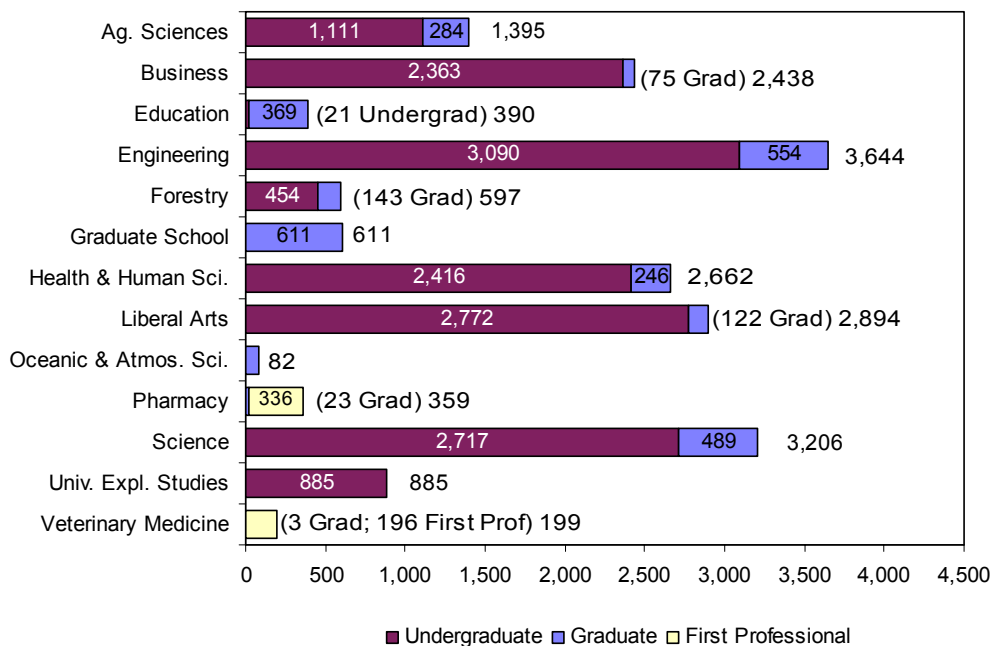

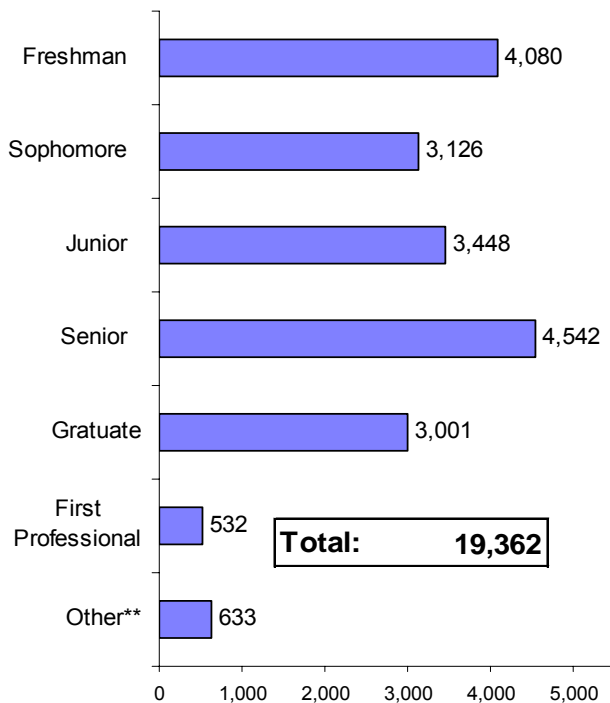

Headcount Enrollment by Class Standing



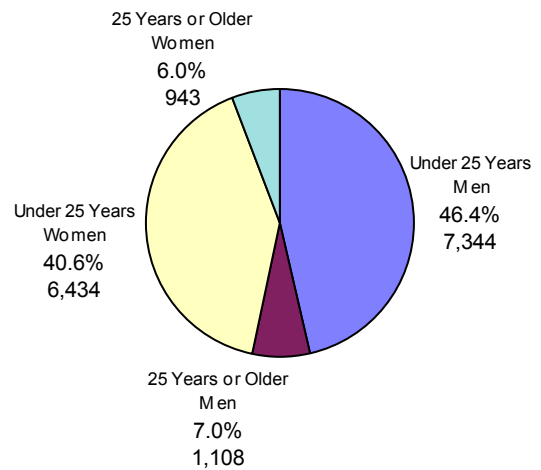

