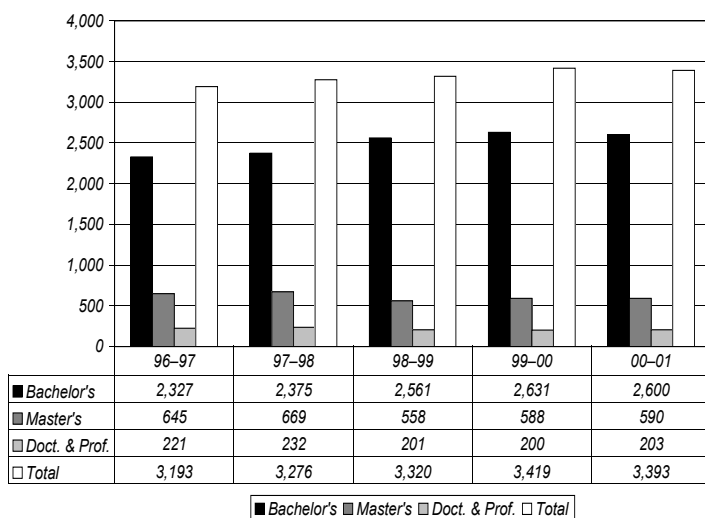

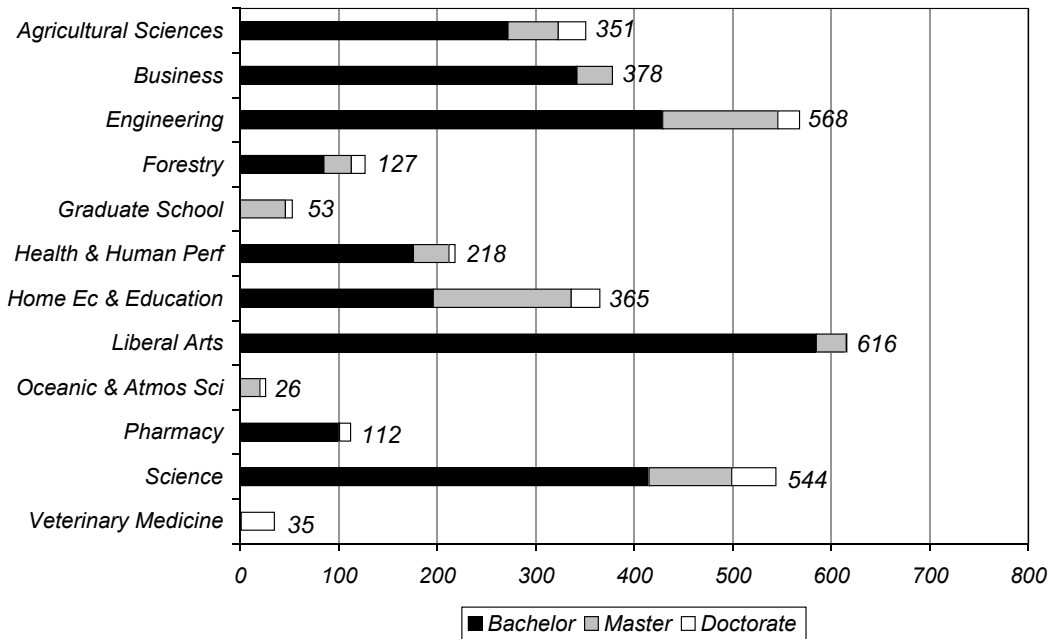

By Degree Type, 1996 through 2001

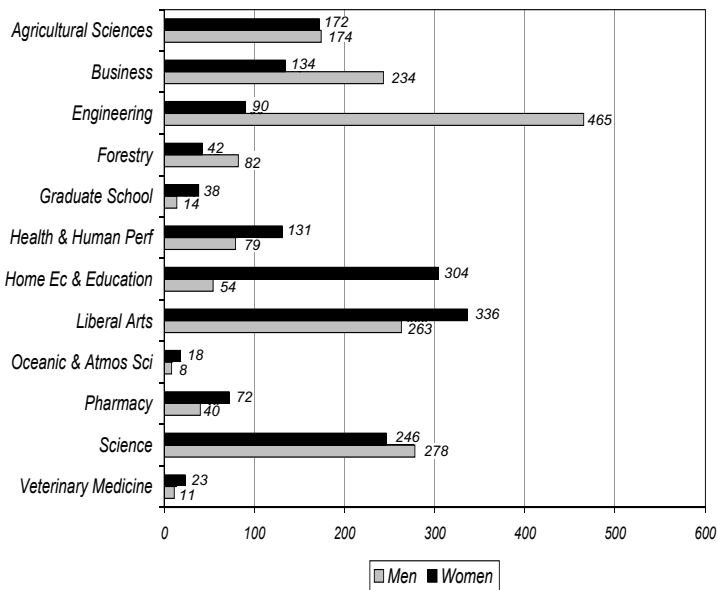


