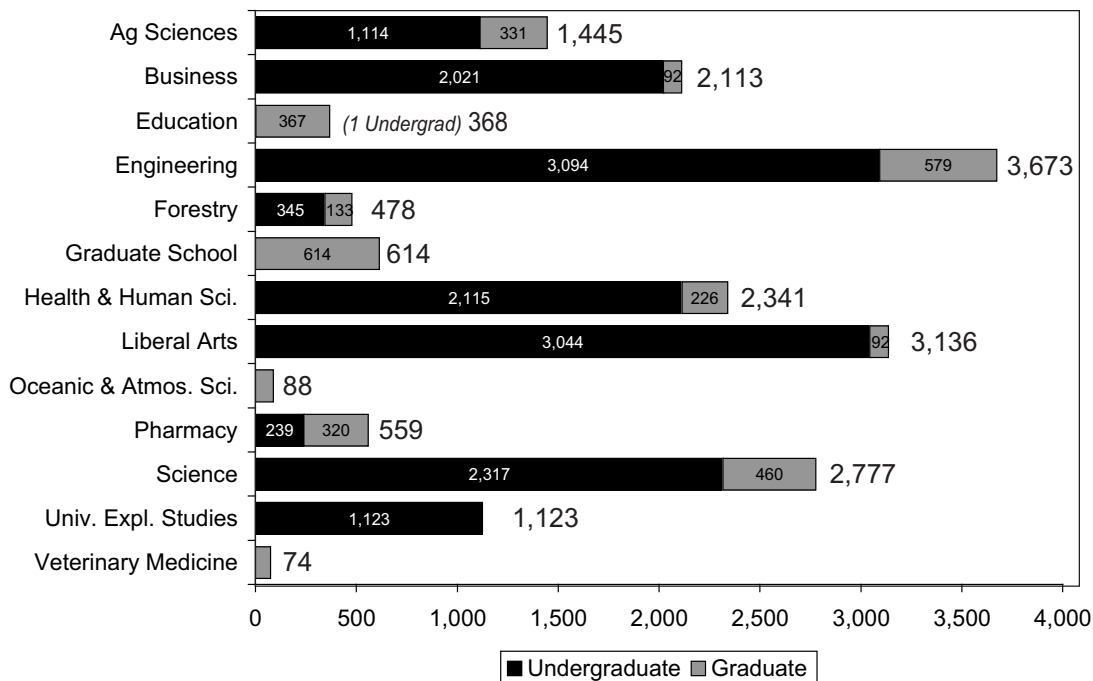

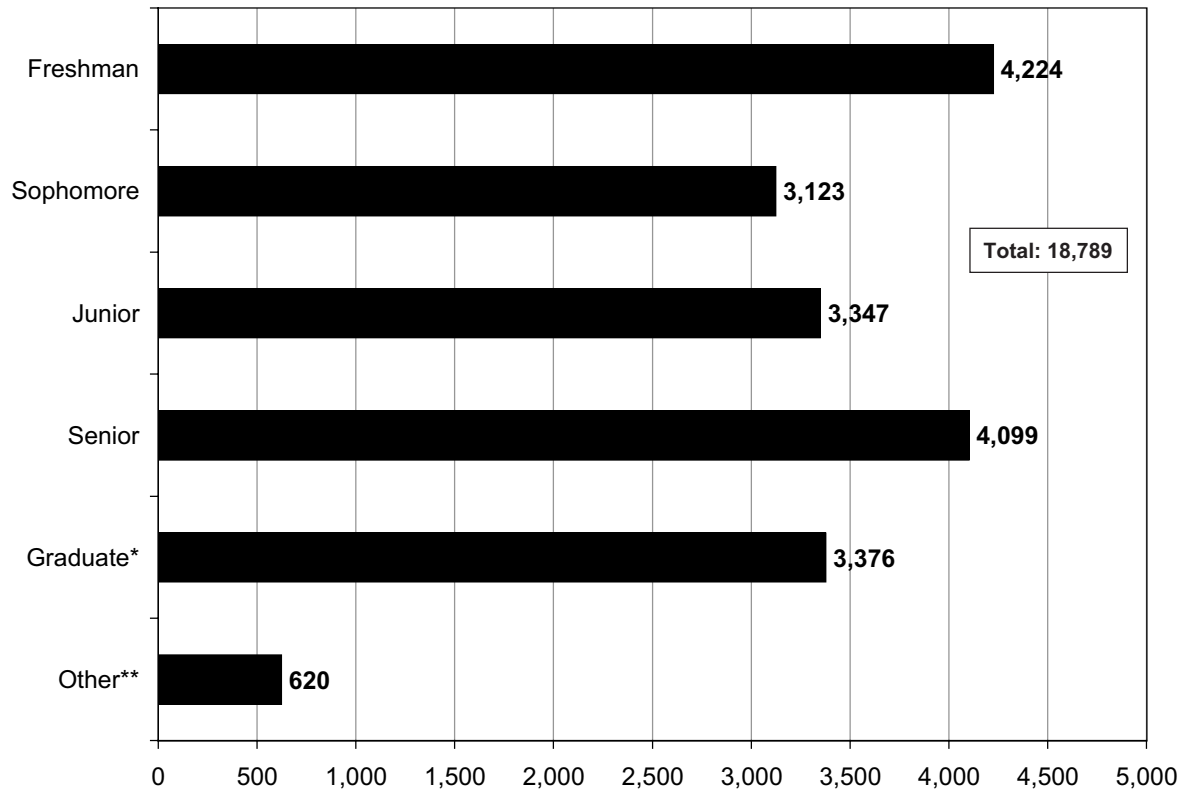

Headcount Enrollment by Class Standing



