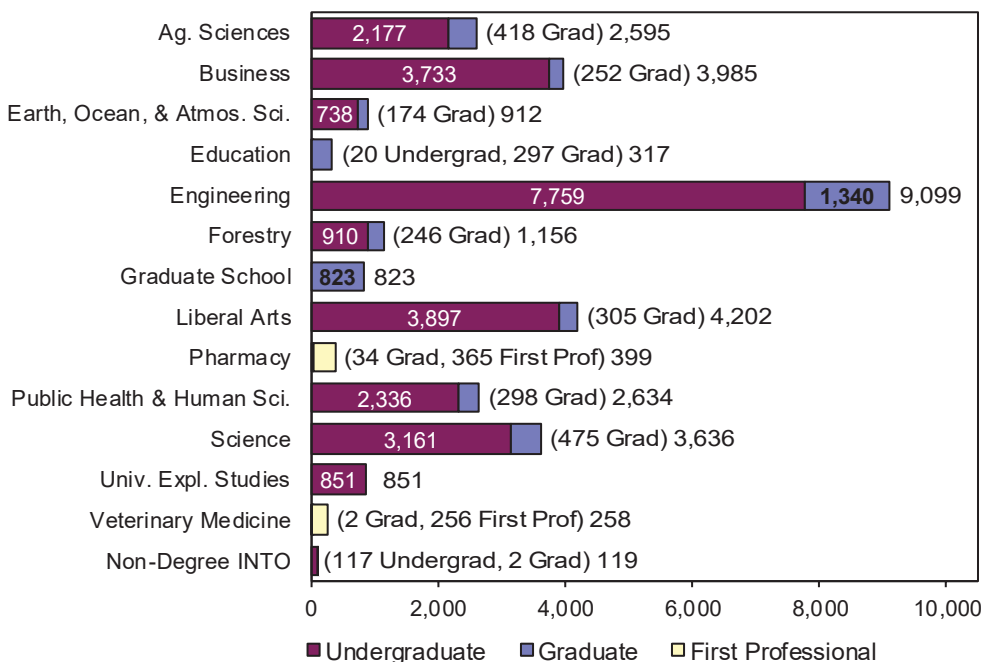

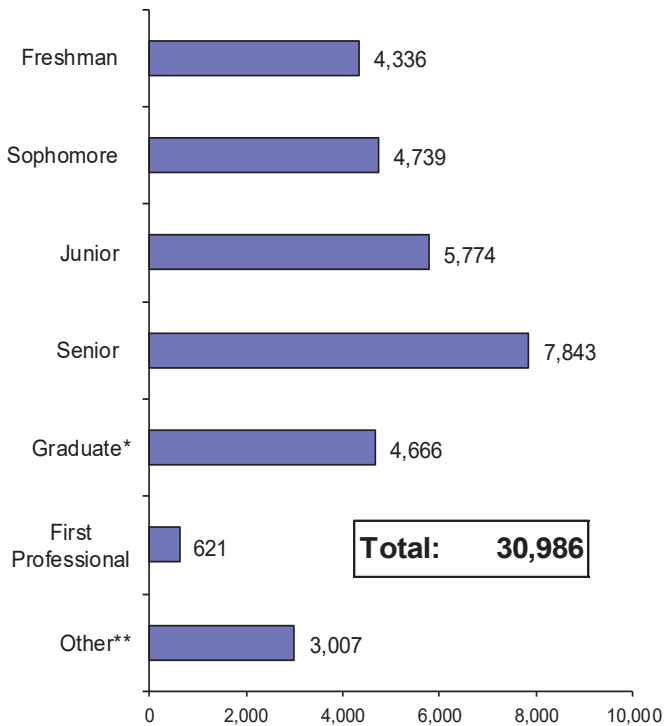

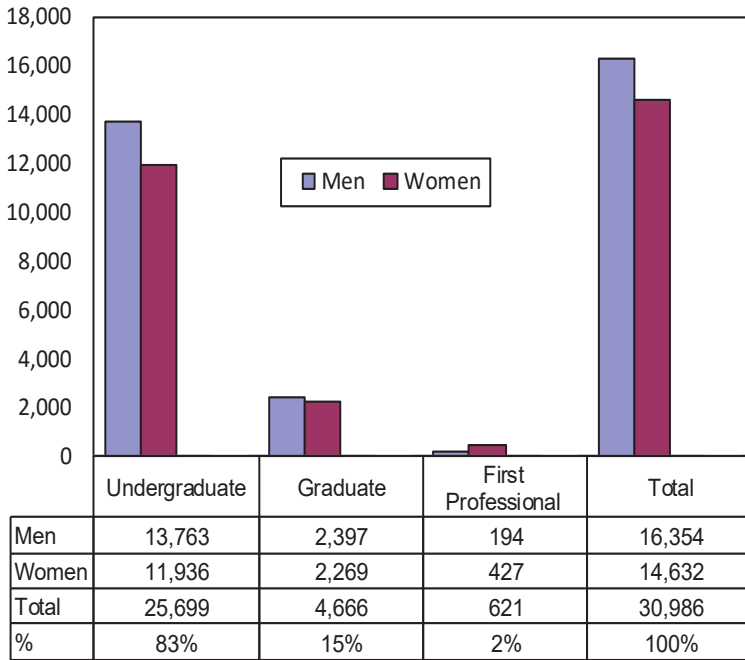

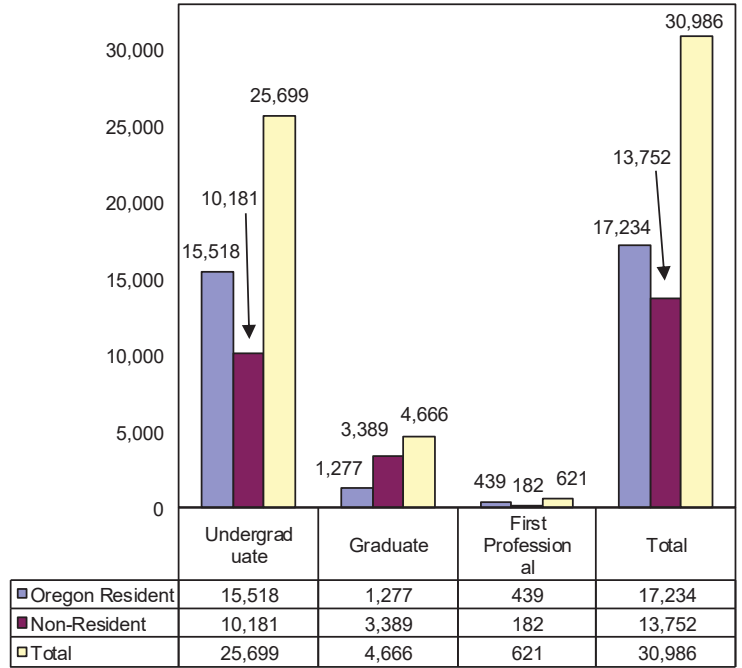

Enrollment by Sex—Binary and Student Level

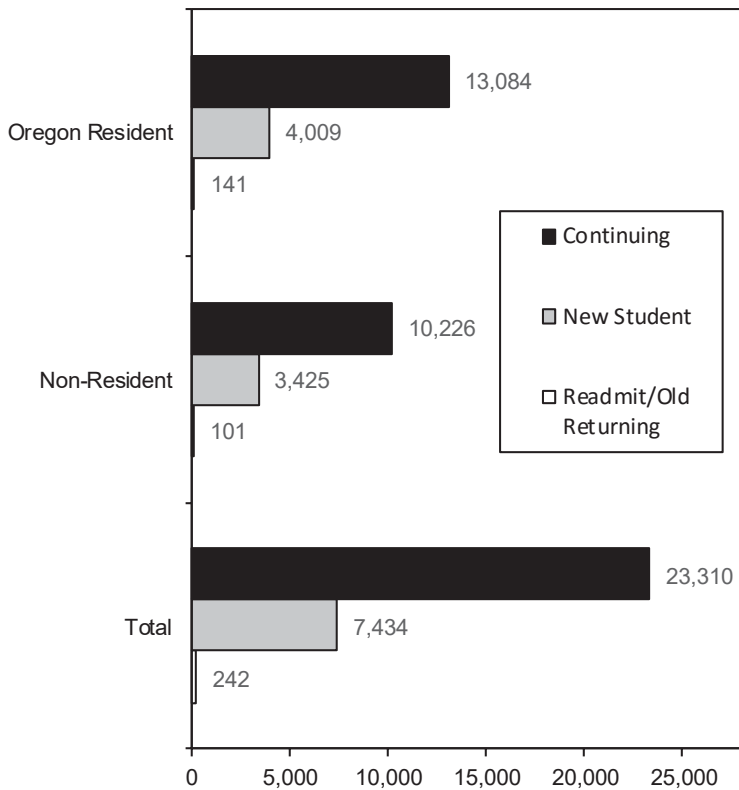


By Residency* and Student Level



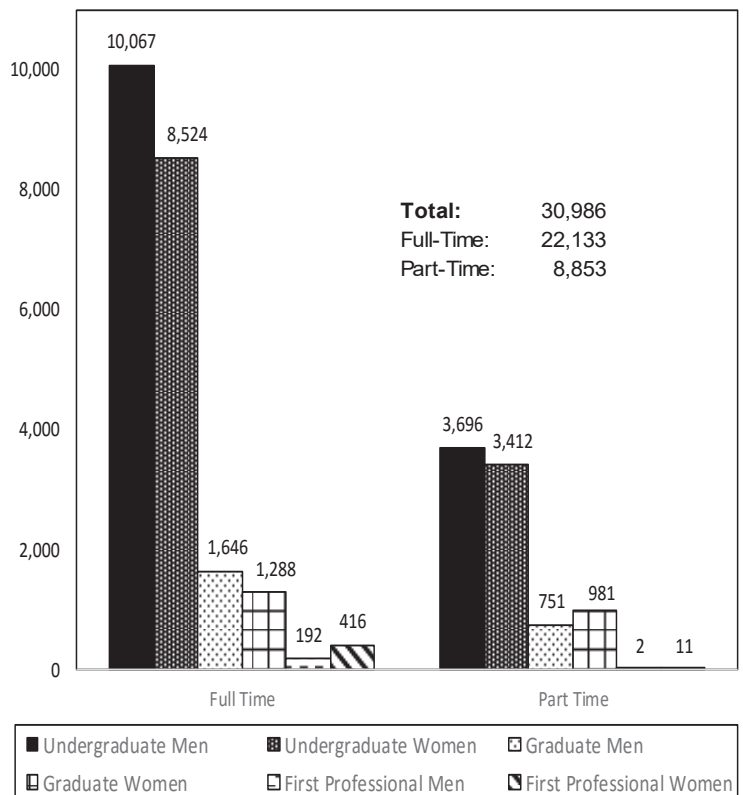

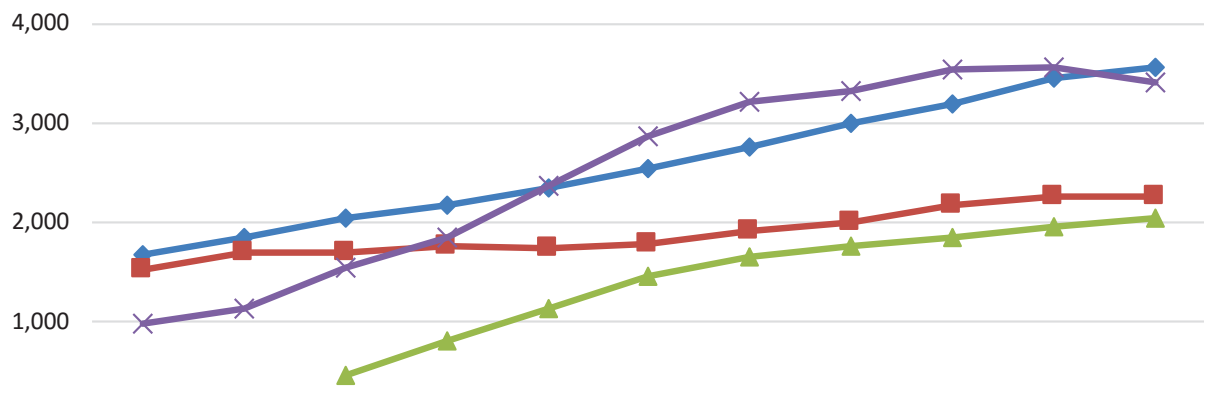

