

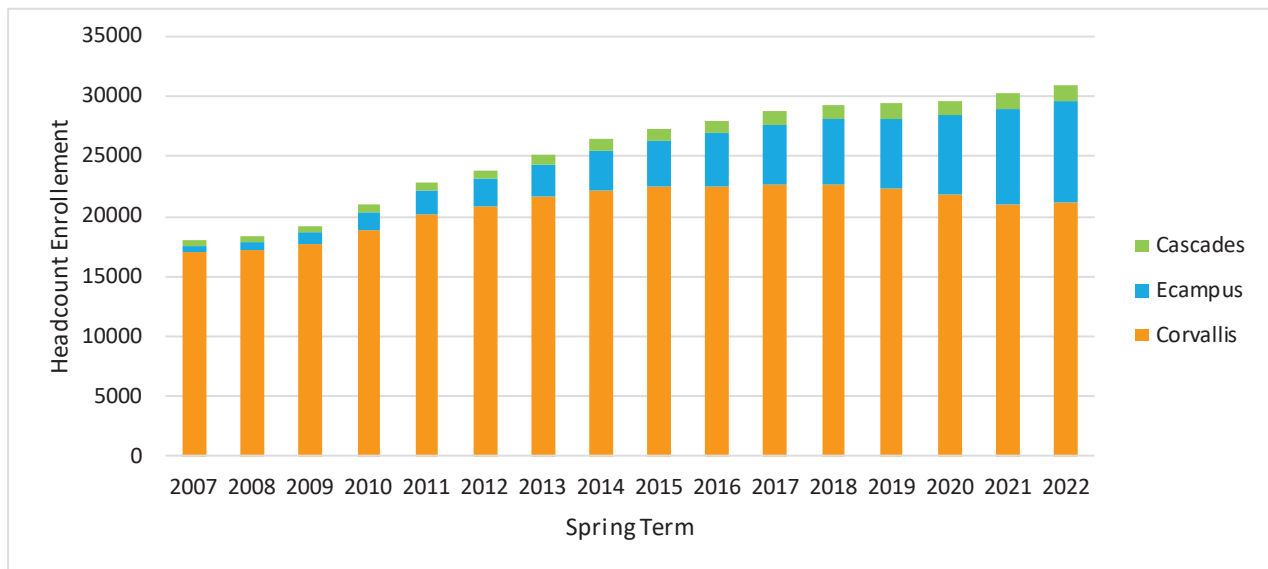

Headcount Enrollment: Main (two largest components)\* and Cascades



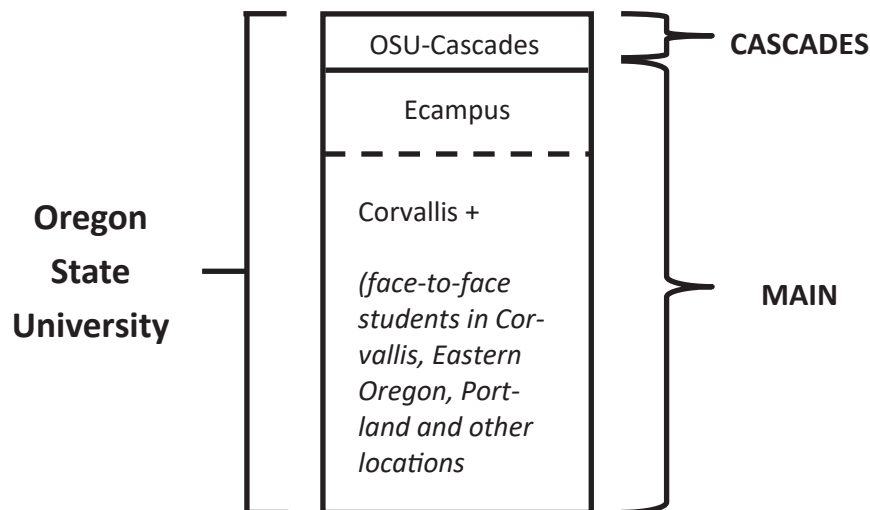

## Two Reporting Campuses for Oregon State University

- **MAIN**
- **CASCADES**

Historically, OSU has been funded by the state as a single entity. When the OSU-Cascades campus was established in 2001, the state funded it as a separate line item. This required reporting OSU-Cascades enrollments separately from all other enrollments, both to the state and to the federal IPEDS data system.