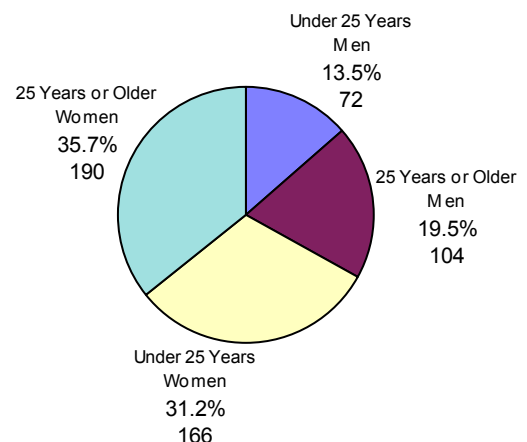

Enrollment by Gender and Student Level

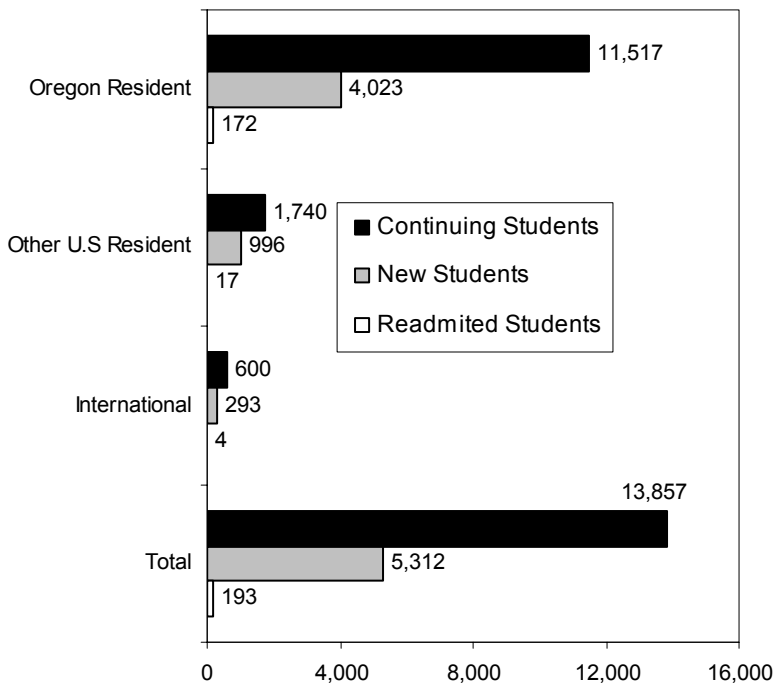


By Residency* and Student Level