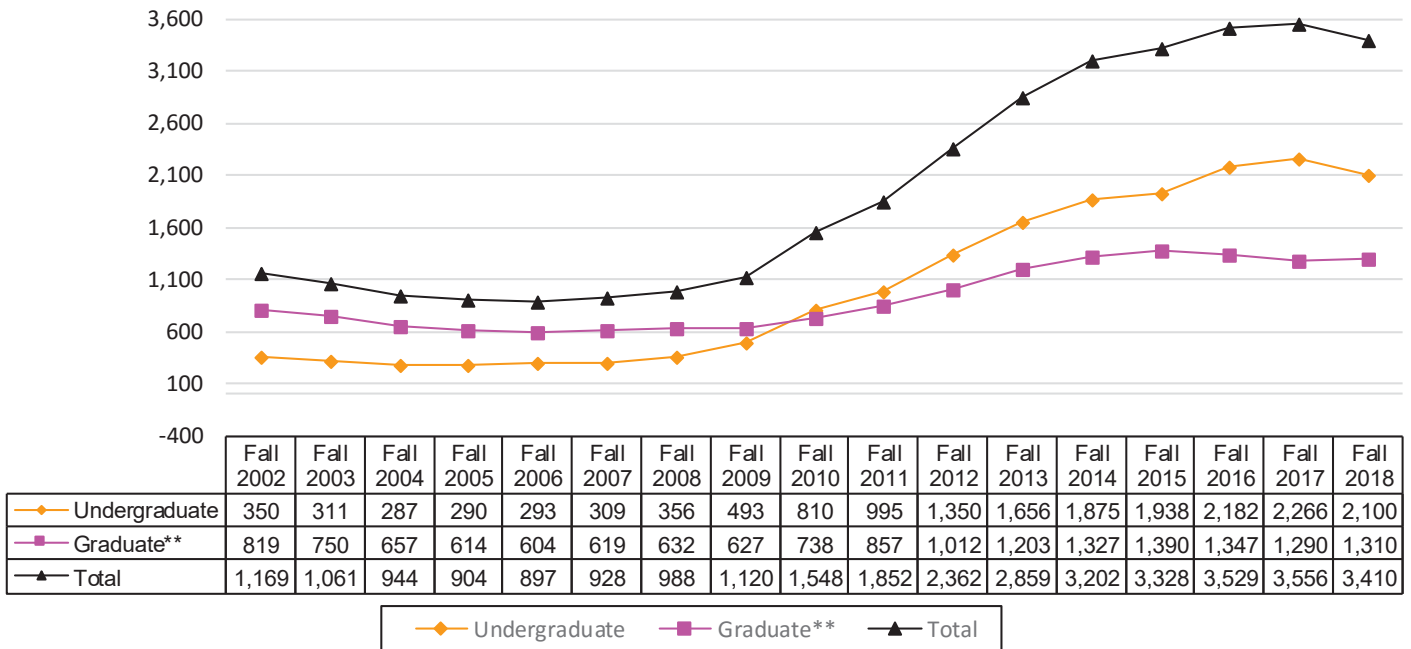

Enrollment by Geographic Origin

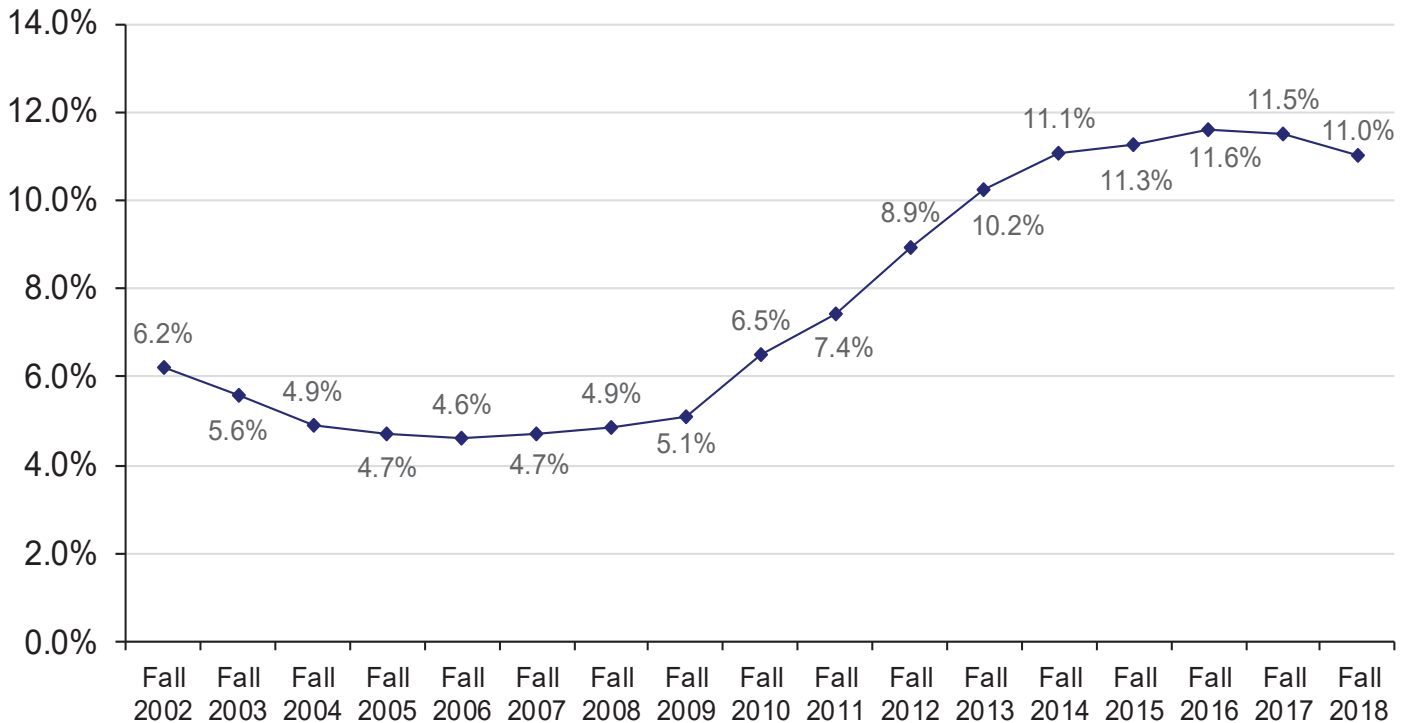

International Student Percent of Total OSU Enrollment



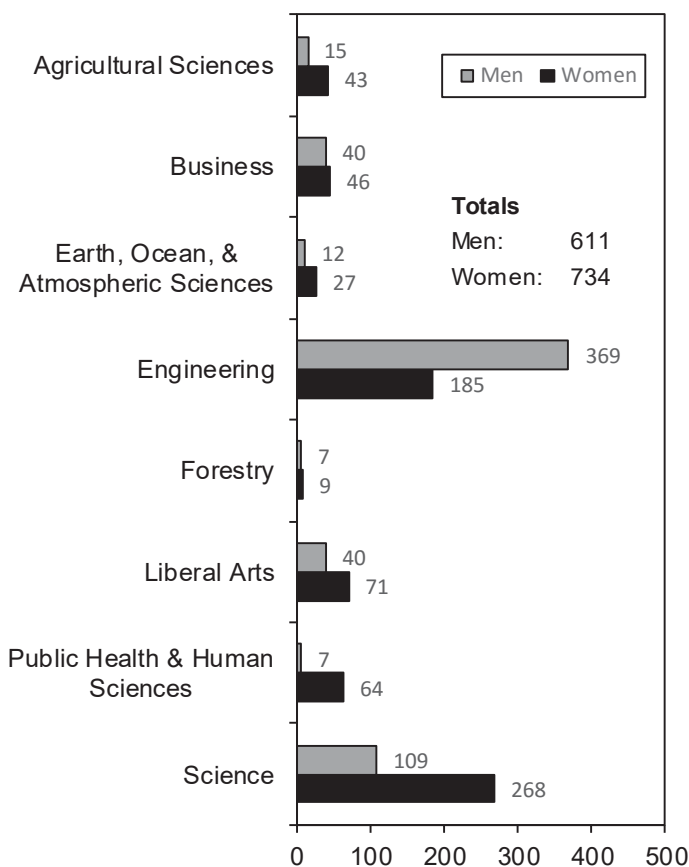

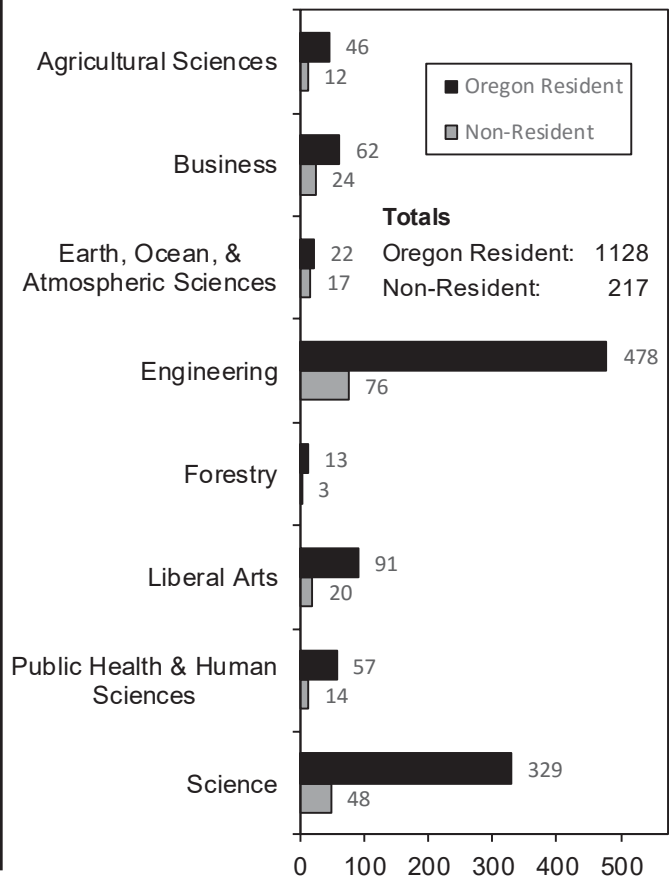

Highlights

- For Fall 2018, total enrollment was 30,986 students.
- When Fall 2017 and Fall 2018 are compared, the total enrollment increased