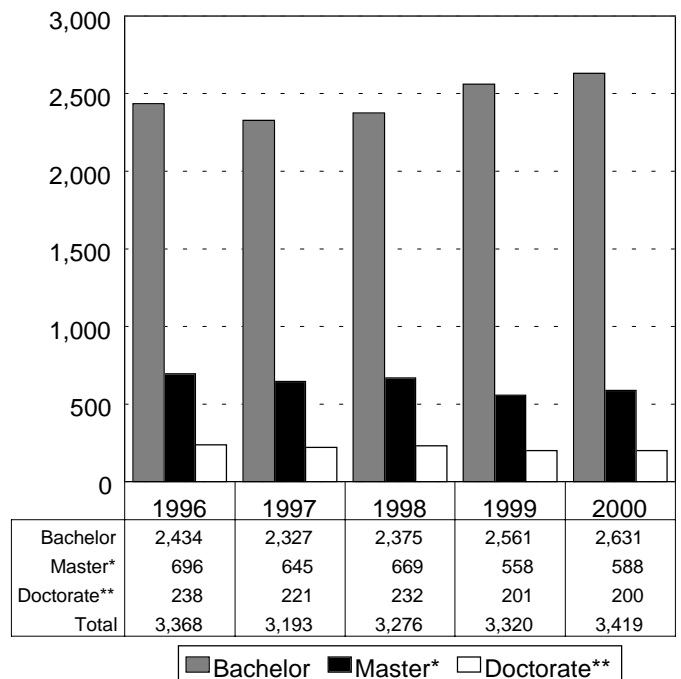

Five-Year Comparison By Degree Type 1996 through 2000



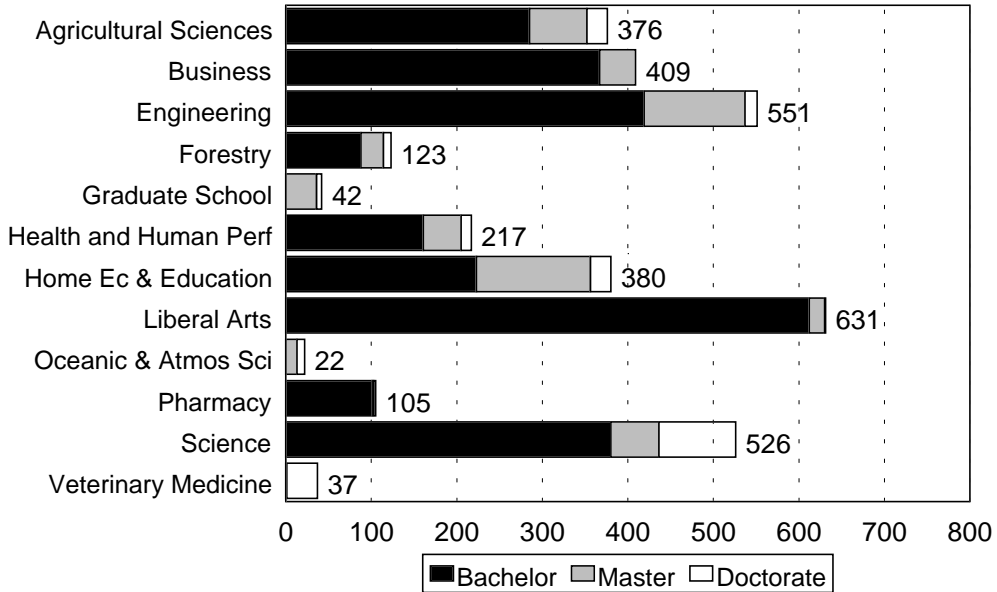

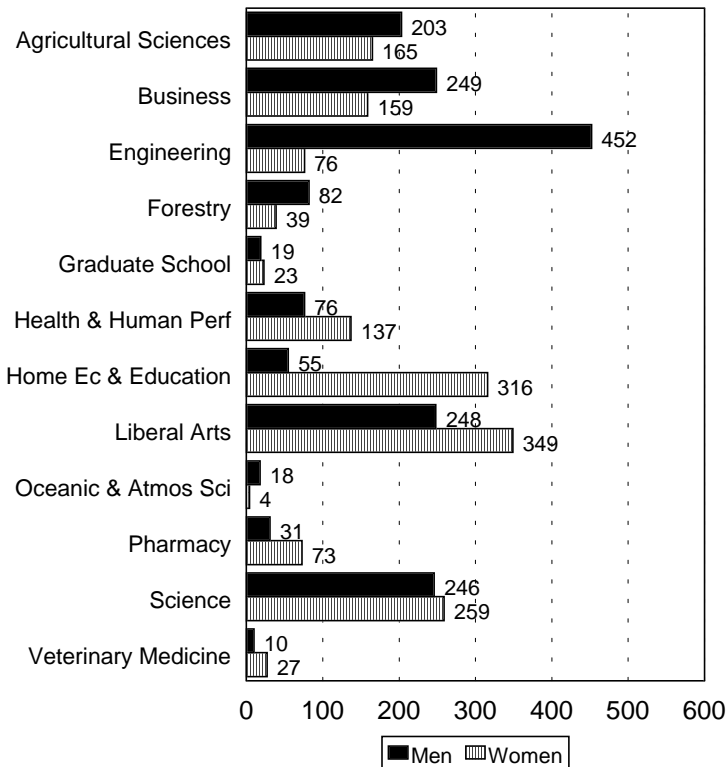