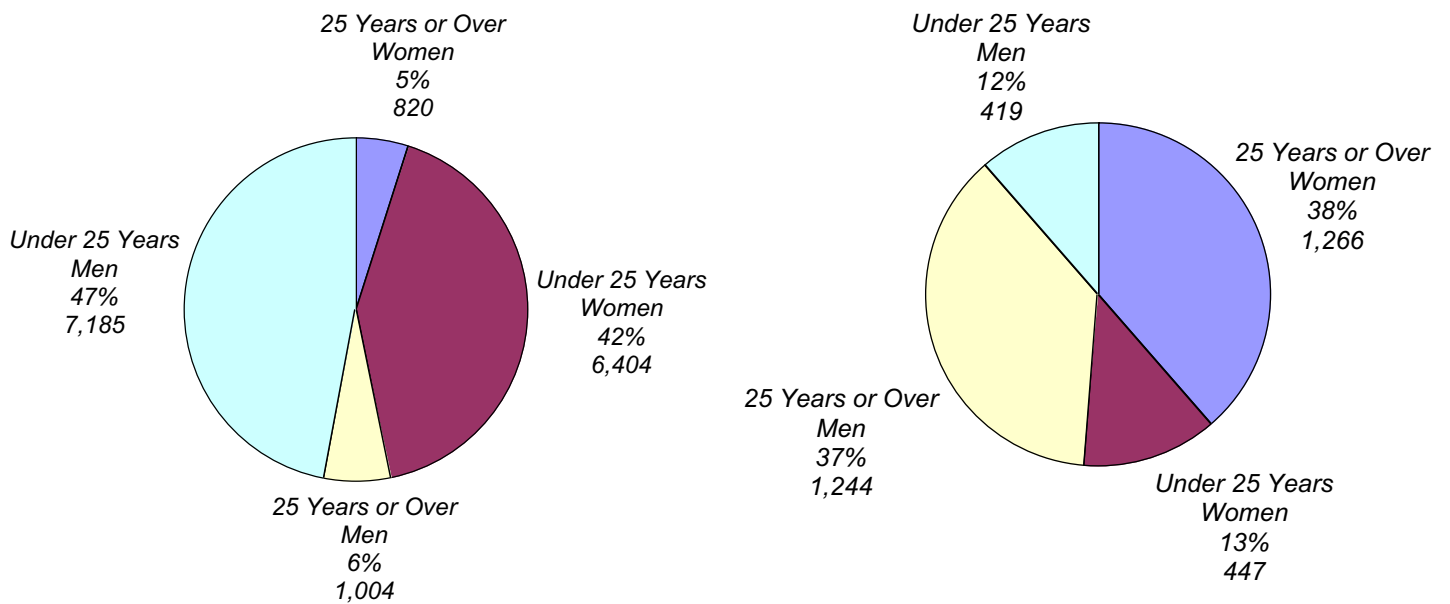

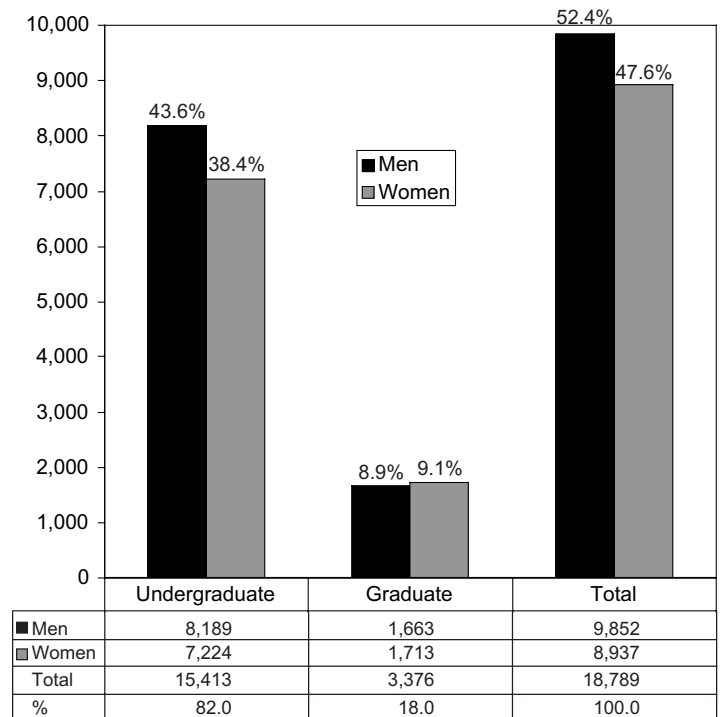

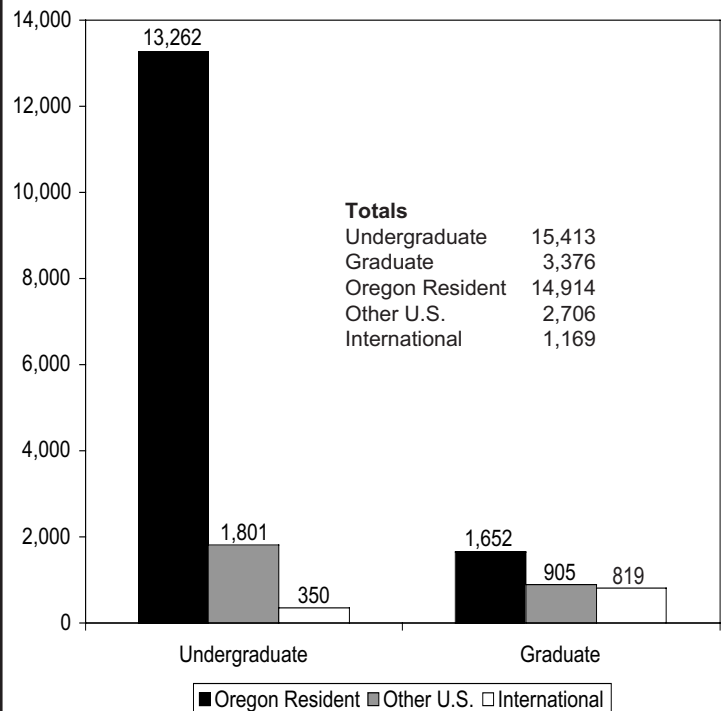

