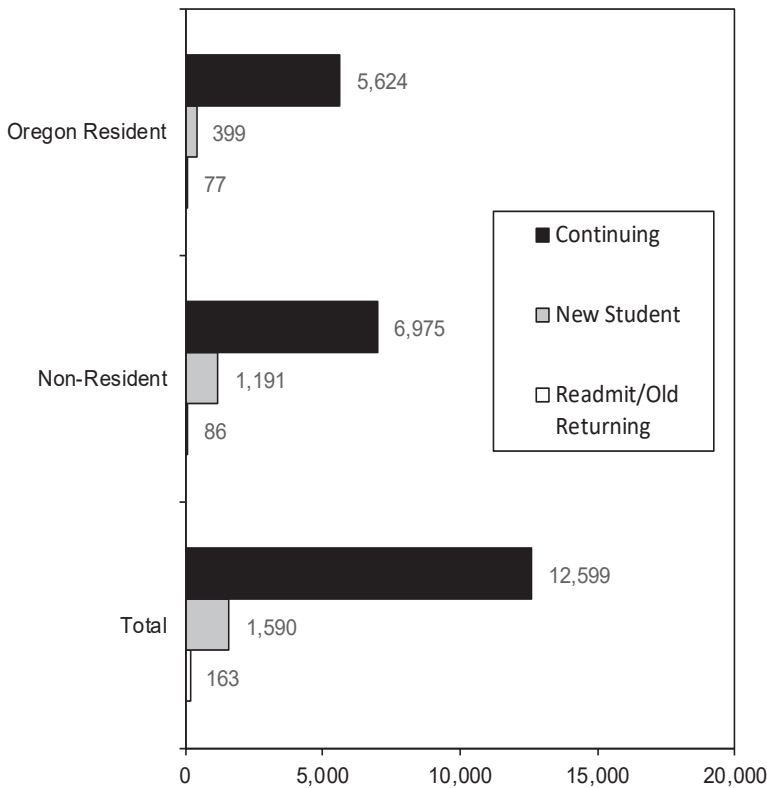


By Residency* and Student Level



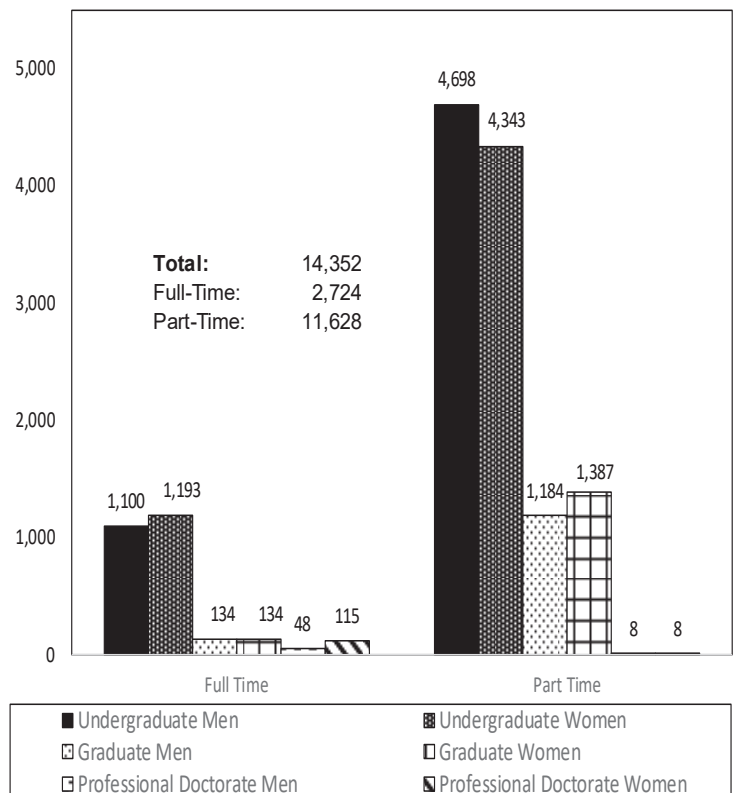

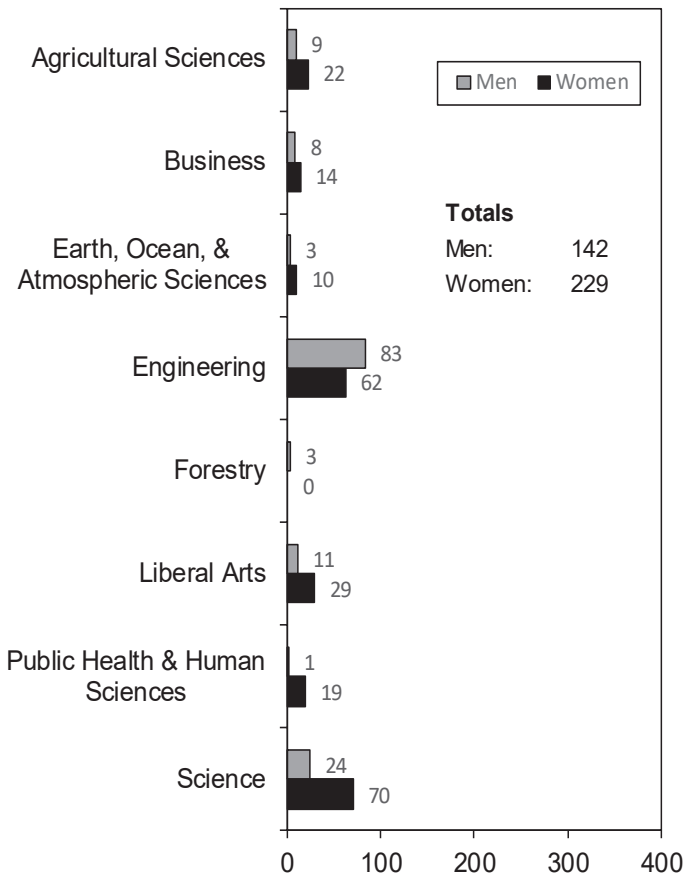

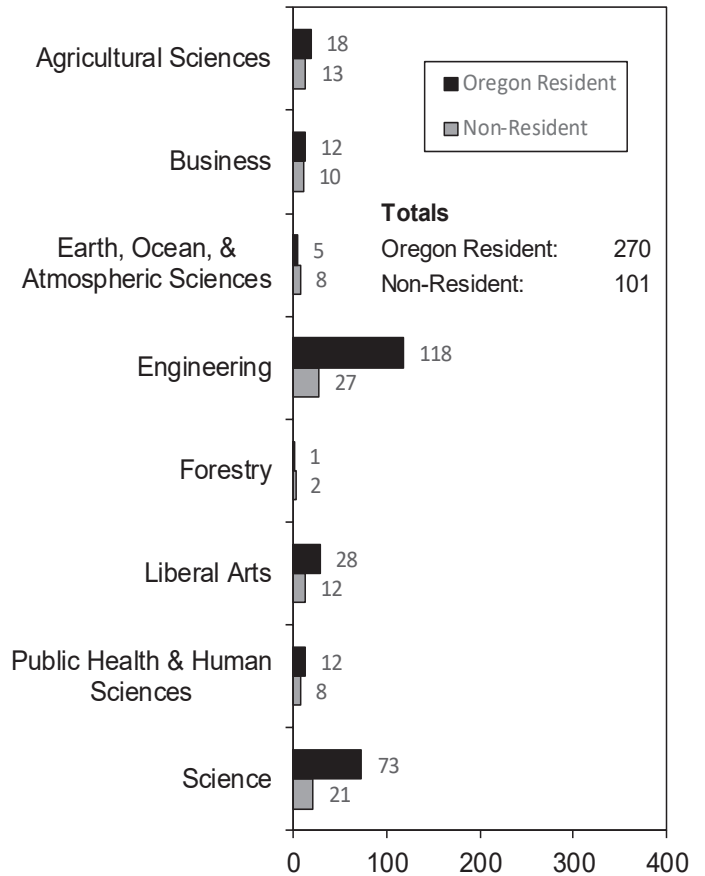

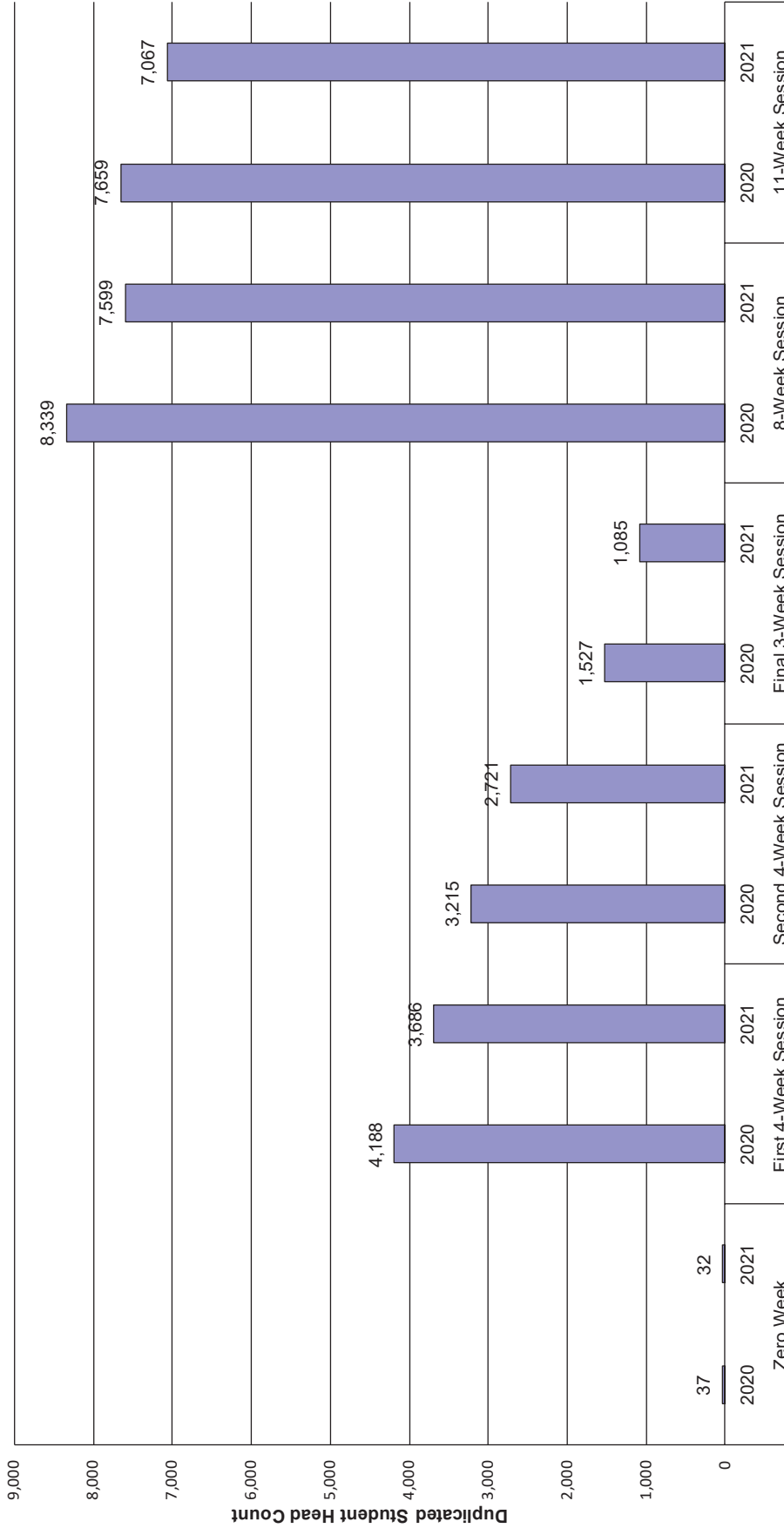