Degrees Conferred 1999-00 By Academic Unit/By Degree Type



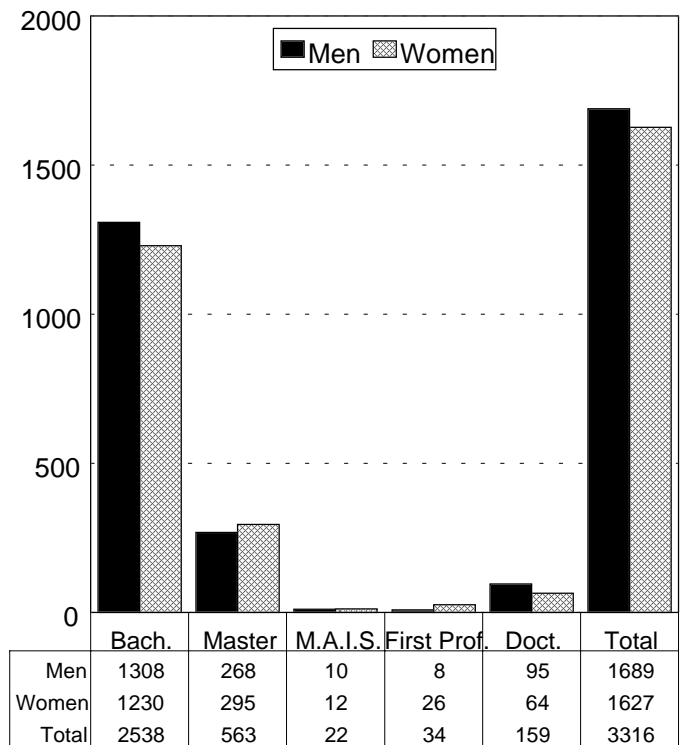
Duplicated headcount of students receiving more than one degree.