By Residency and Student Level

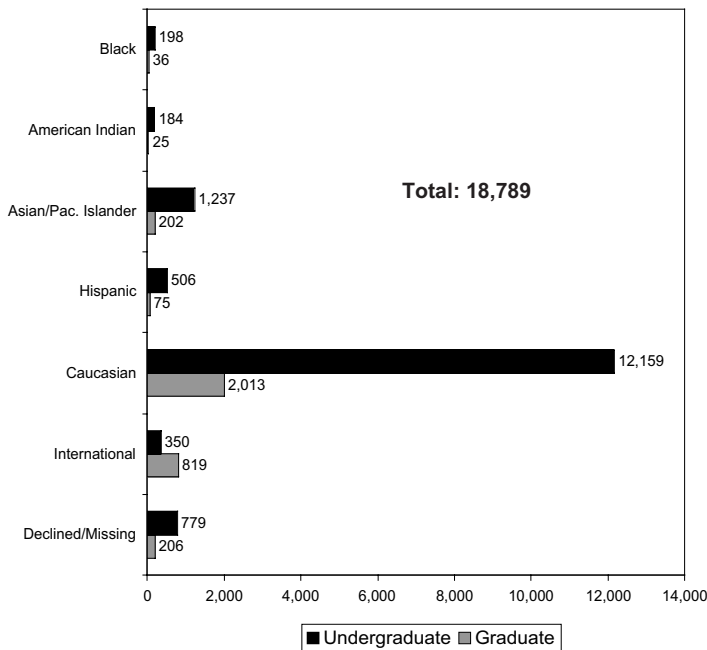

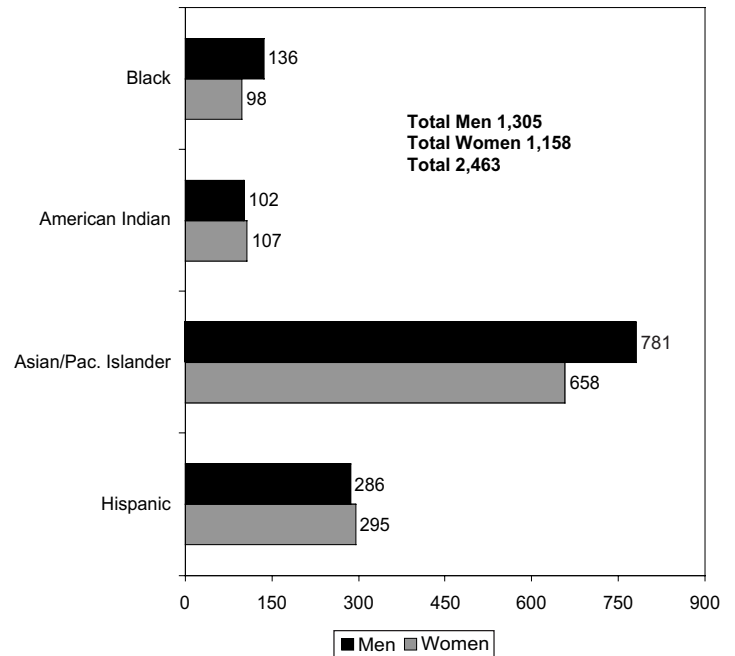