### OSU Reporting Campus Breakdown



We don't typically report total Oregon State University numbers. "Main" is usually quoted when giving OSU numbers. We do not use "OSU-Corvallis" in standard enrollment reporting.

Headcounts are based on student course registration, not student primary campus. OSU-Cascades students also taking Ecampus courses appear in counts for both Main and Cascades. For this reason, OSU's total enrollment cannot be calculated by adding Main and Cascades headcounts.

### Student Credit Load Terms

Undergraduates making full-time progress towards their bachelor's degree typically take 15 credits per term. We break up total credits in segments of this amount to indicate counts of full-time equivalents. For undergraduates, 15 credits = 1.0 FTE. For master's and professional doctorates, 12 credits = 1.0 FTE. For doctoral students, 9 credits = 1.0 FTE.

Full-time status is a characteristic of individual student credit load. A minimum value indicates whether the student credit load meets university and financial aid requirements for full-time enrollment. Undergraduates are considered "full-time" if they are enrolled in 12 or more credits.

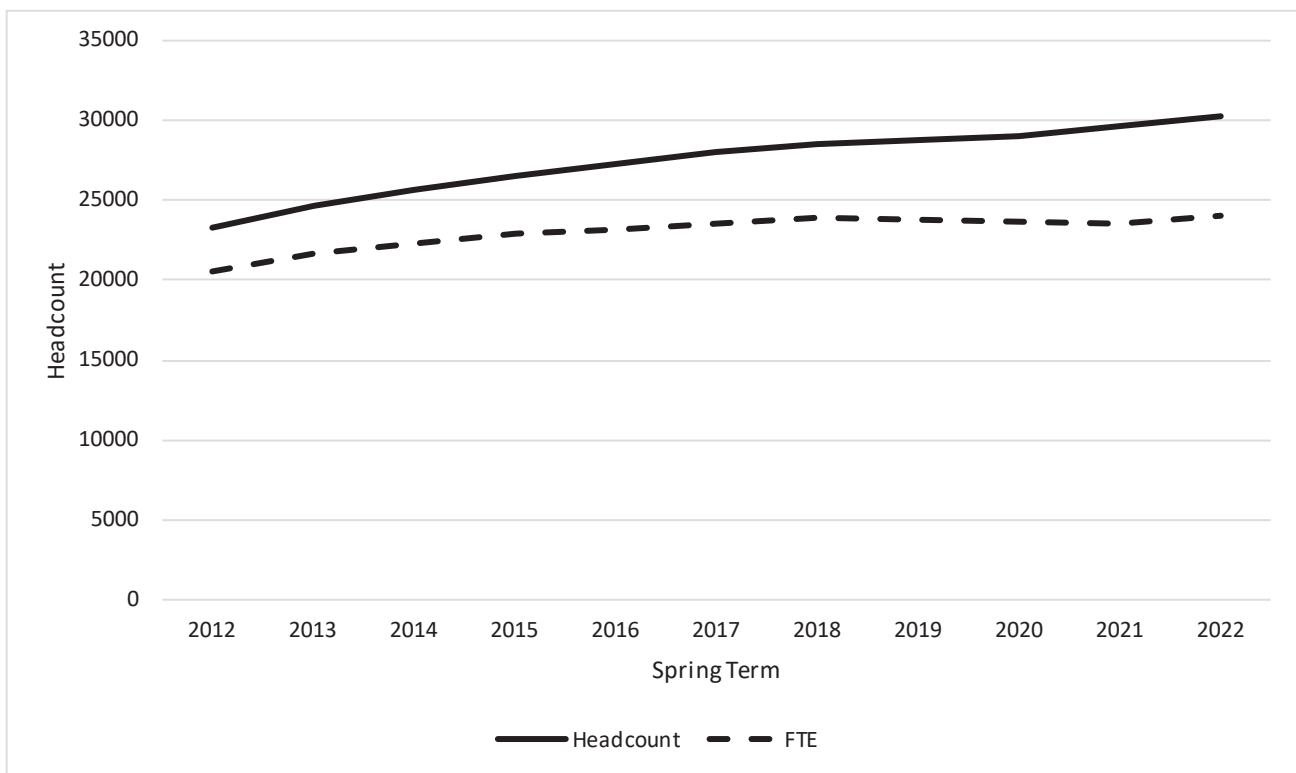

- *Main Campus FTE flattening out as on-line students become larger proportion of enrollments; on-line students tend to take fewer credits*
- *Tuition revenue and state apportionment are proportional to FTE not headcount*

