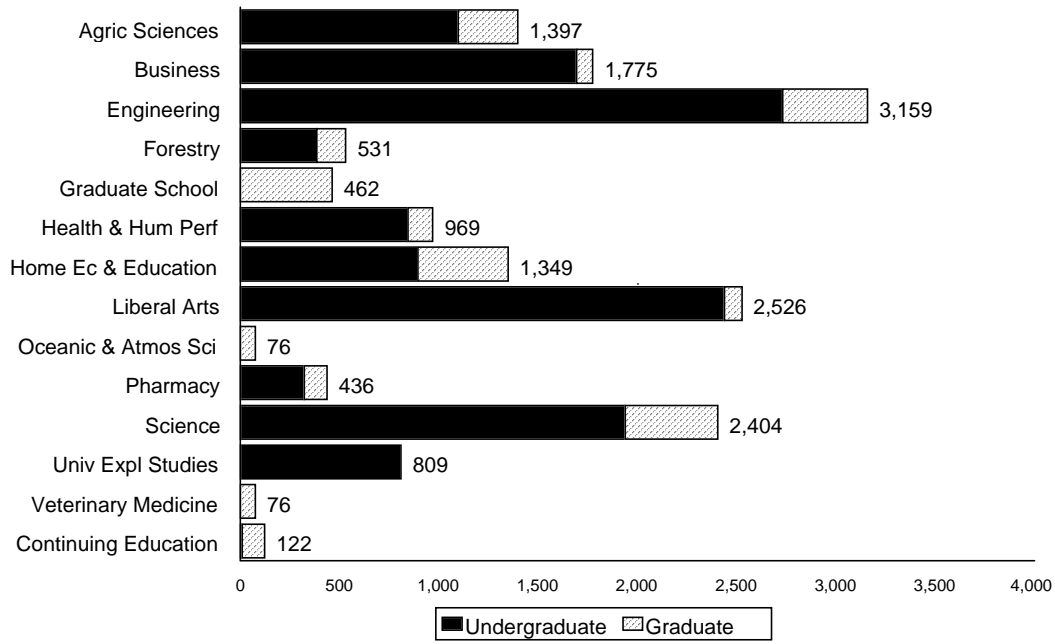

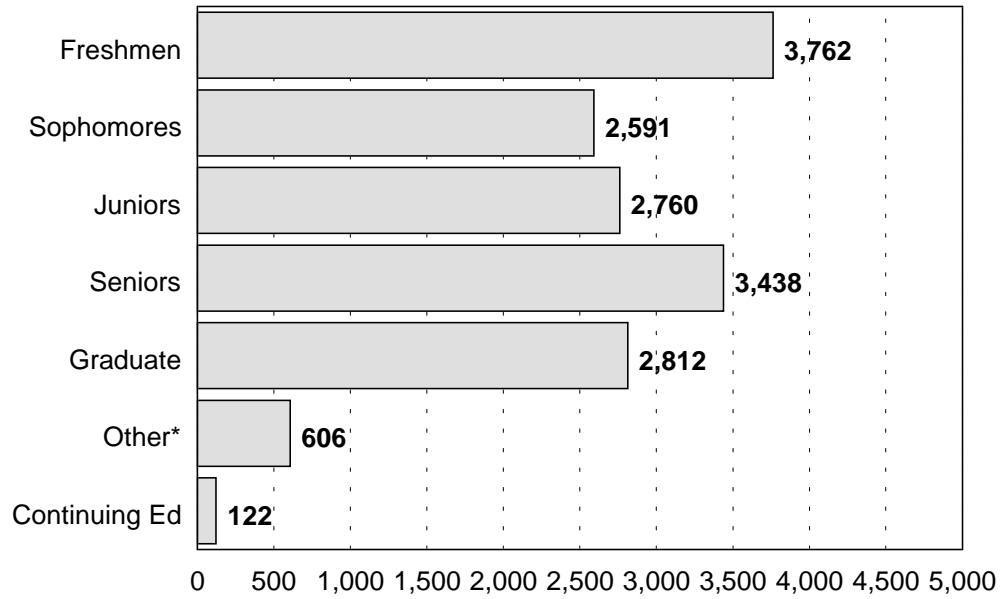

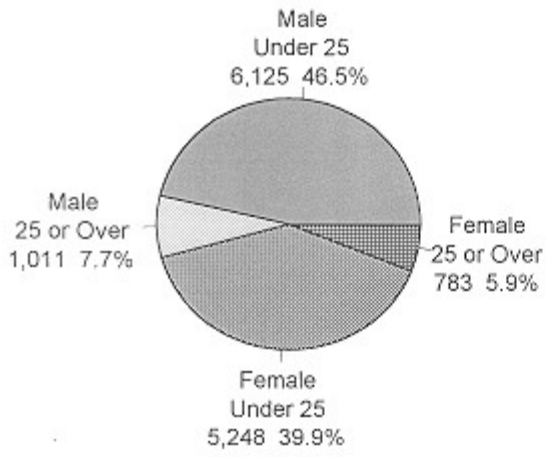
# Headcount Enrollment By Class



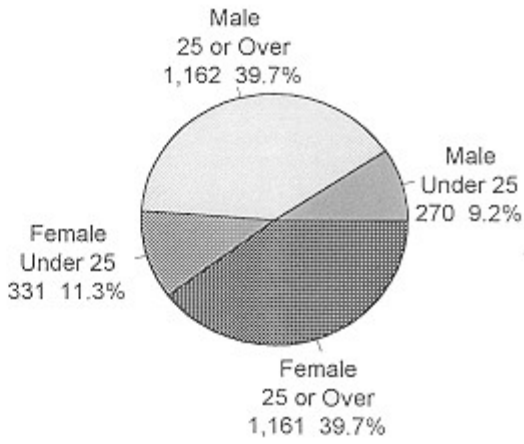