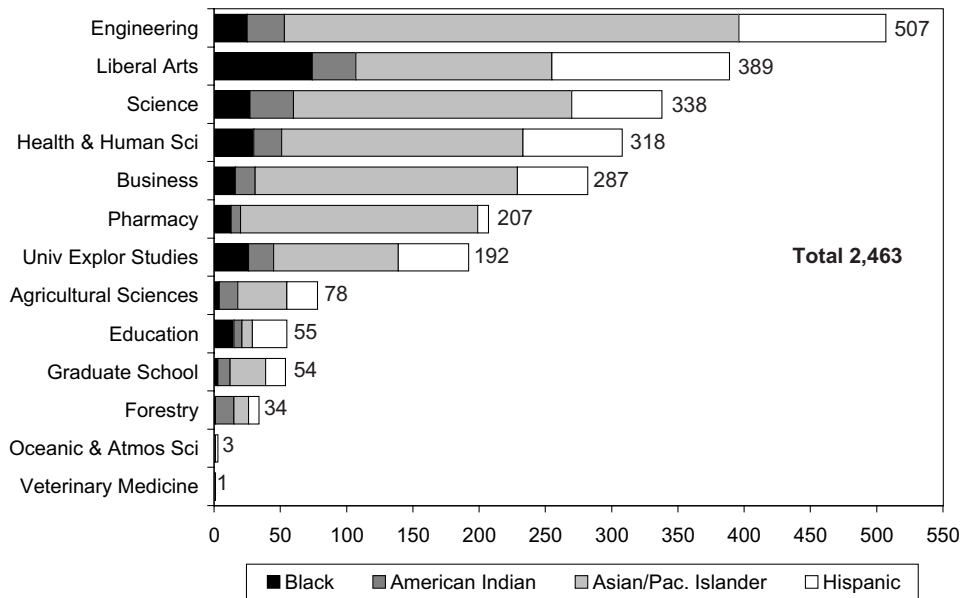
Ethnicity - All Students - by Level



U.S. Minorities by Gender