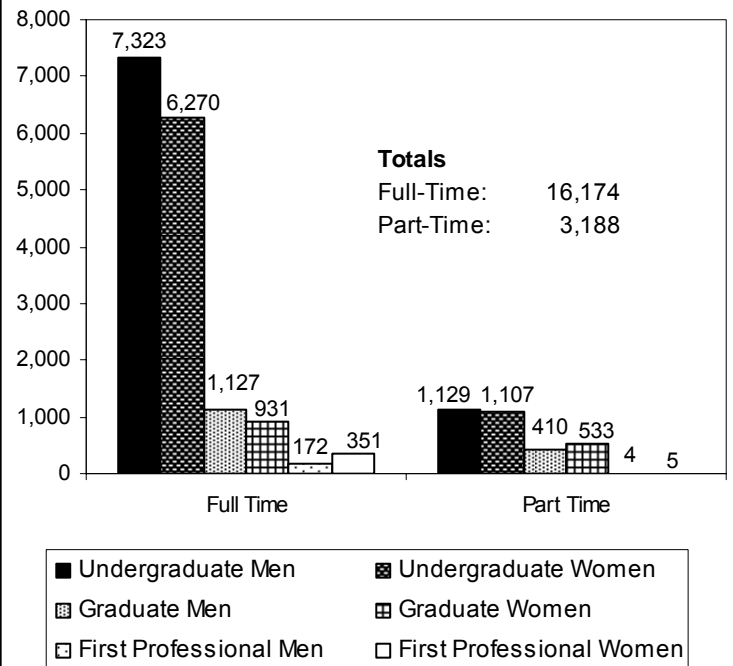

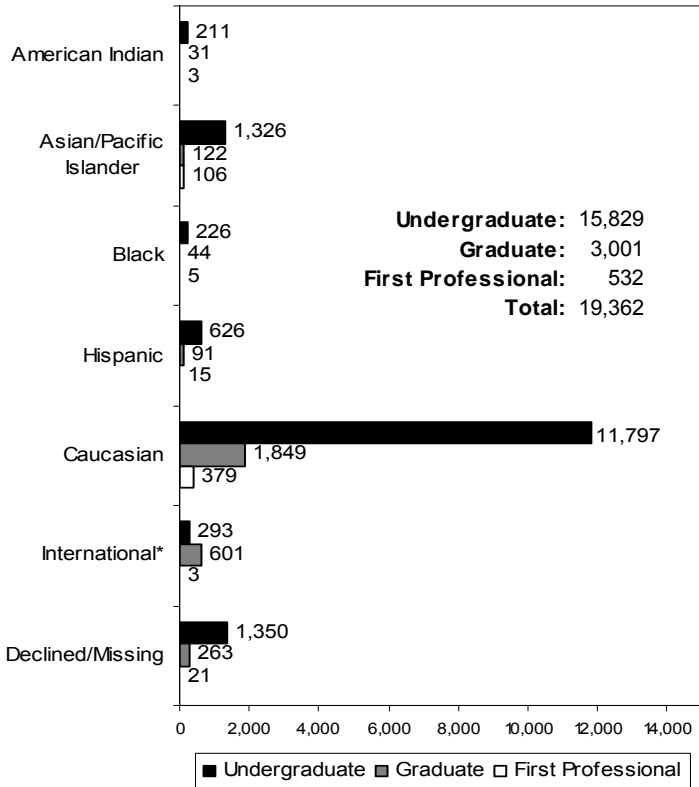
Student Enrollment Full Time and Part Time, by Gender