Degrees Conferred 2000–01 By Academic Unit/by Degree Type



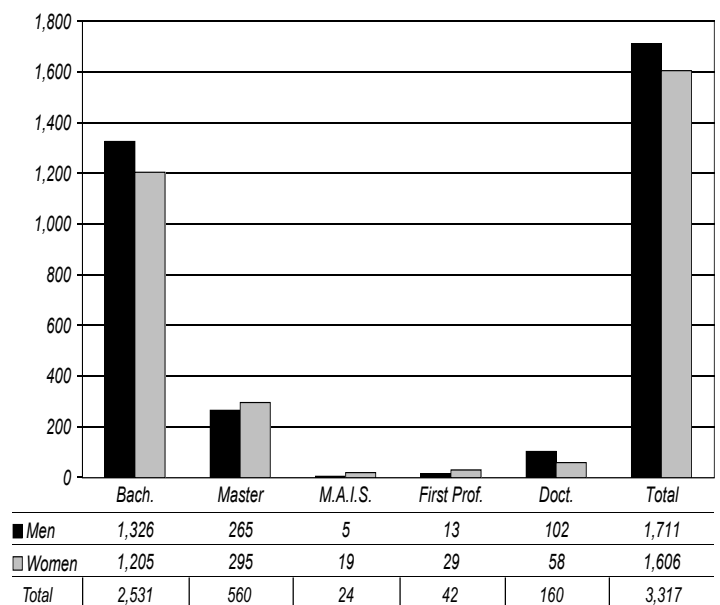

By Academic Unit/by Gender



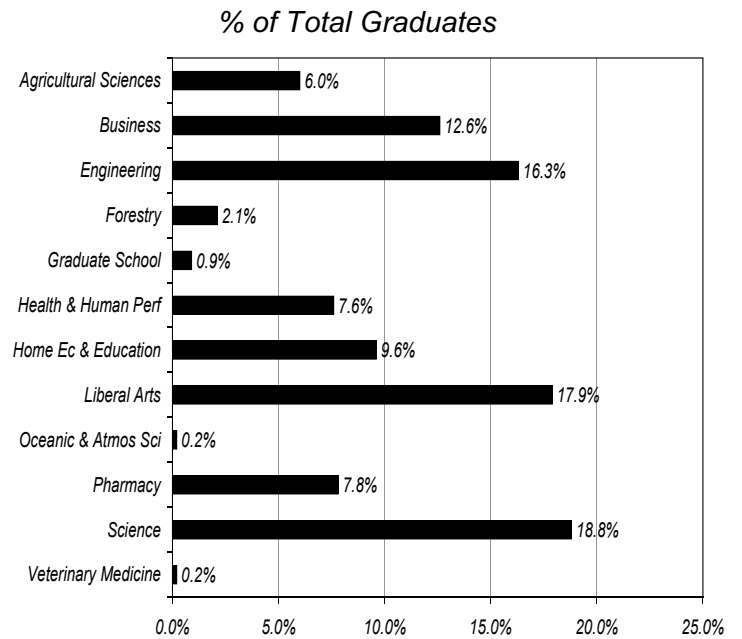
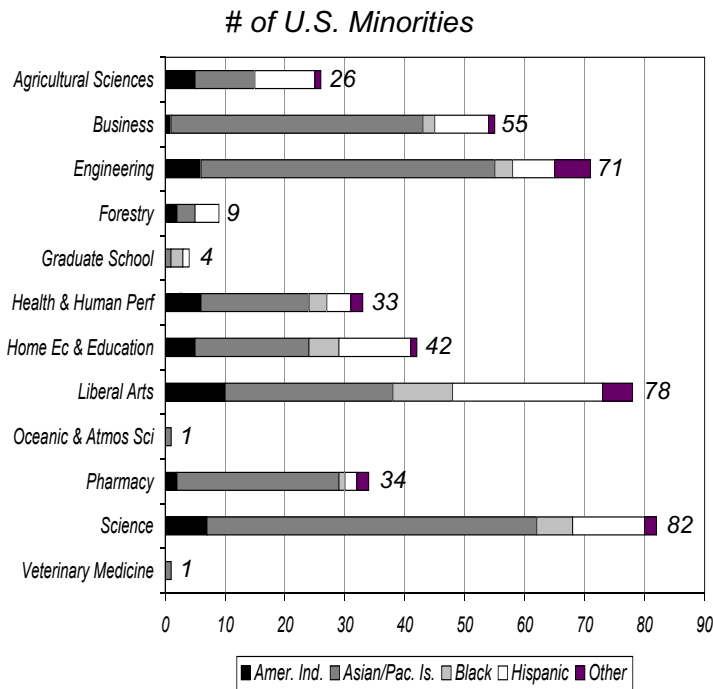