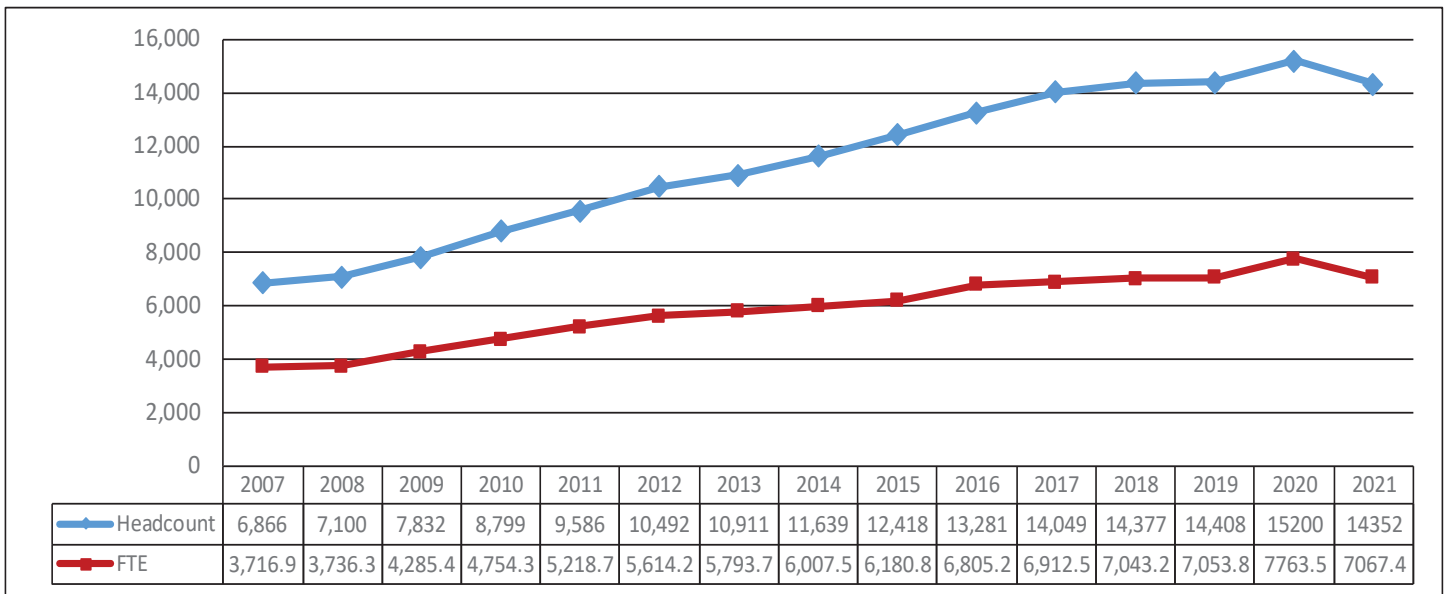

Highlights

- Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Summer Term courses were offered by remote access.
- Main Campus headcount enrollment fell by 5.6% compared to last Summer, with FTE declining by 9.0%.
- OSU Cascades also saw a 34.4% decrease in headcount as well as a 27.2% decrease in FTE.
- College of Engineering continues to be the largest college – nearly 30% of headcount
