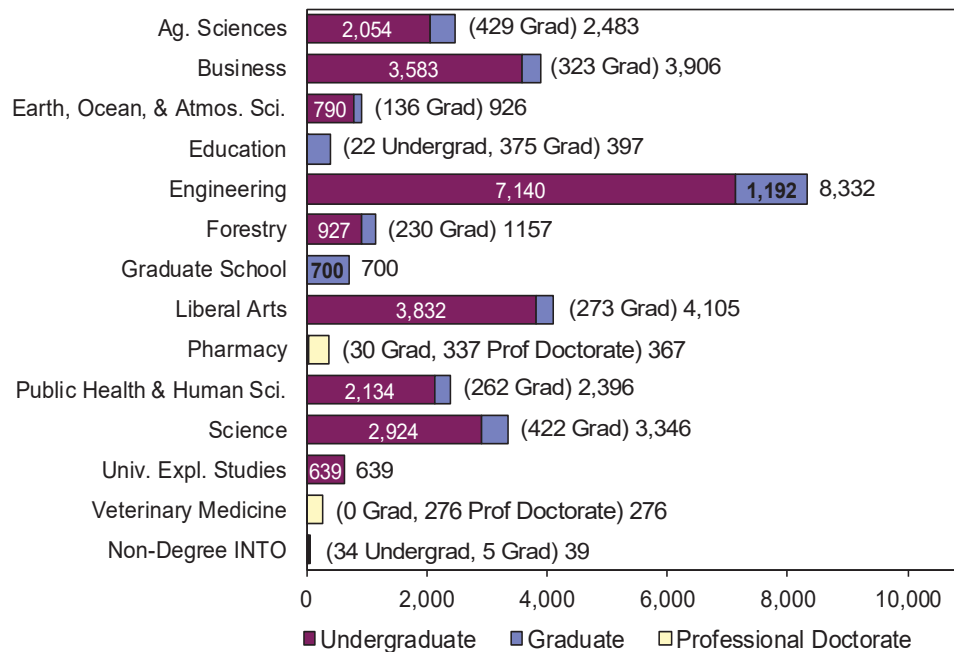

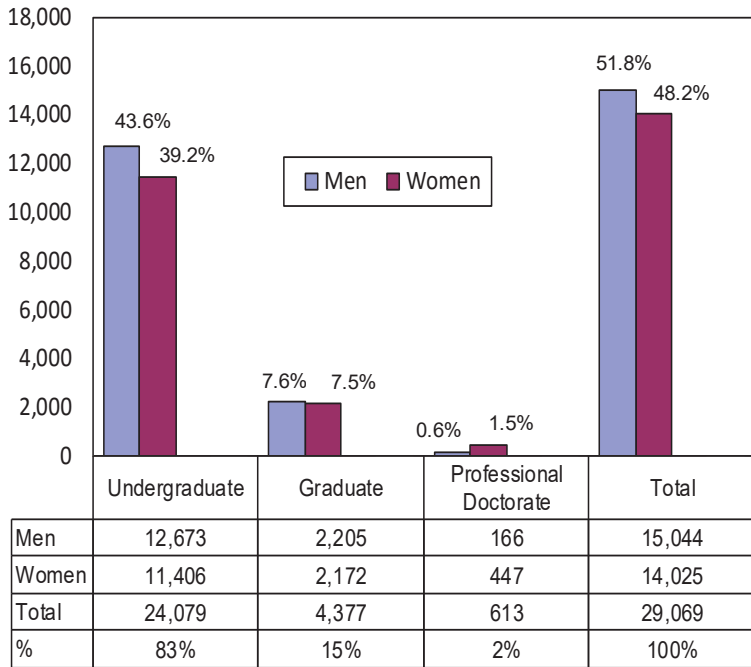

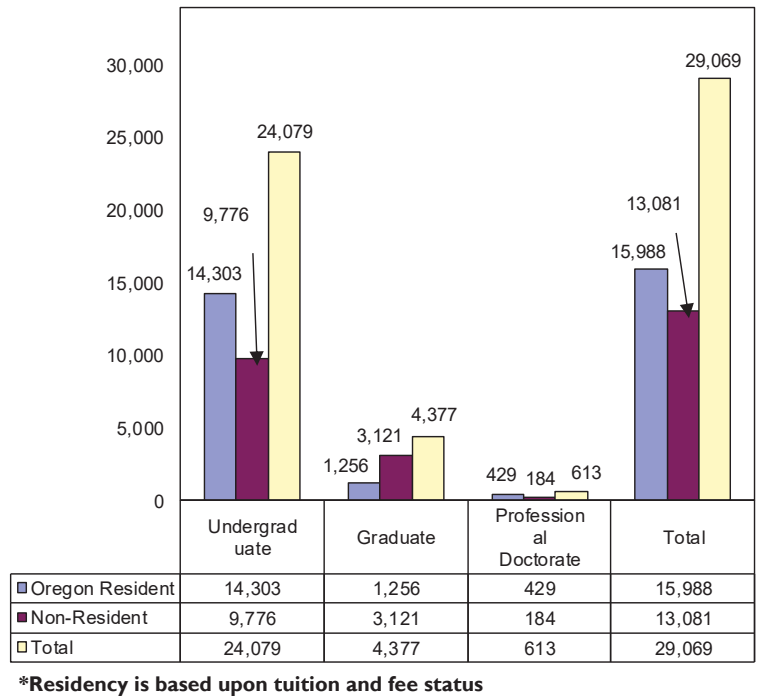

## Enrollment by Sex—Binary and Student Level



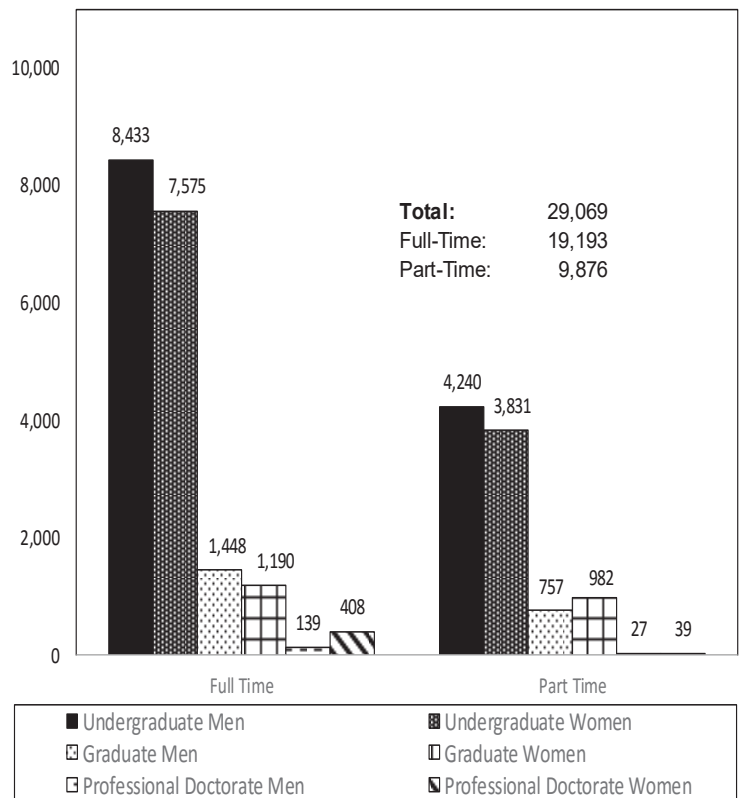

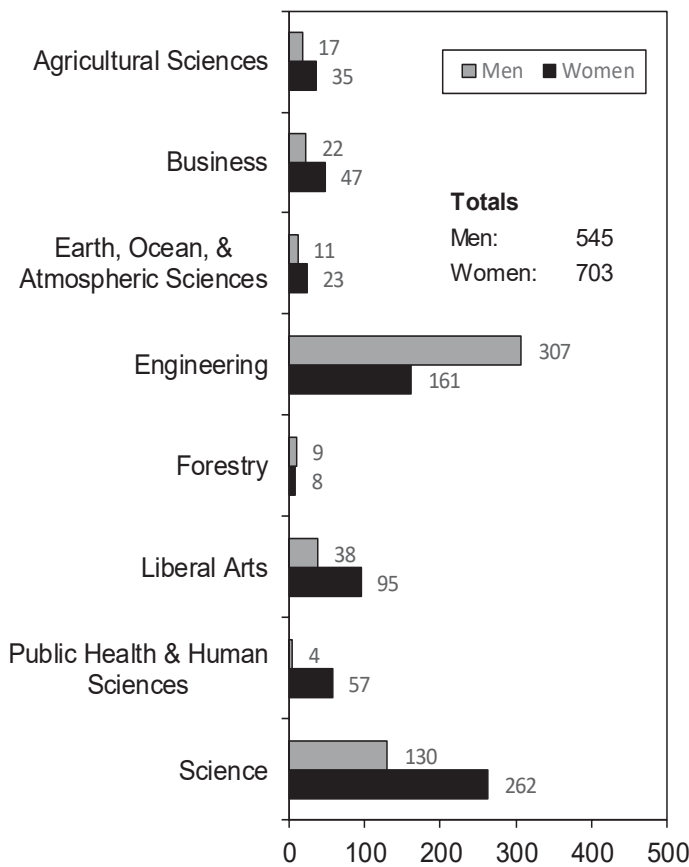

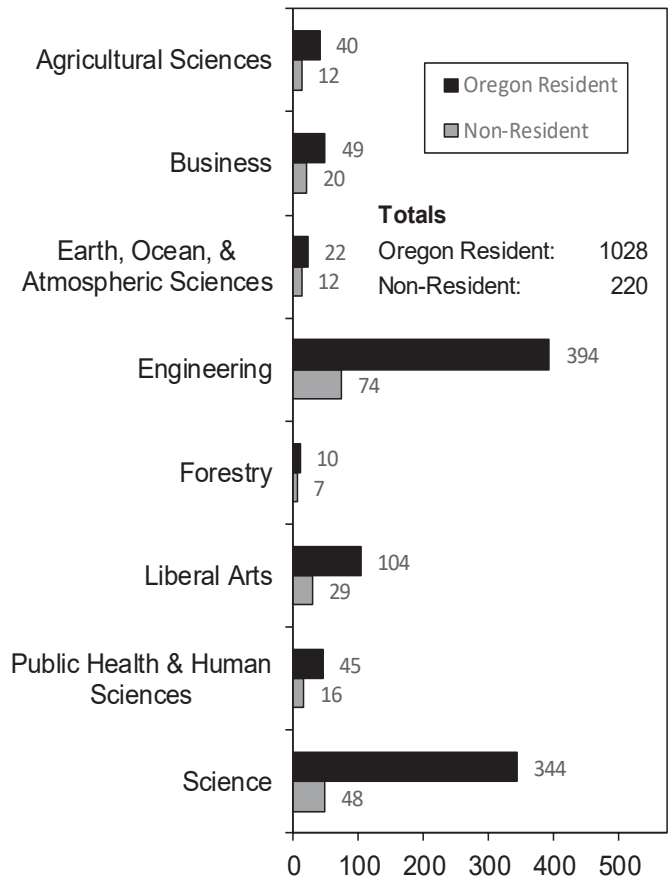