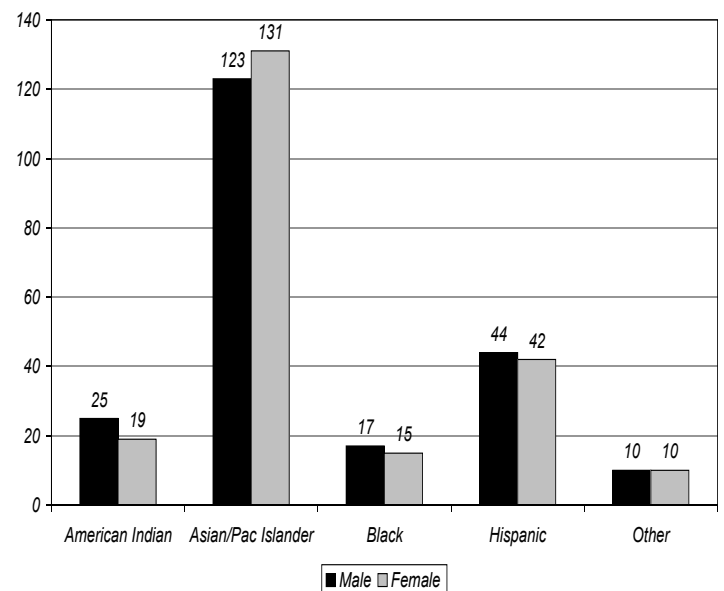

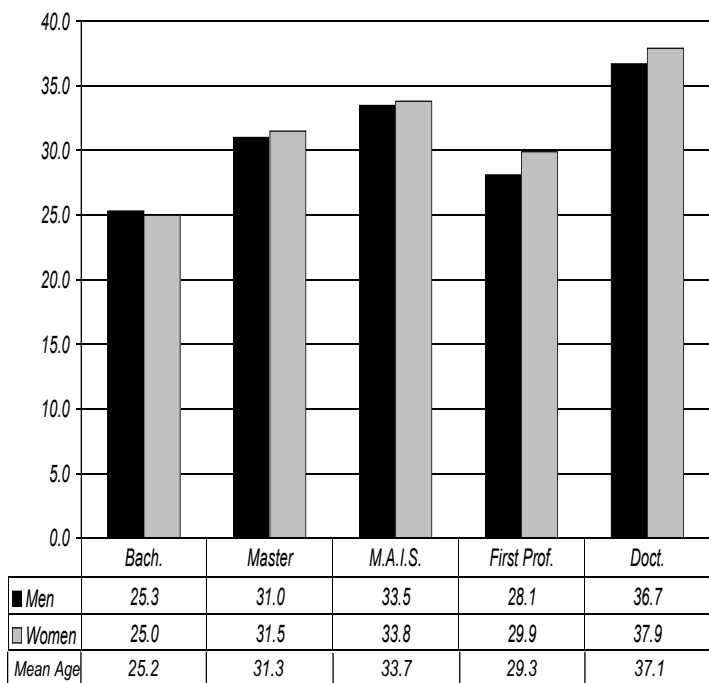

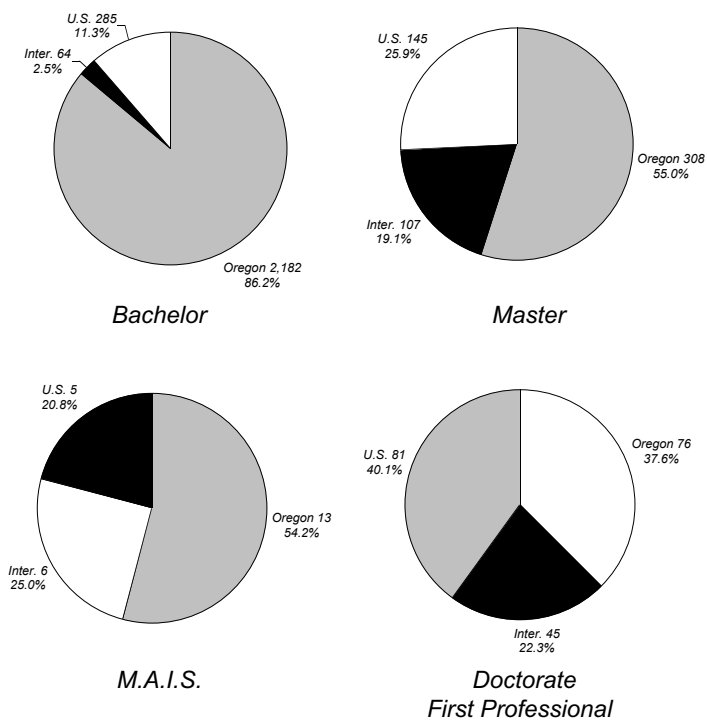

Residency of Graduates