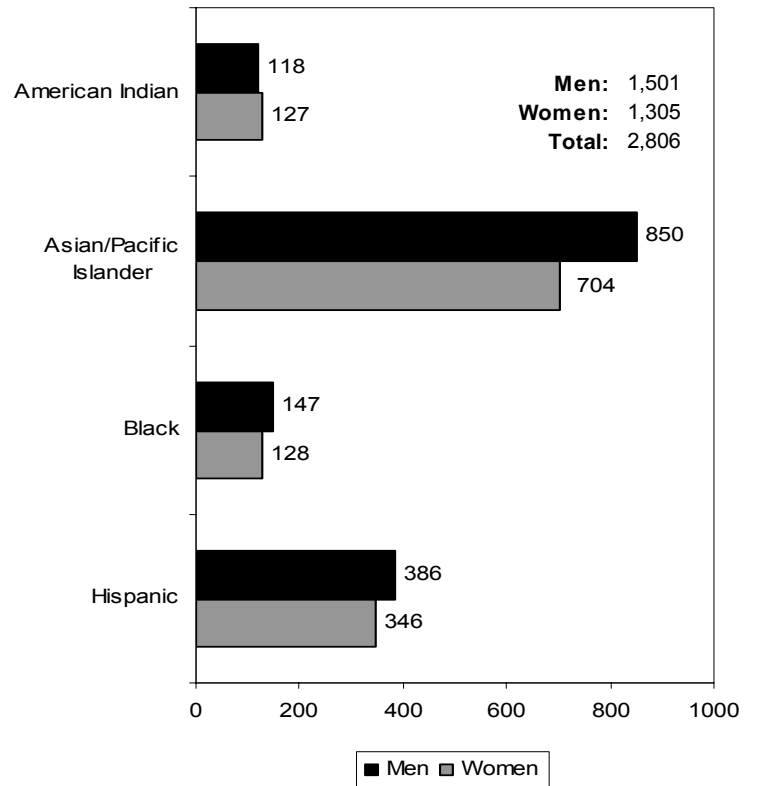

Ethnicity — All Students — by Level

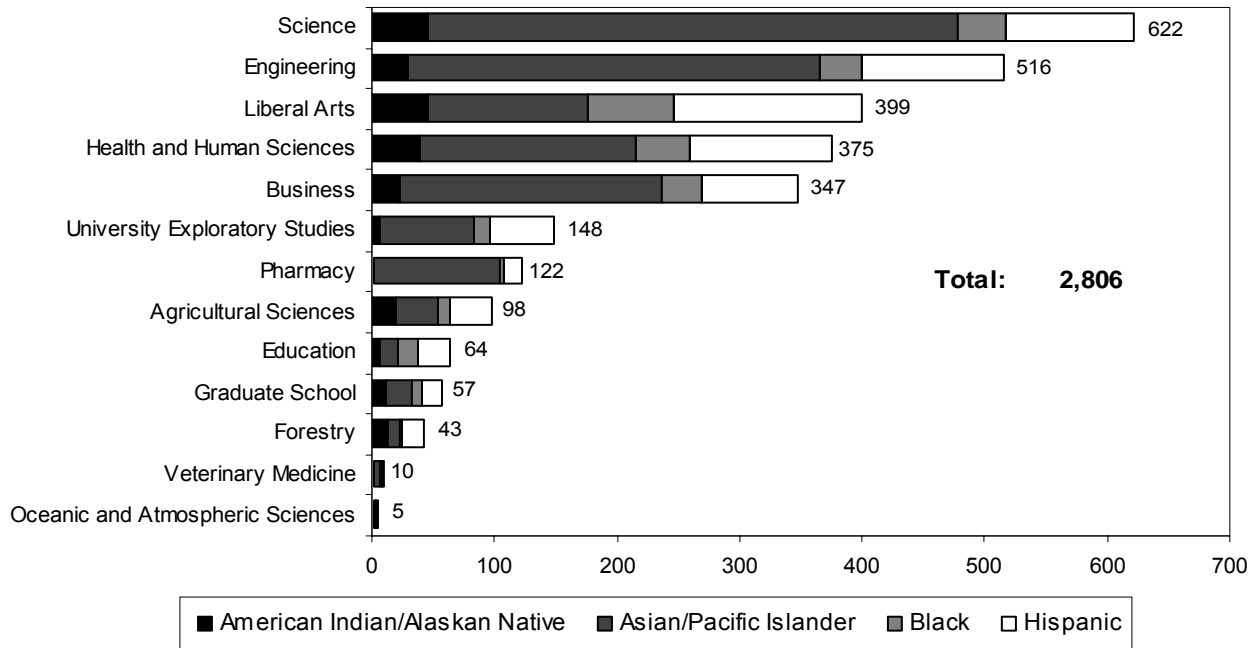