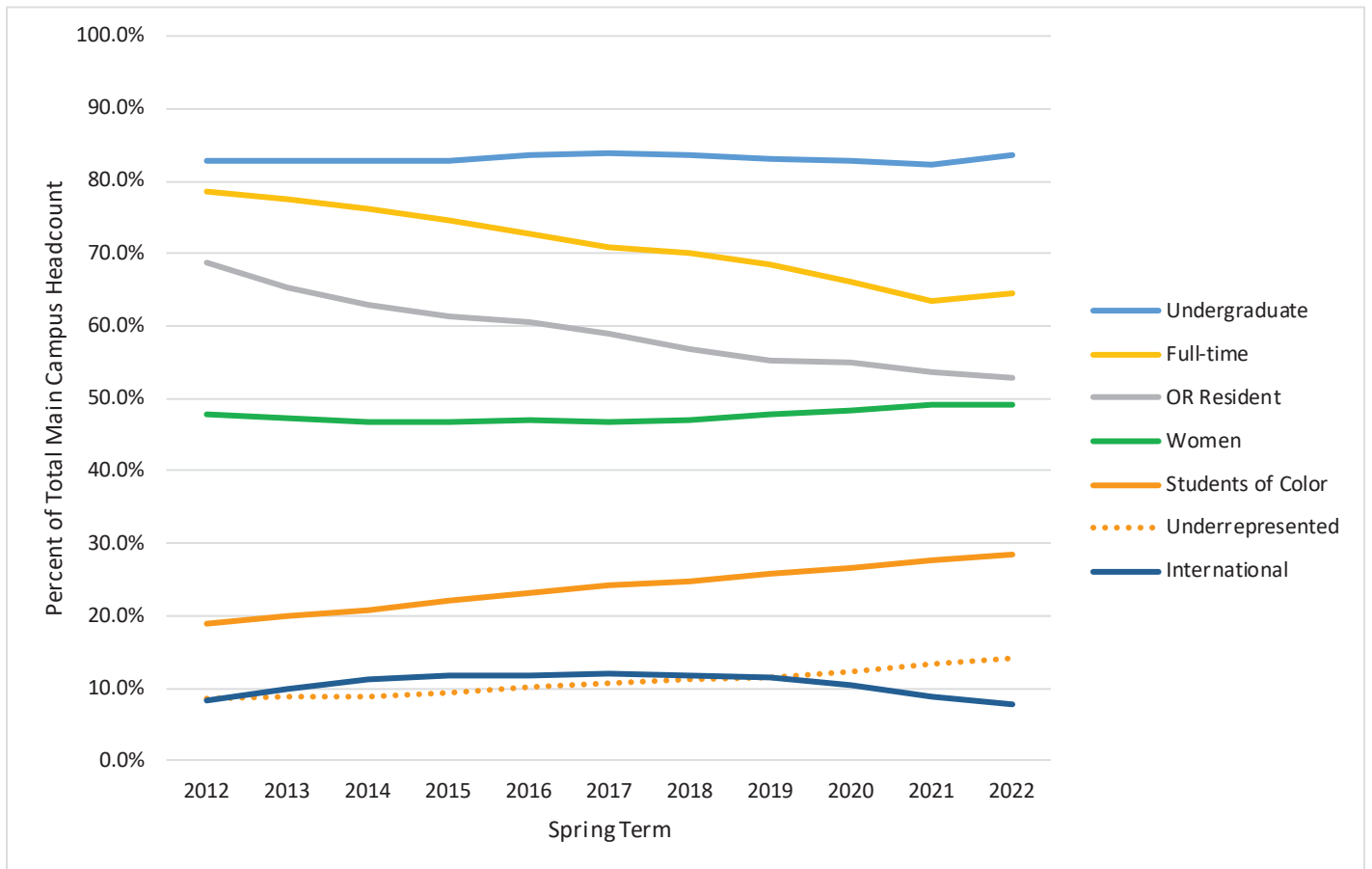

**10 Year Trend: Demographic Percentage of Total Main Campus**



- ***Undergraduate Enrollment proportion grew slightly, bucking a longer term slight decline***
- ***A drop in Oregon Resident percent primarily reflect the growth of our nationally ranked on-line program (Ecampus)***
- ***OSU is slightly different from national rates where women are typically the majority of college enrollments; this may reflect OSU's STEM majors which tend to have fewer women***