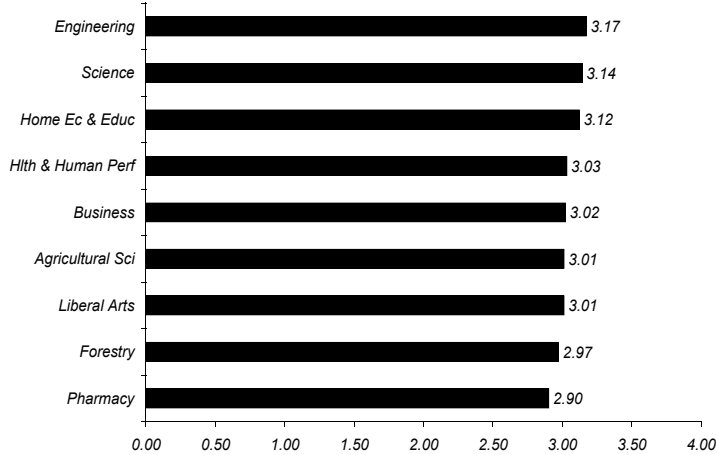

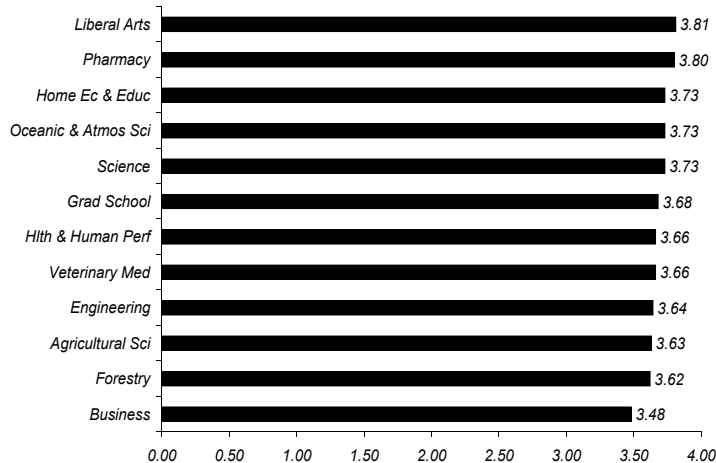

Grade Point Average Graduating Class of 2001

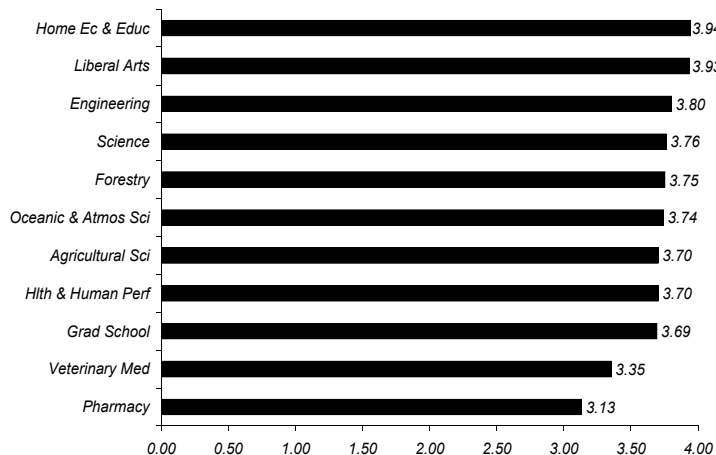