By Gender and Degree Type

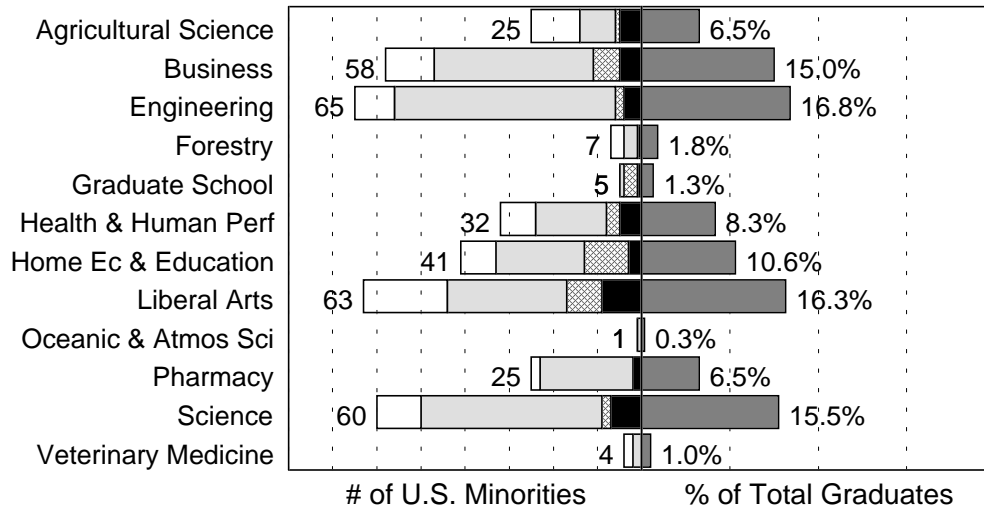

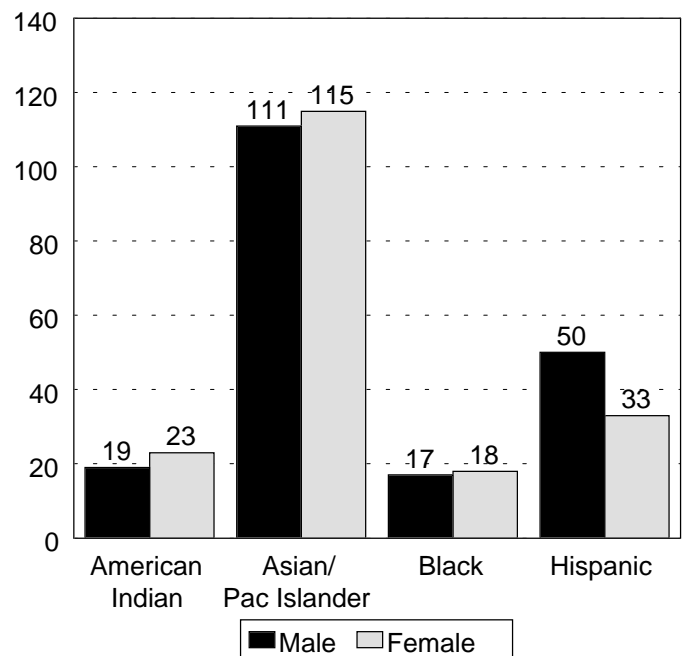

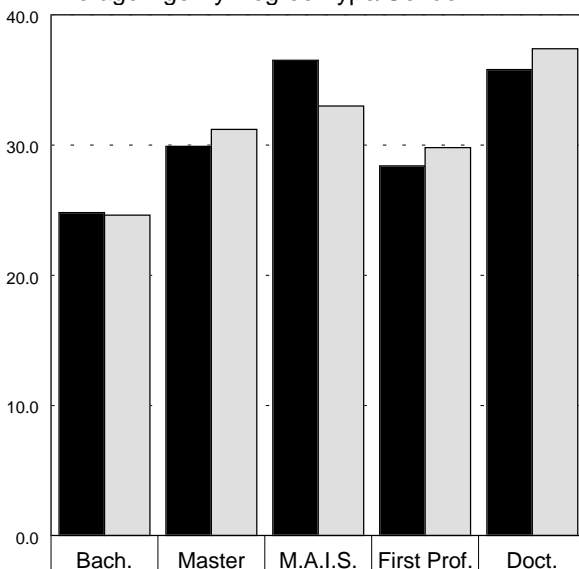

Average Age Graduating Class 2000

