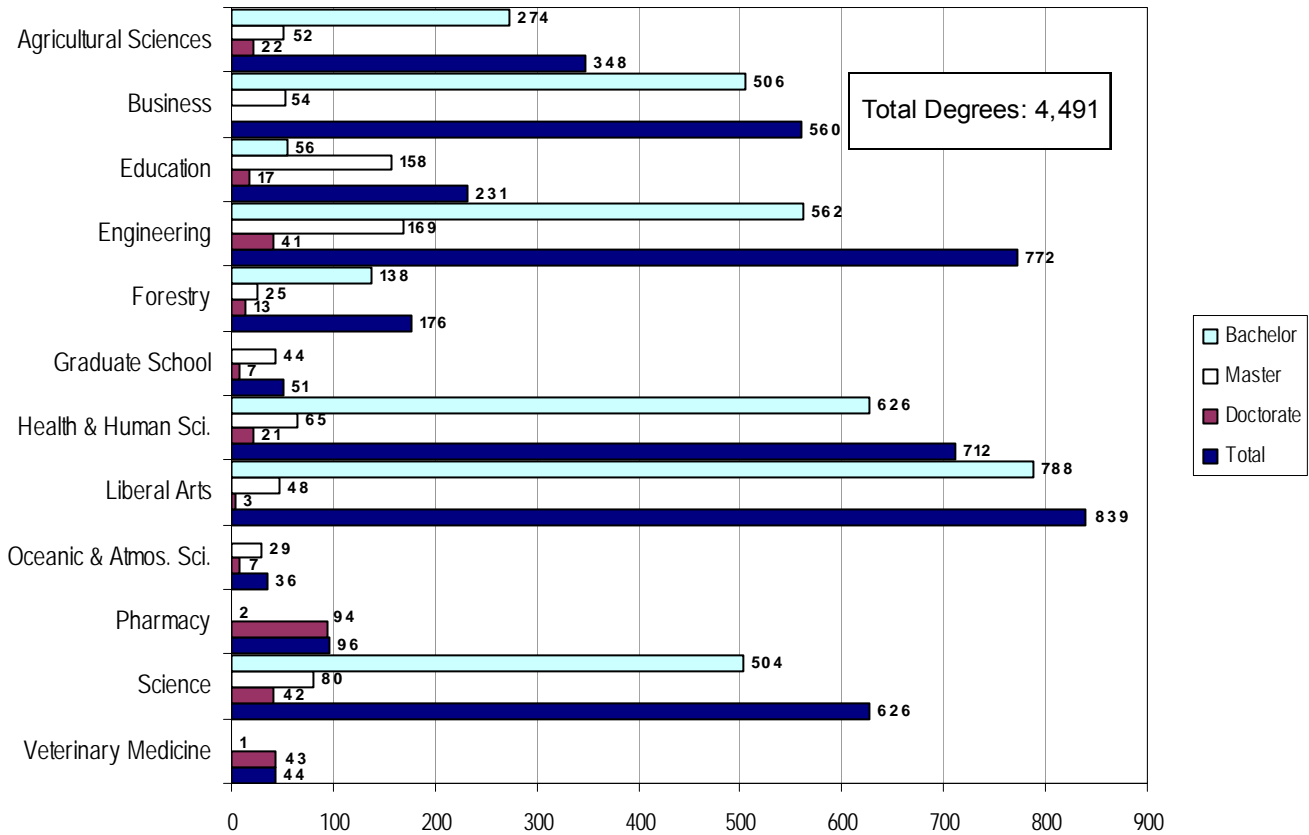

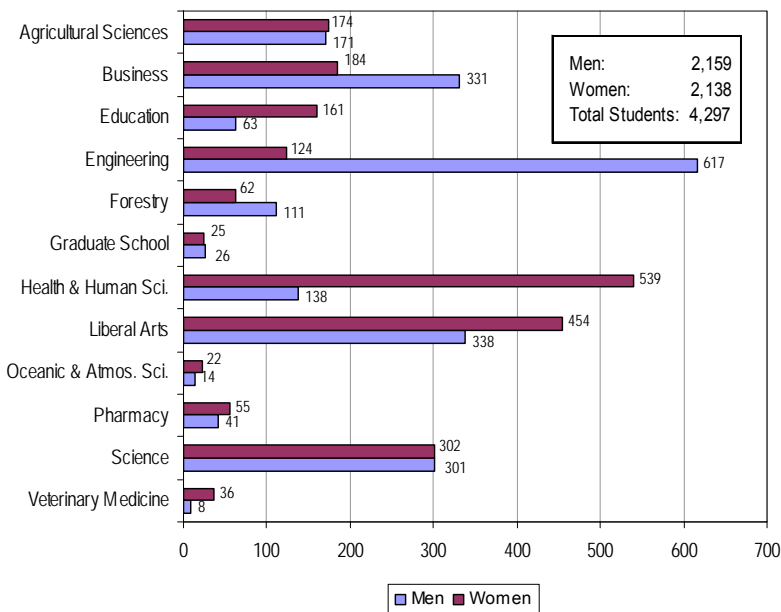
Degrees Conferred by Academic Unit and Degree Type