- ***Percent of Students of Color and Underrepresented Students of Color has grown steadily, reflecting a corresponding growth among Oregon K-12 students***
- ***Recent drops in international students reflects travel restrictions posed by both the previous federal administration and the global COVID crisis. But numbers remain strong***

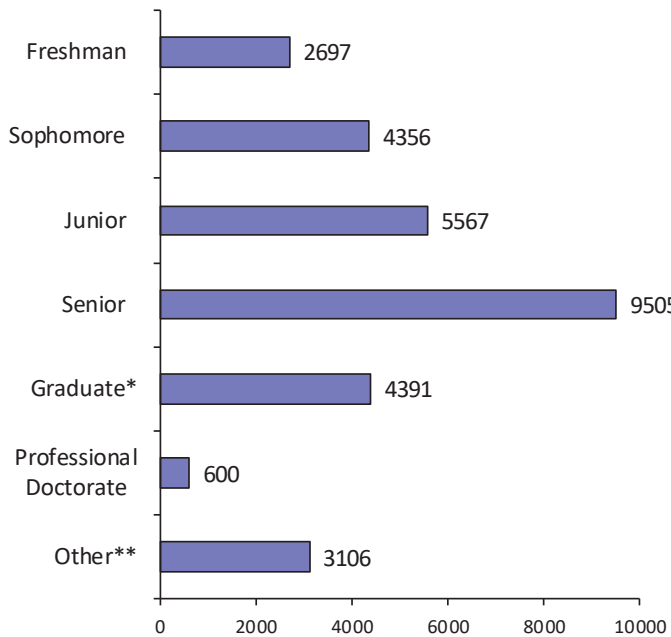
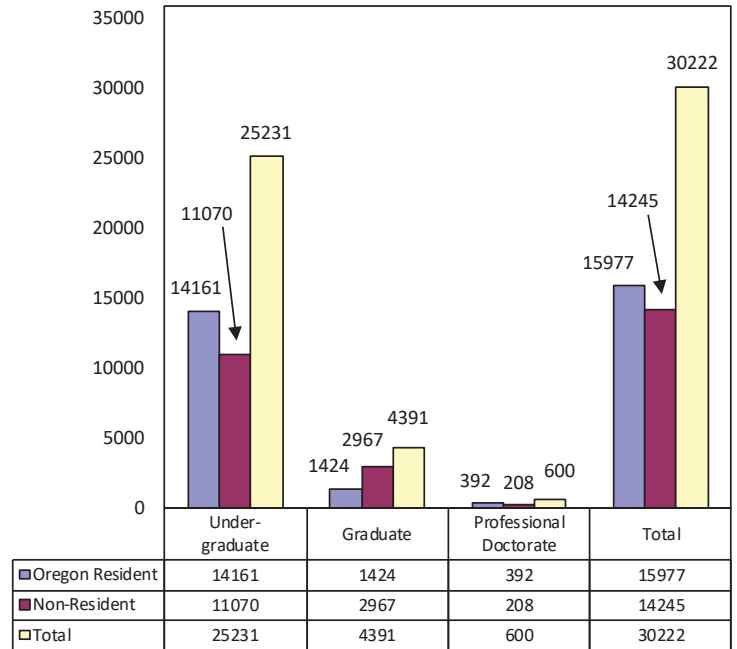