U.S. Minorities by Gender

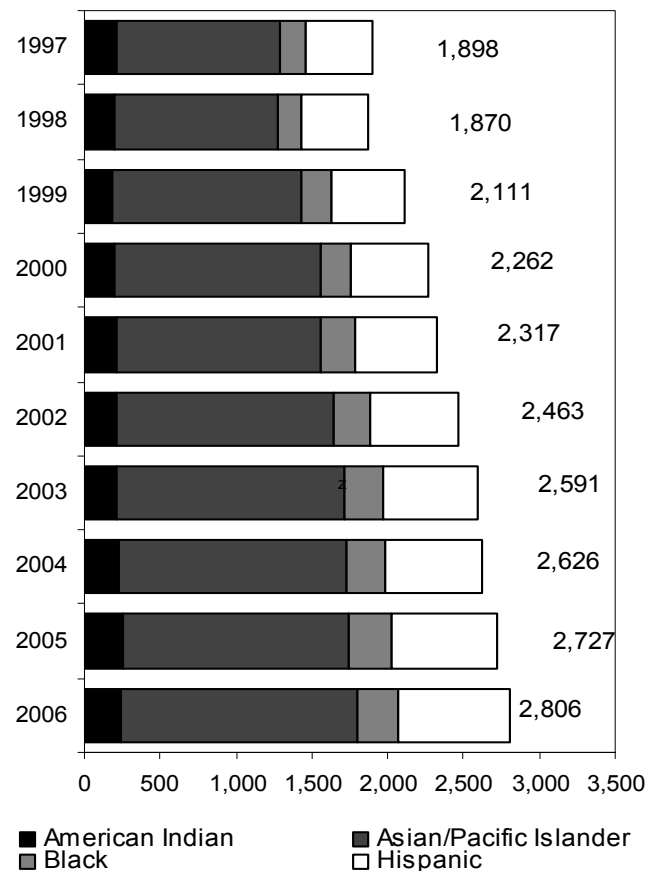

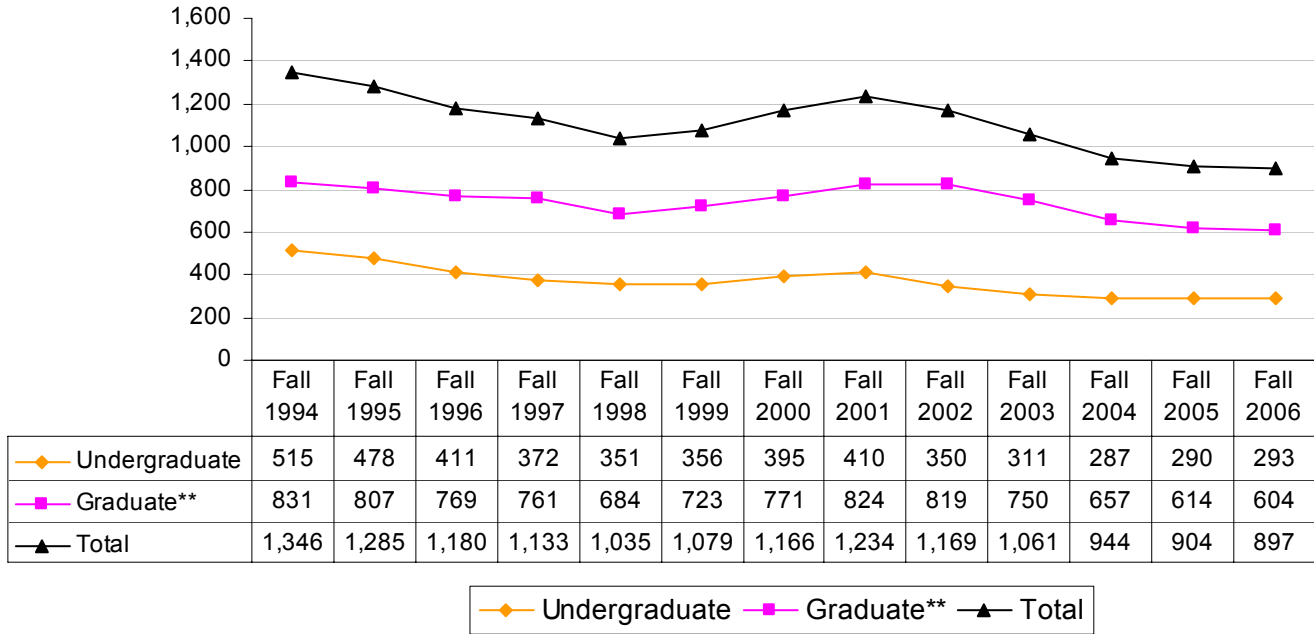