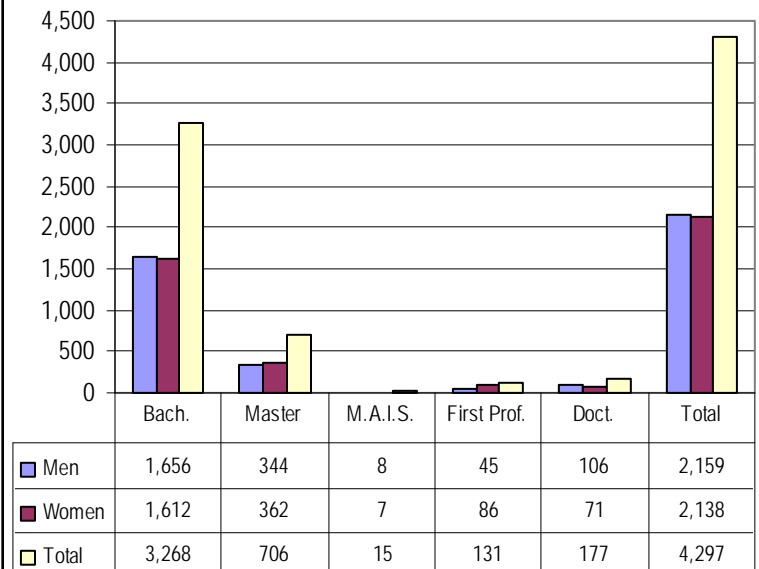

By Academic Unit and Gender



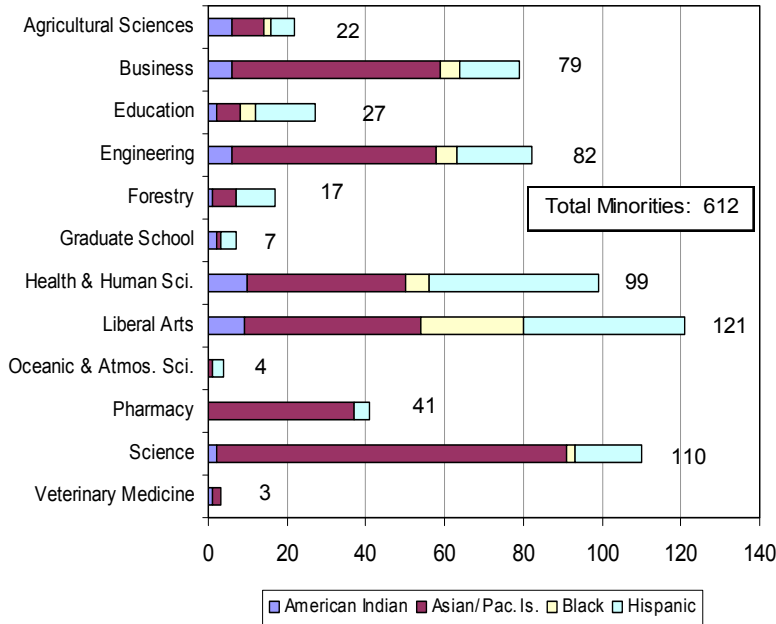
By Gender and Degree Type



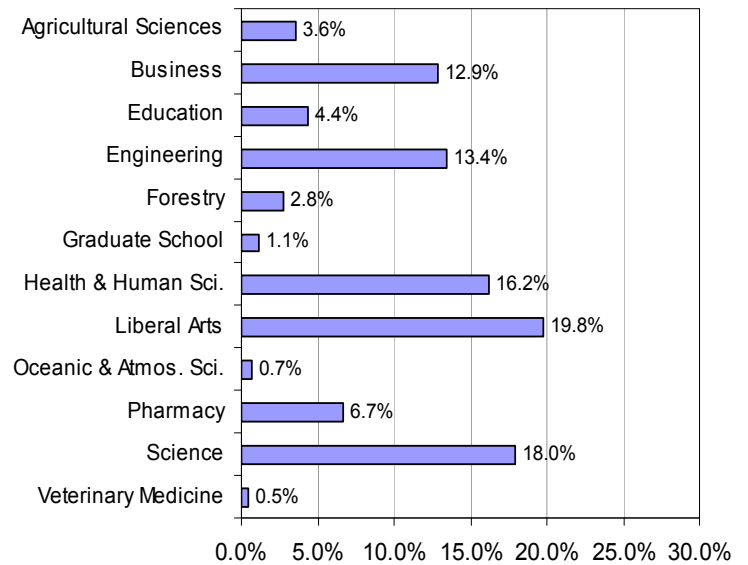

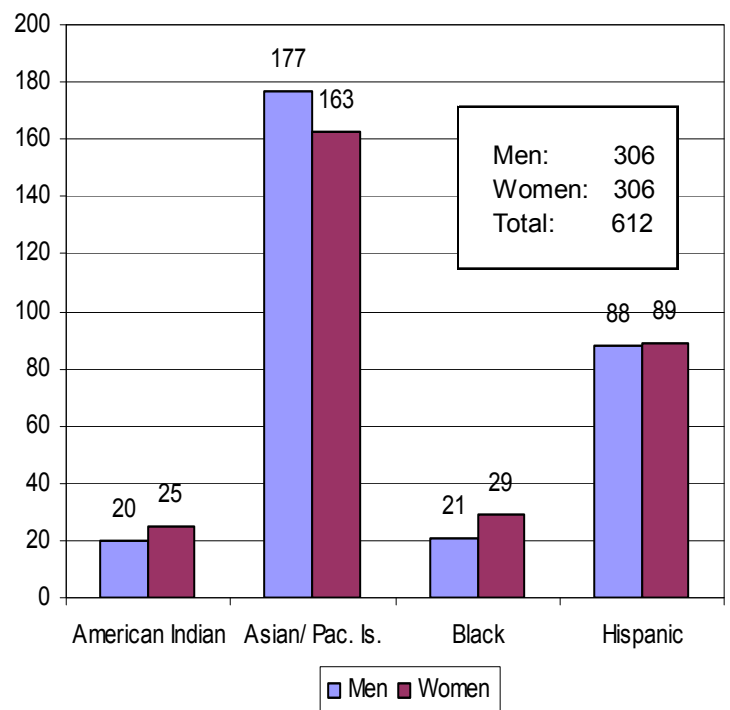

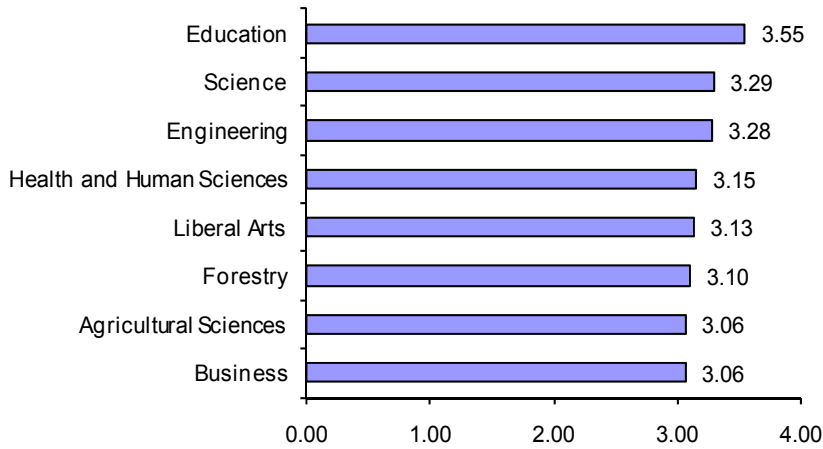

Grade Point Average of Graduates

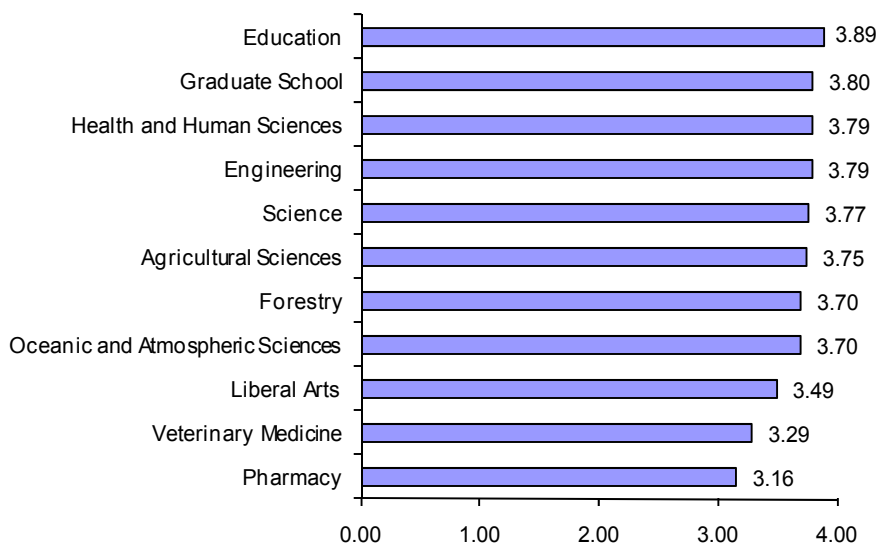

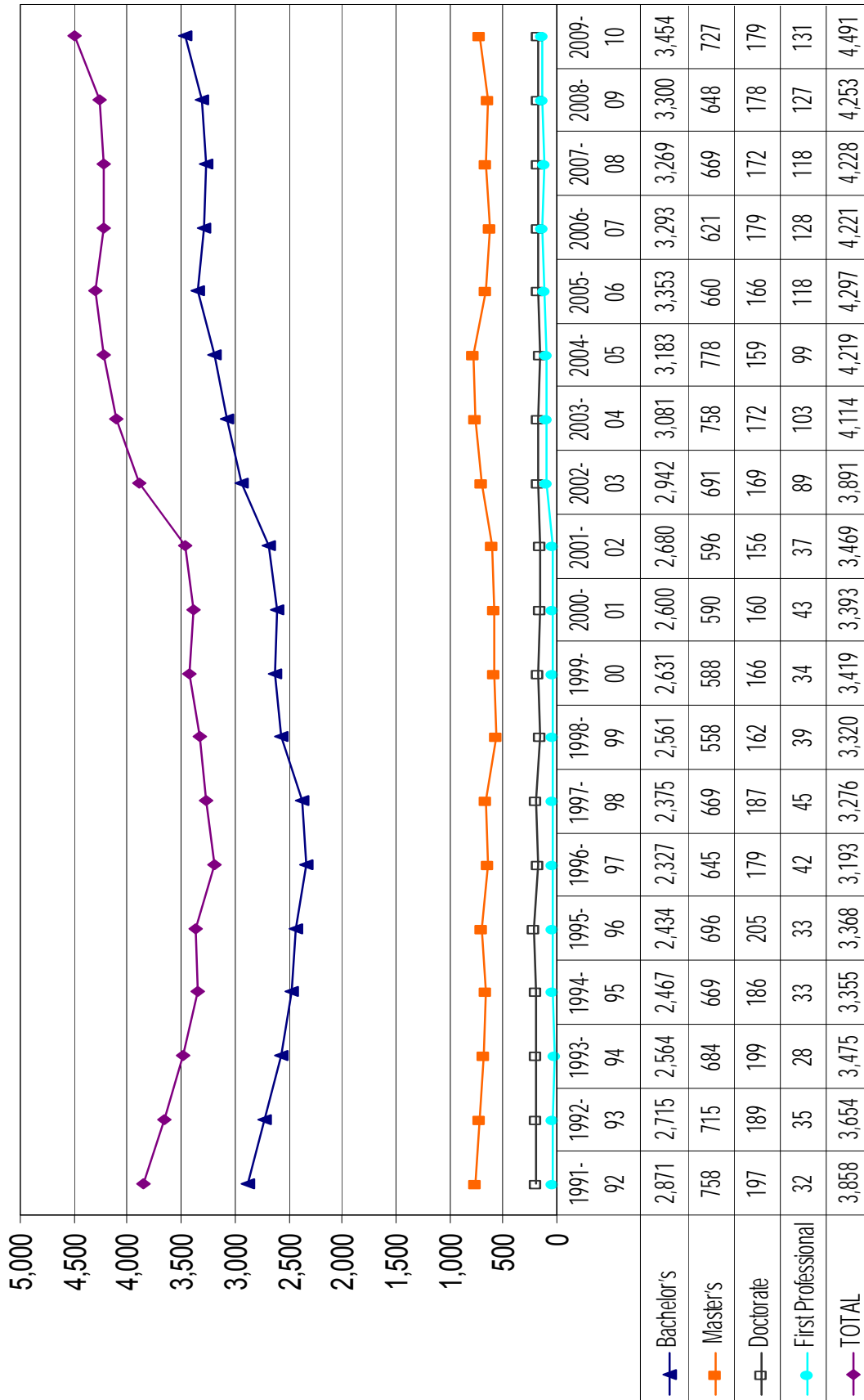
Doctorate and First Professional

Highlights

- The number of degrees awarded during the 2009-10 academic year was 4,491. In all, OSU has awarded 204,461 degrees through 141 annual commencements.

- Compared to 2008-09, the total number of degrees awarded increased by 5.6%. The number of Bachelor degrees increased by 4.7%; First Professional degrees increased by 3.1%; Masters degrees increased by 12.2%; and Doctoral degrees increased by .6%.

- 6 students received three degrees; and 182 students received two degrees.

- The College of Liberal Arts awarded the largest number of degrees (839) when compared to the other academic units.

- The average age for Bachelor, Master, M.A.I.S, First Professional, and Doctorate degree recipients was 25.0, 31.1, 35.0, 28.7, and 35.7, respectively.

- The College of Veterinary Medicine had the largest percentage of U.S. minority graduates: 19.8%.

- The number of U.S. minority graduates was 612 or 14% of all graduates in 2009-10. 306 U.S. minority women and men (306) earned degrees in 2009-10 at OSU.

- 80.3% of the graduates were Oregon residents; 19.7% of the graduates were non-residents.

- The grade point average (GPA) for students receiving Bachelor, Master, M.A.I.S, First Professional, and Doctorate degrees was 3.17, 3.73, 3.78, 3.18, and 3.77, respectively.