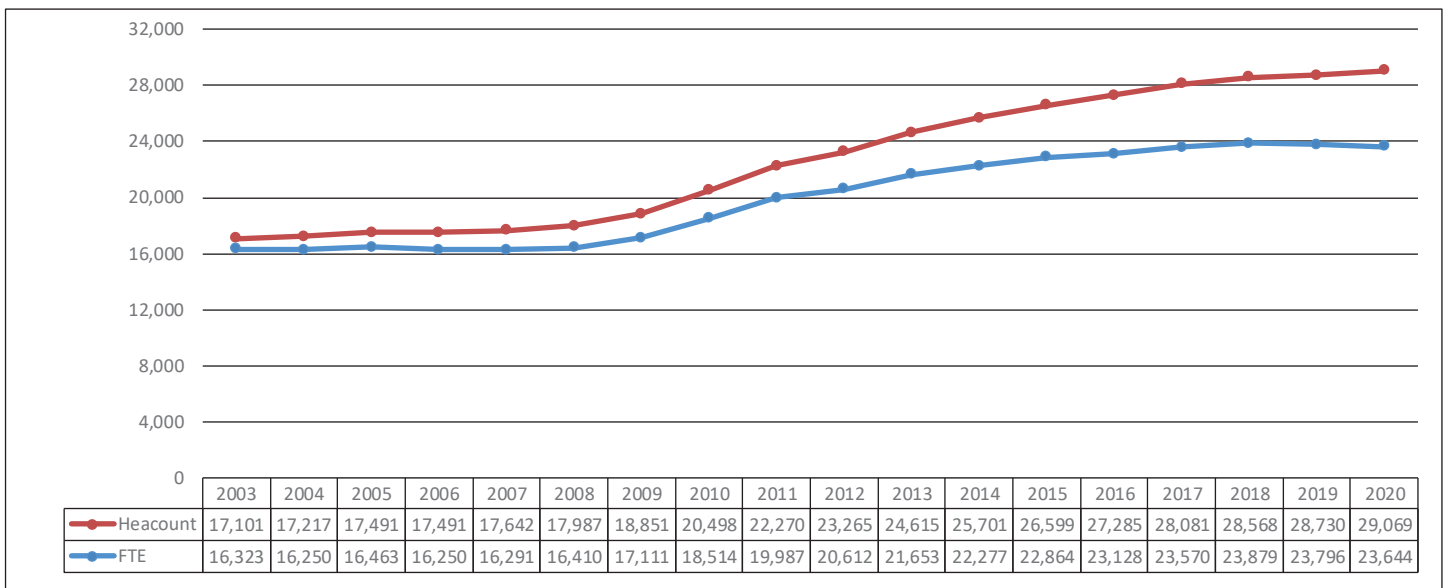

## Highlights

- Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Spring Term courses were offered by remote access. Although we had expected a resulting decline in enrollment, the drop has been negligible, if at all.
- Main Campus headcount enrollment grew by 1.2% compared to last Spring. This growth was primarily fueled by growth in part-time students, many of which are Ecampus students.
- OSU Cascades saw a small drop in headcount/FTE, mostly due to drops in seniors and masters students
- College of Engineering continues to be the largest college – nearly 30% of headcount