by 90 students or 0.3% (from 30,896 to 30,986), the FTE decreased by 0.5%, and the Student Credit Hours decreased by 0.6%.
- The number of part-time students increased by 4.2% (from 8,494 to 8,853).
- When compared to Fall 2017, the undergraduate enrollment decreased by 140 students, or 0.5% (from 25,838 to 25,698); the graduate enrollment increased by 4.7% (from 4,458 to 4,667); the first professional enrollment increased by 3.5% (from 600 to 621).
- When compared to Fall 2017, Oregon residents decreased by 3.3%; non-resident increased by 5.2%; and international student enrollment decreased by 4.1%.
- INTO OSU had a total enrollment of 779: 212 in Academic English program, 204 in INTO OSU Graduate Pathways, 4 in OSU-Student-Cap, 12 in Study Abroad, and 347 in Undergraduate Pathway program.
- University Honors College had an enrollment of 1,345.
- The College of Engineering had the largest student enrollment (9,099) when compared to the other academic units.
- OSU Extended Campus had 13,482 students, an increase of 5.9% compared to Fall 2017. These students took 75,869 credits, of which 29.2% were from the College of Liberal Arts, while 16.0% were from the College of Engineering.
- The percentage of U.S. minority students was 25.4% of the total enrollment. The number of minority students increased by 2.6% when compared to Fall 2017 (from 7,660 to 7,857).
- The most popular undergraduate majors for Fall 2018 were:
 - Computer Science
 - Business Administration
 - Mechanical Engineering
 - Biology
 - Kinesiology
