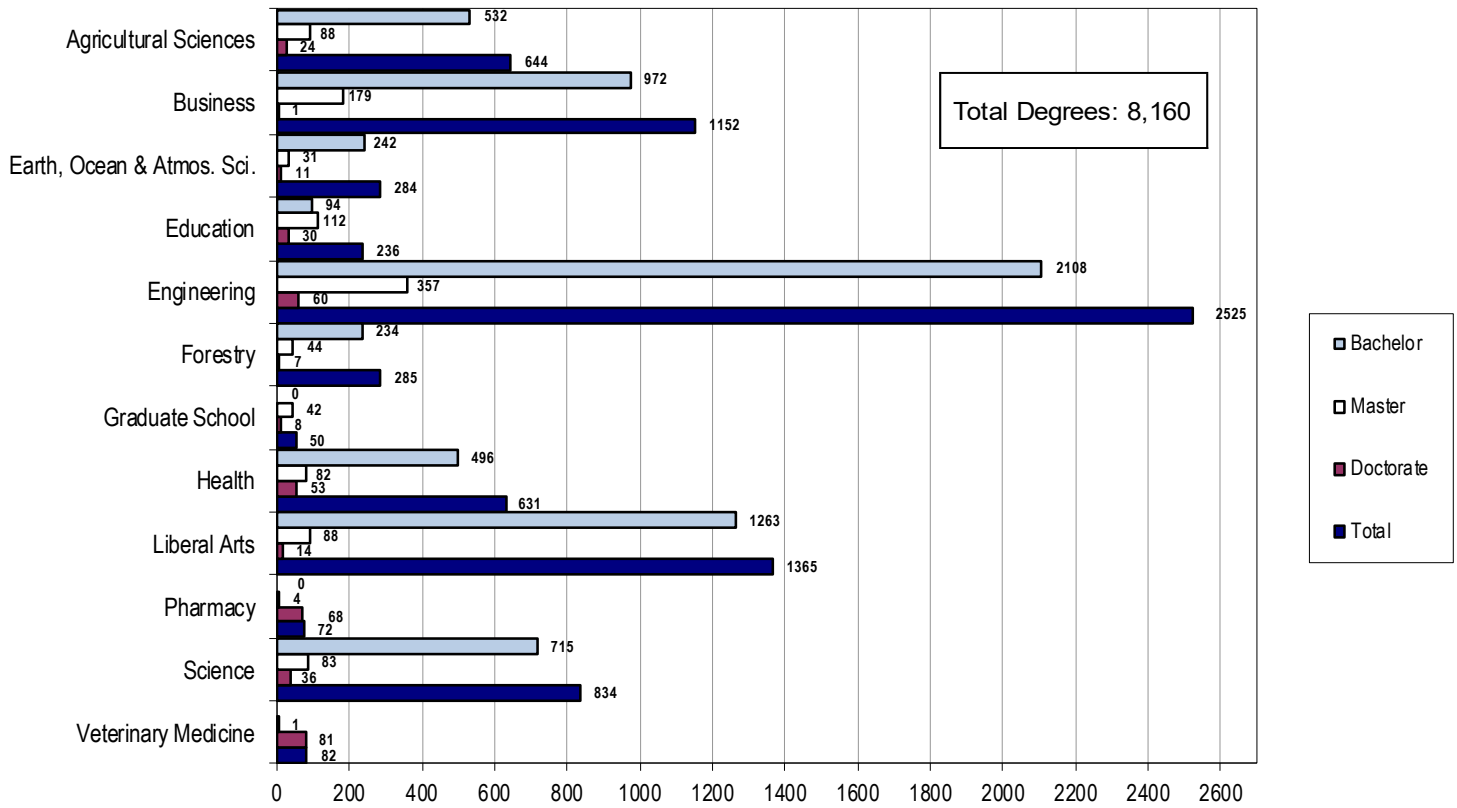

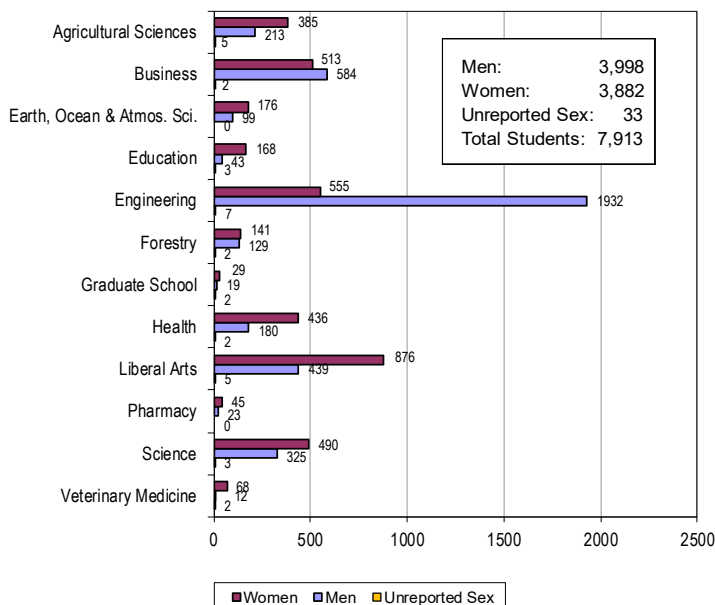
## Degrees Conferred by Academic Unit and Degree Type