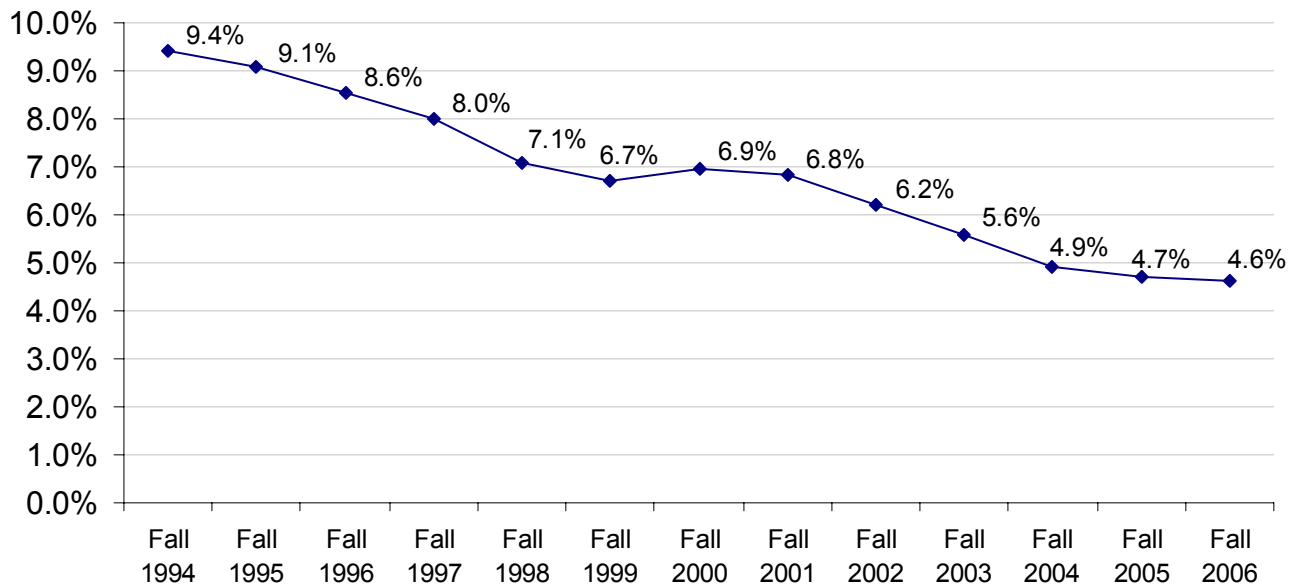
International* Student Enrollment Fall Term 1994 to Fall Term 2006