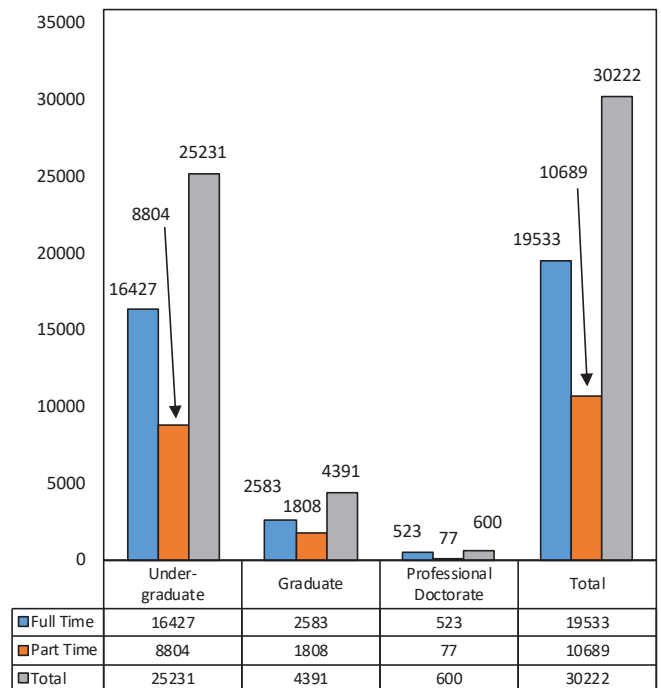
**Headcount Enrollment by Class Standing**