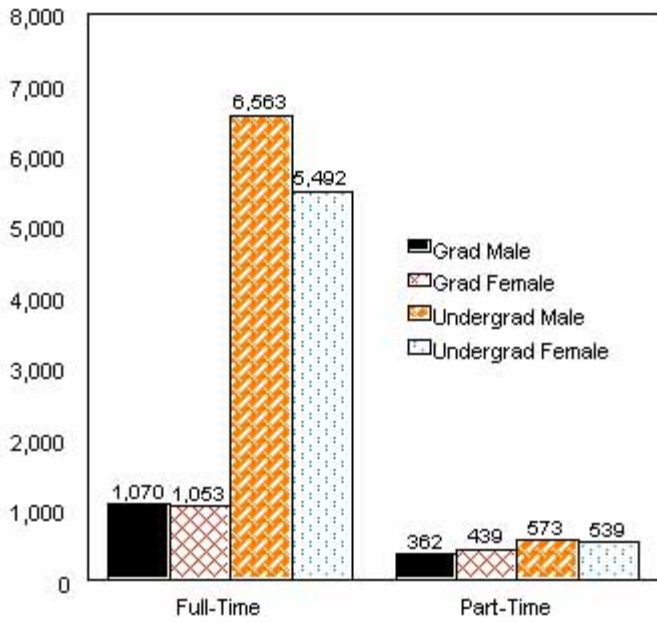
## New Students\* By Residency

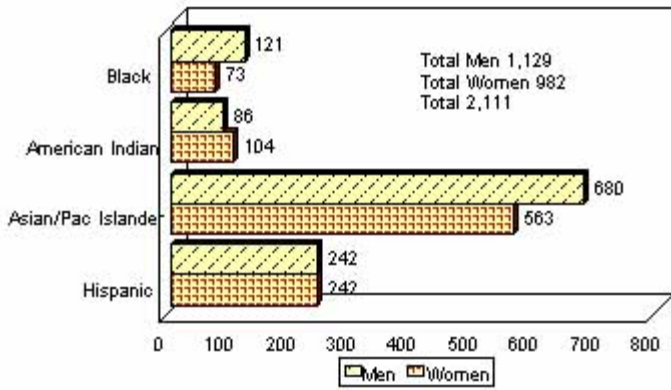

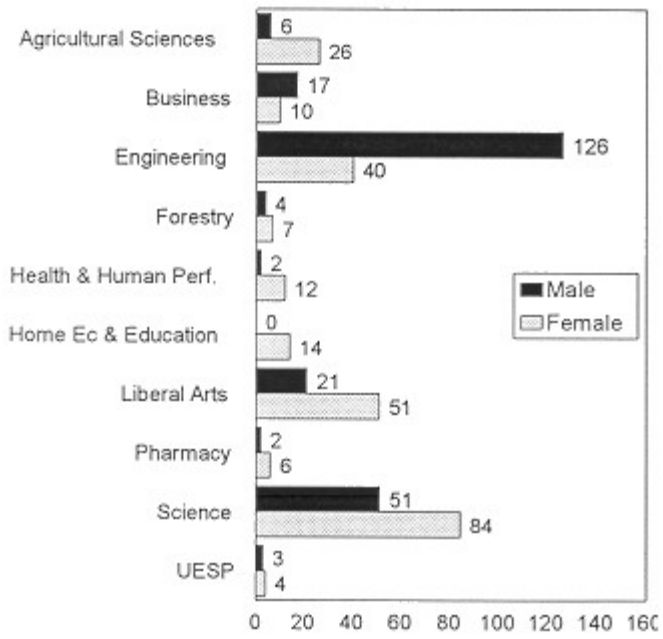