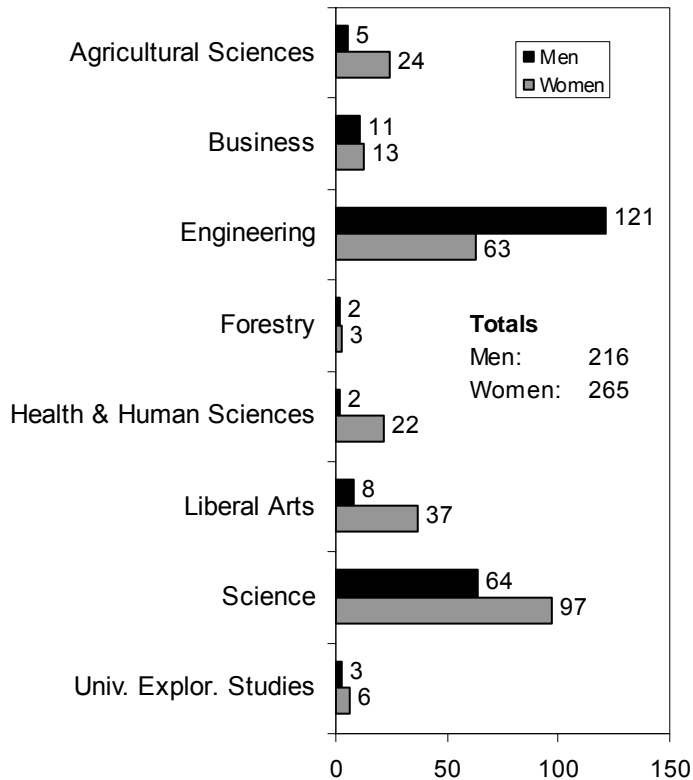

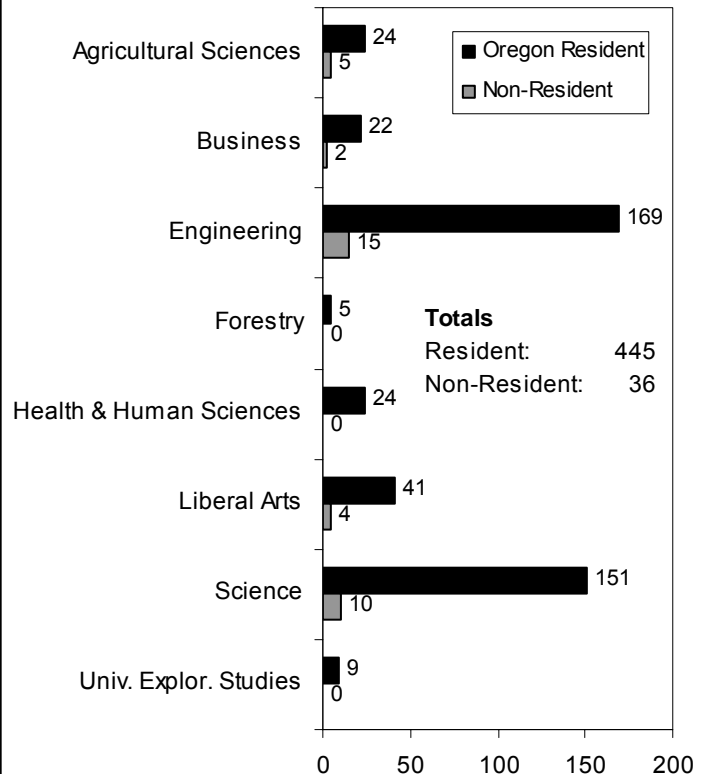

Highlights

- For Fall 2006, total enrollment was 19,362 students.
- When Fall 2005 and Fall 2006 are compared, the total enrollment increased by 126 students, or 0.7% (from 19,236 to 19,362).
- While the headcount increased by 0.7% and the FTE increased by 0.2%, the Student Credit Hours decreased by 0.1%.
- The number of part-time students increased by 4.5% (from 3,050 to 3,188).
- When compared to Fall 2005, the undergraduate enrollment increased by 82 students, or 0.5% (from 15,747 to 15,829); the graduate enrollment increased by 0.8% (from 2,976 to 3,001); the first professional enrollment increased by 3.7% (from 513 to 532).
- When compared to Fall 2005, Oregon residents decreased by 0.2%; students from other U.S. states increased by 6.0%; and international student enrollment decreased by 0.8%.
- The percentage of U.S. minority students was 14.5% of the total enrollment. The number of minority students increased by 2.9% when compared to Fall 2005 (from 2,727 to 2,806).
- The College of Engineering had the largest student enrollment (3,644) when compared to the other academic units.
- OSU Extended Campus had 2,704 students, an increase of 7.8% over Fall 2005. These students took 10,877 credits, of which 40.7% were from the College of Liberal Arts, while 25.3% were from the College of Science.
- University Honors College had an enrollment of 481.