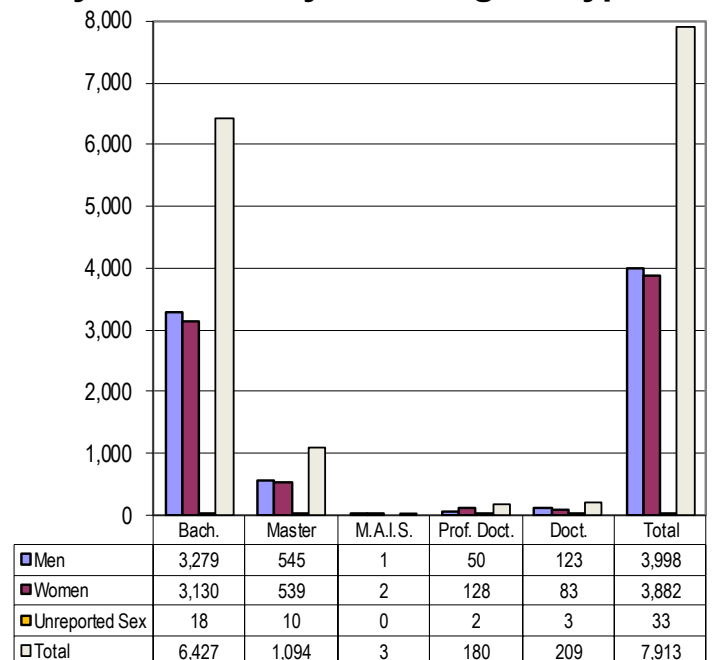

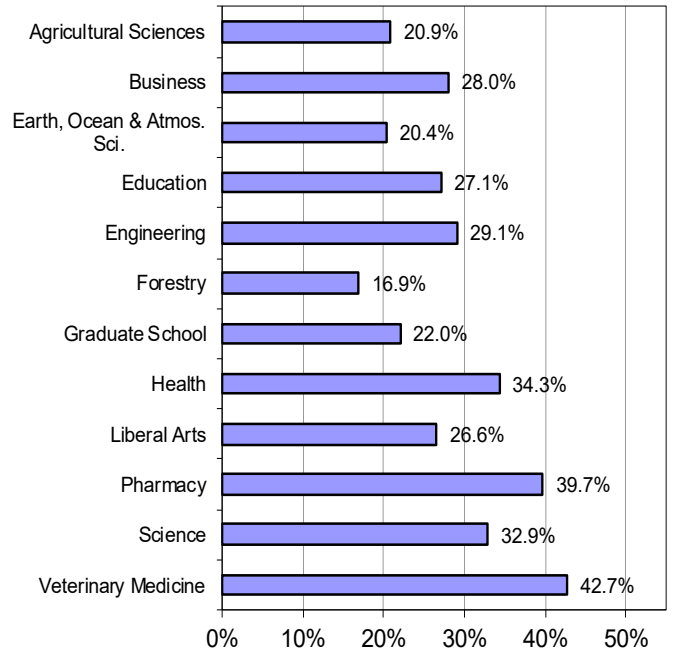

### Percent Students of Color within Academic Unit