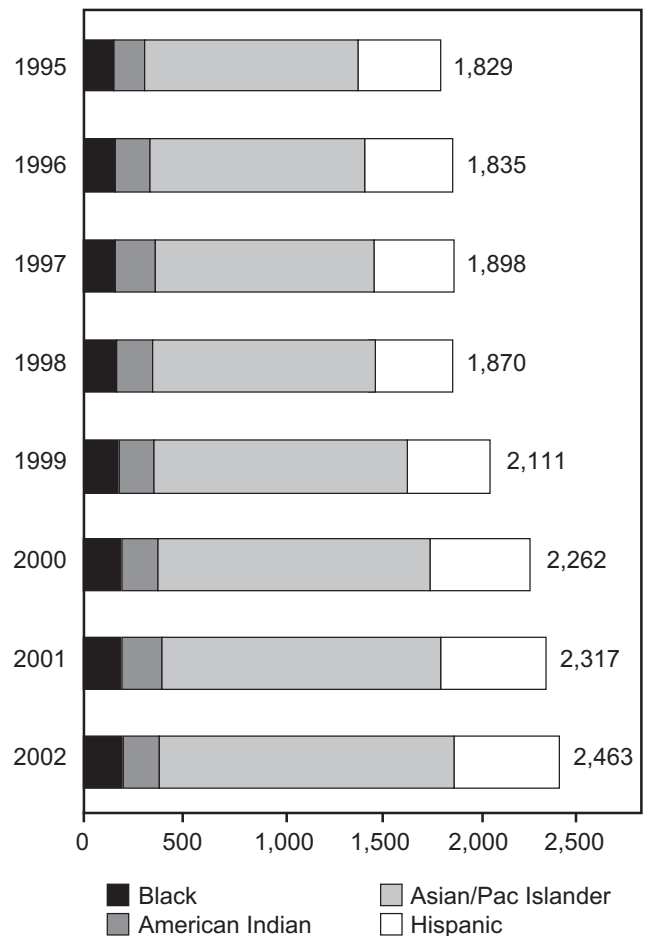

Minority Enrollment Eight-Year Comparison



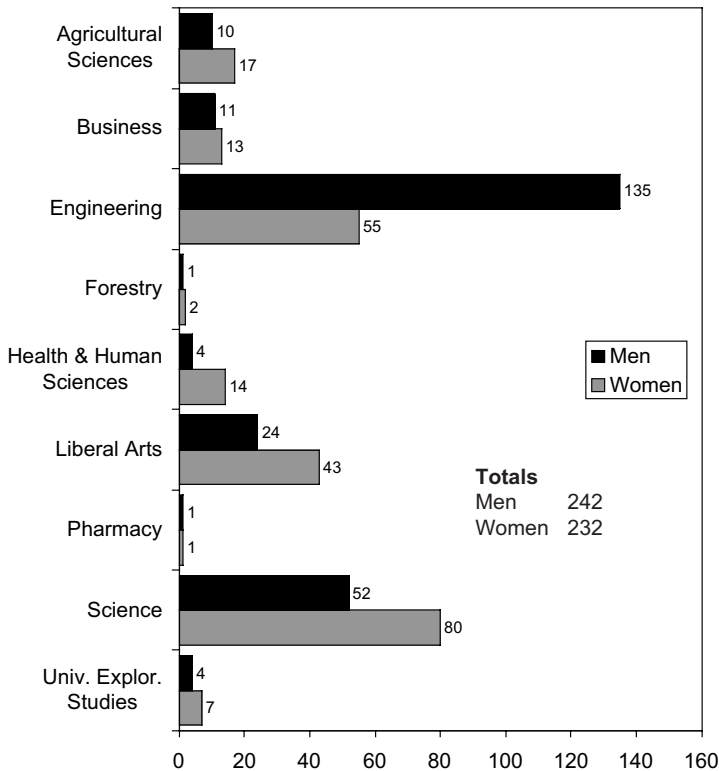