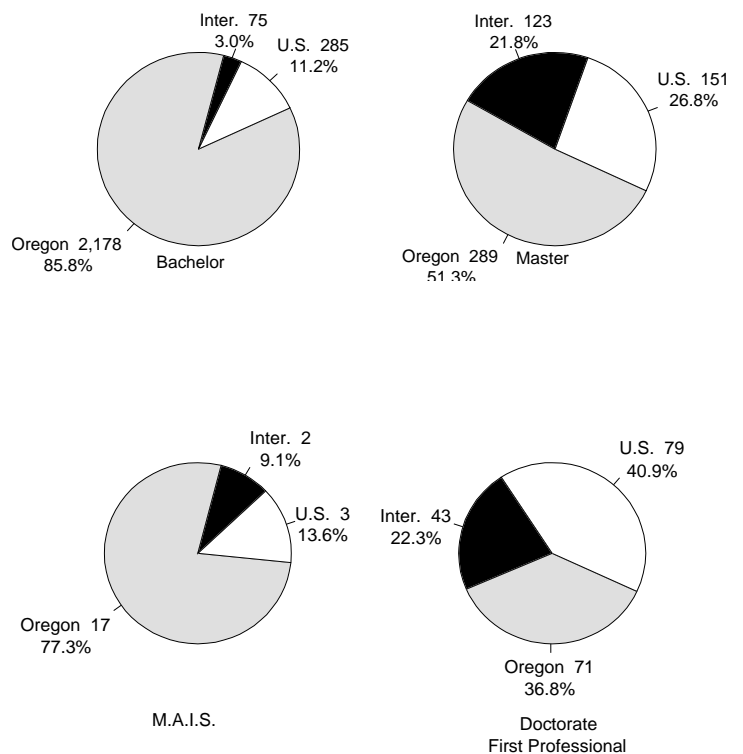
Average Age By Degree Type/Gender

Residency of Graduates



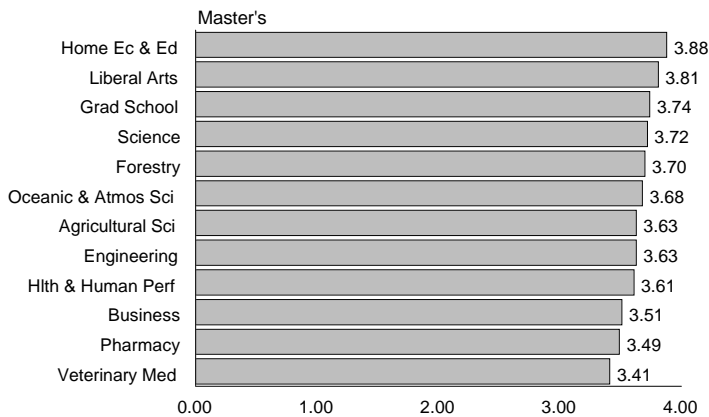
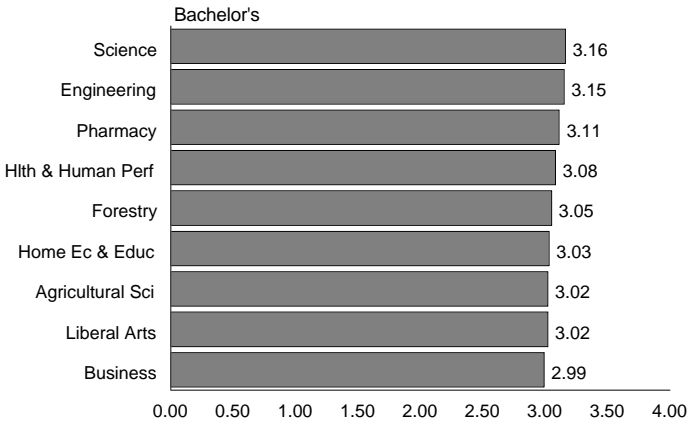

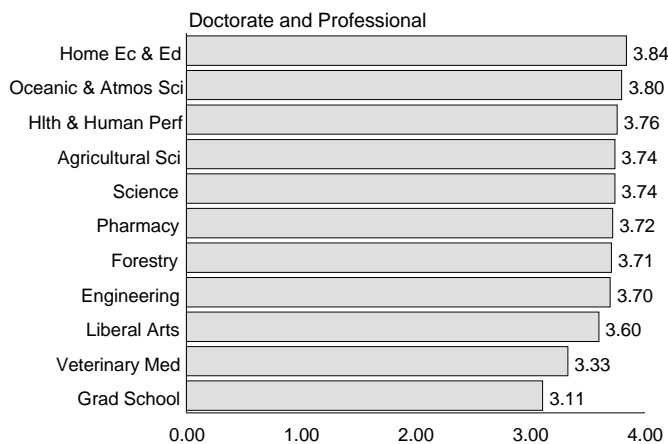