**Enrollment by College/General Academic Unit, Ethnicity, and Student Level**

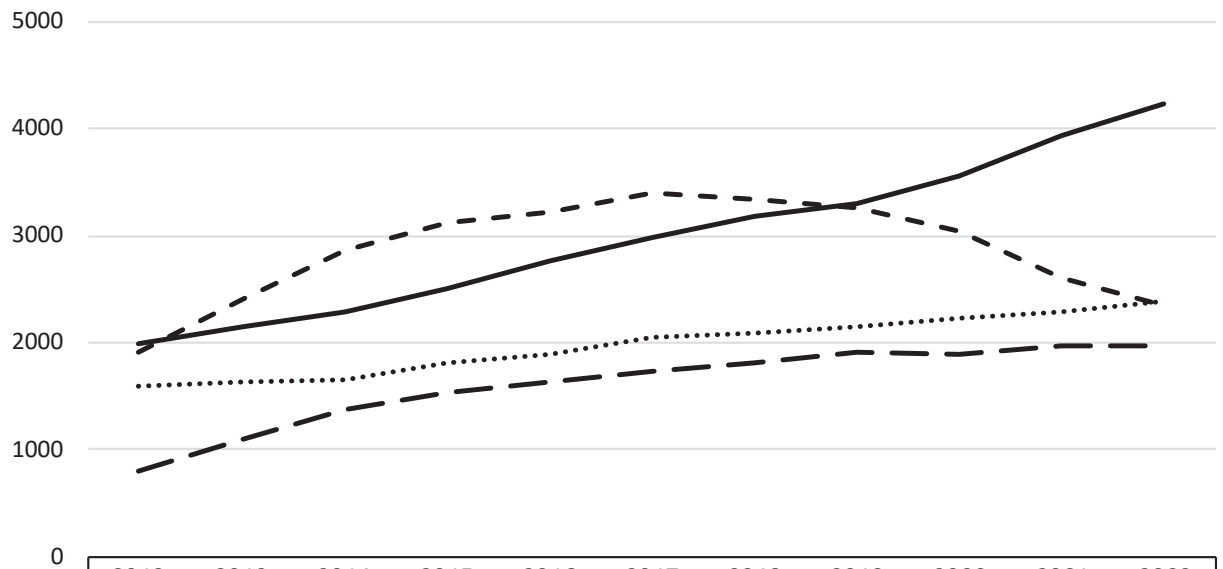