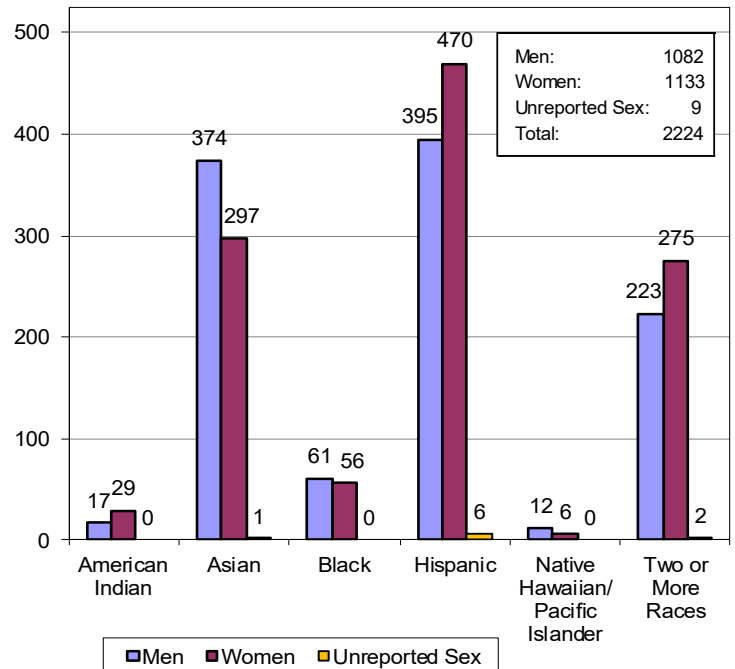

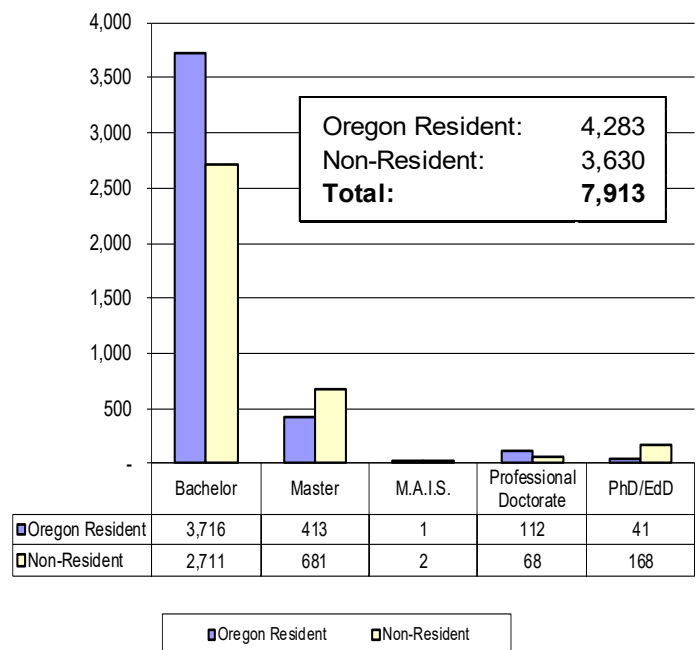

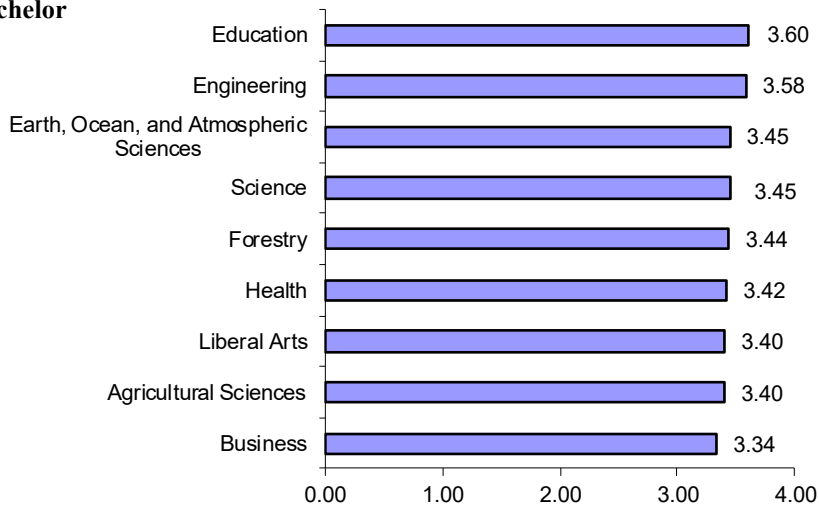

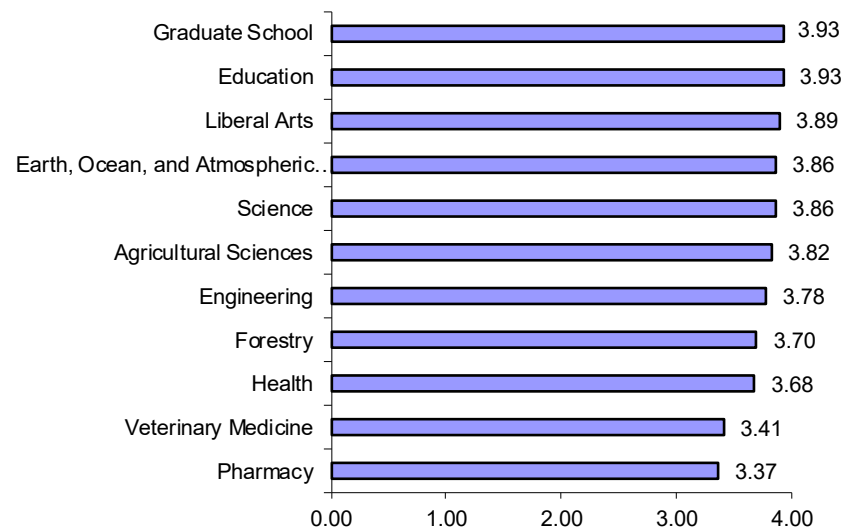