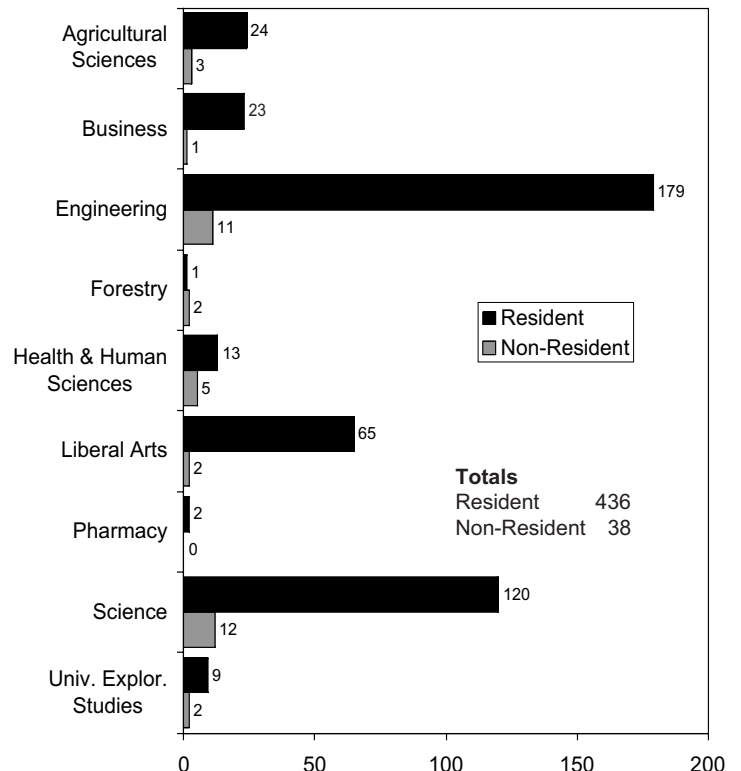

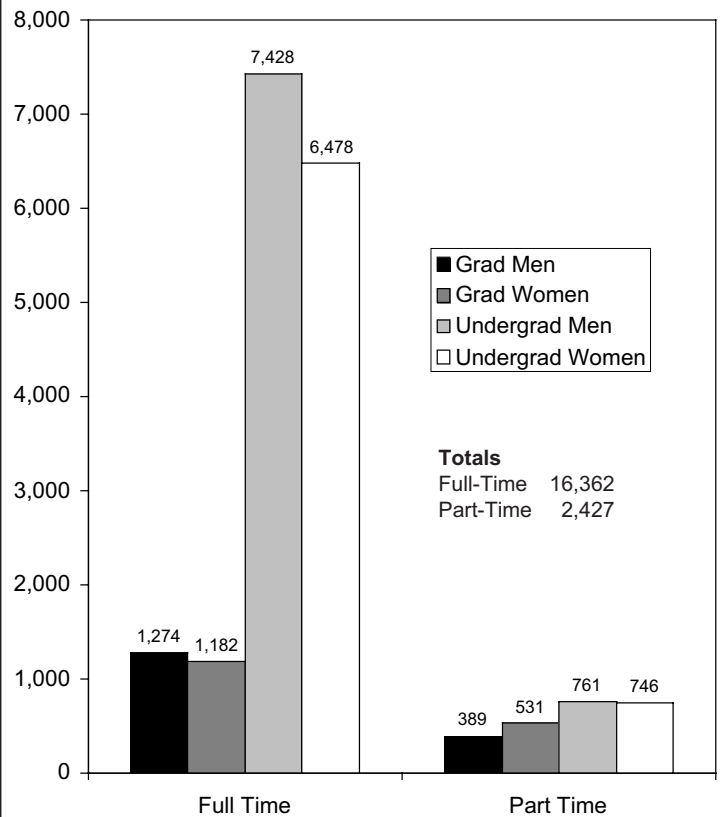

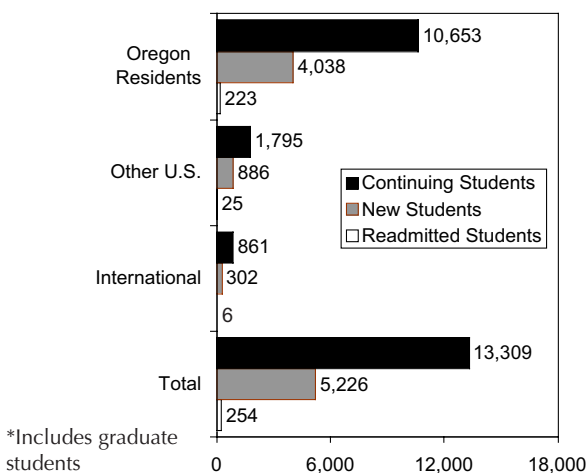