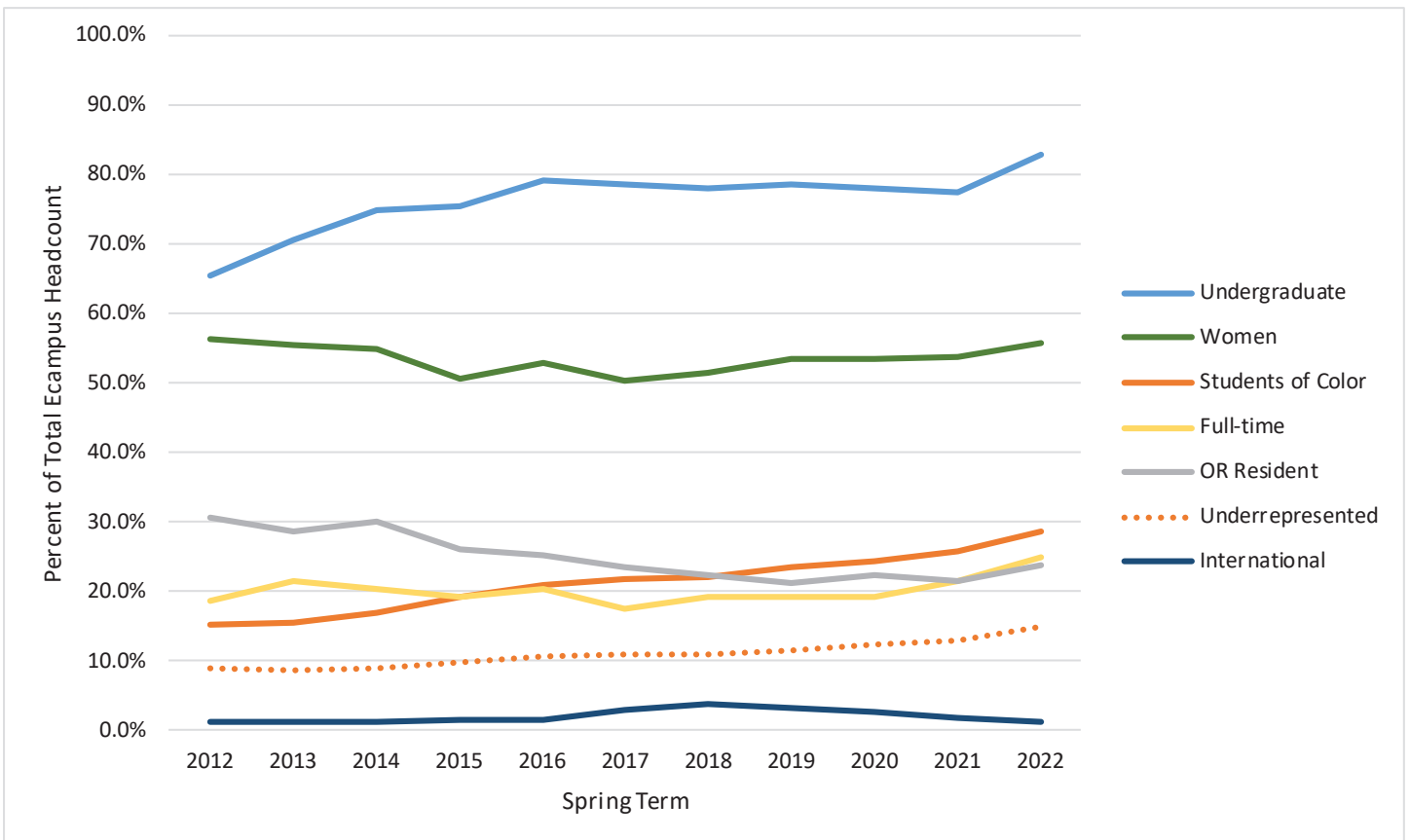

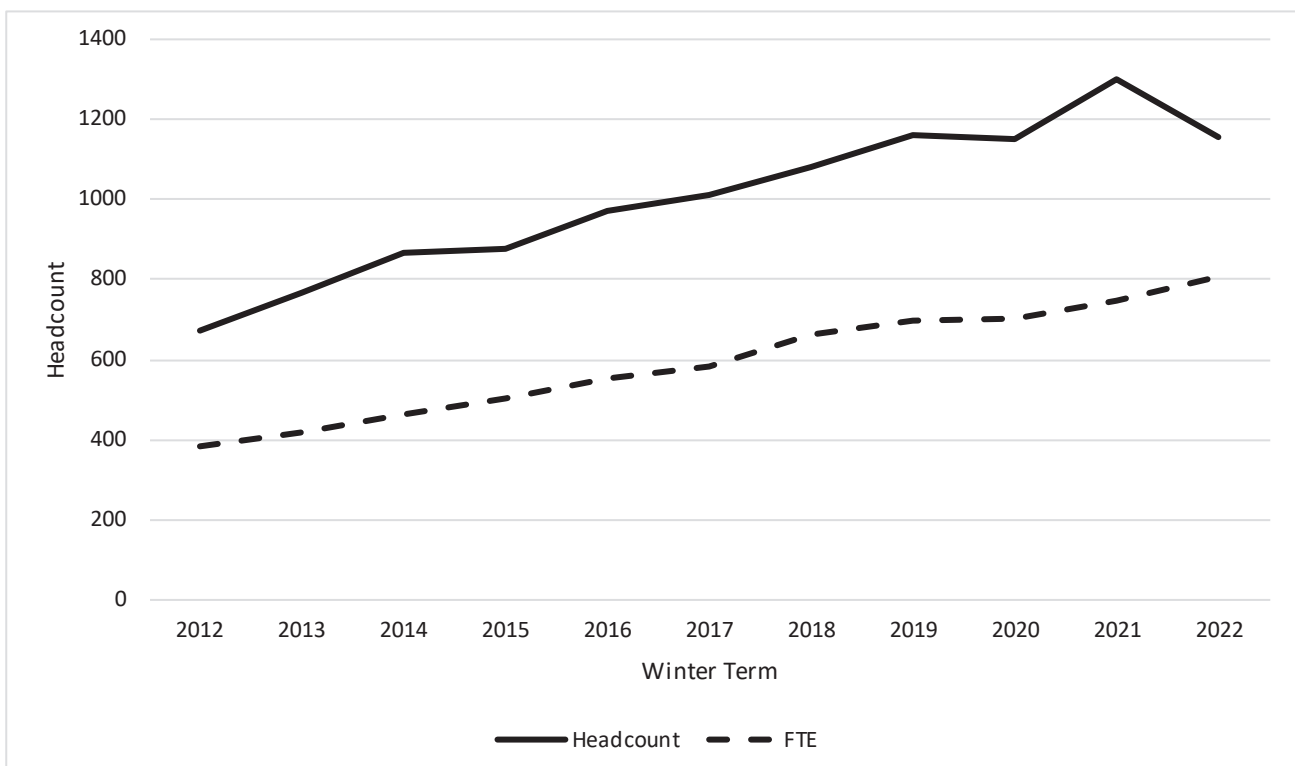
