

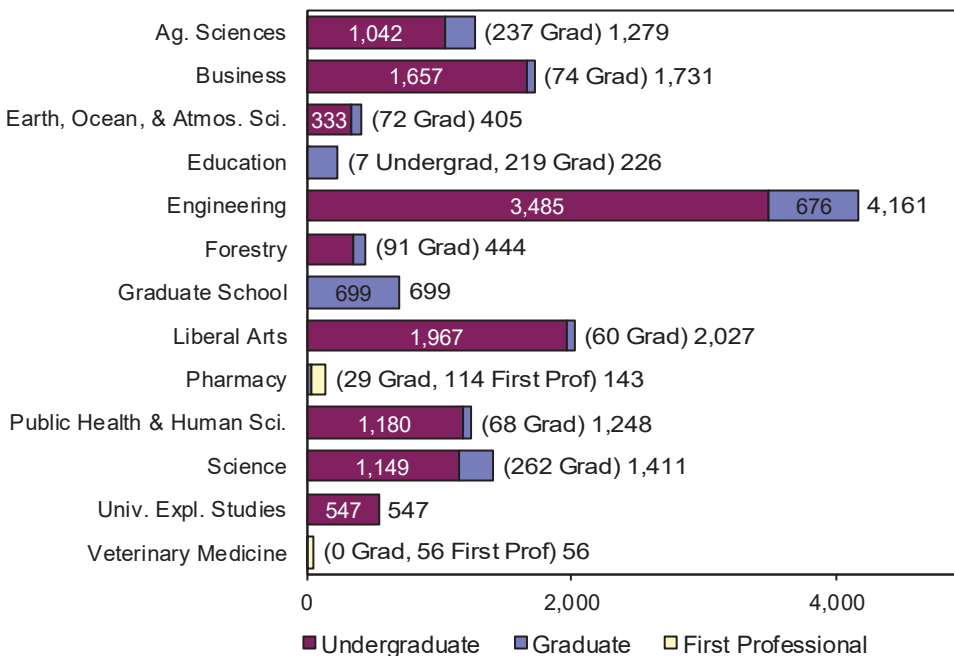

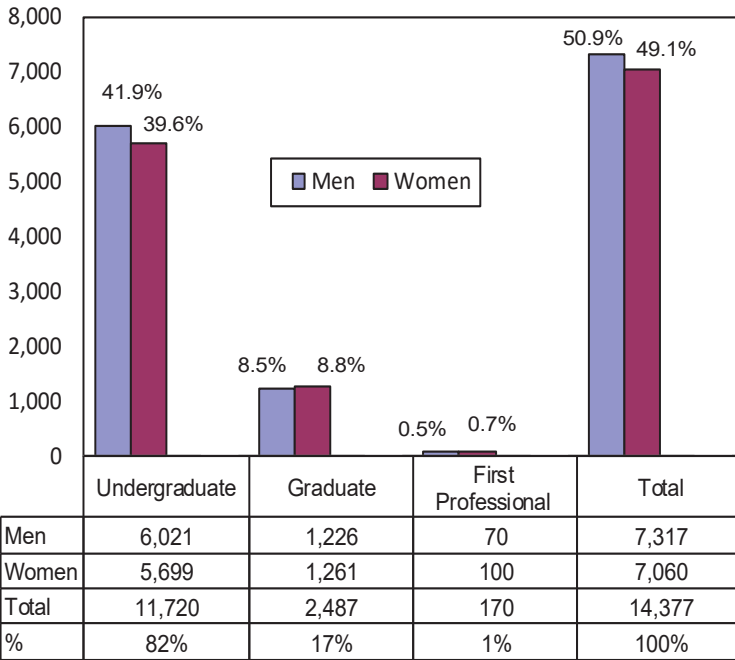

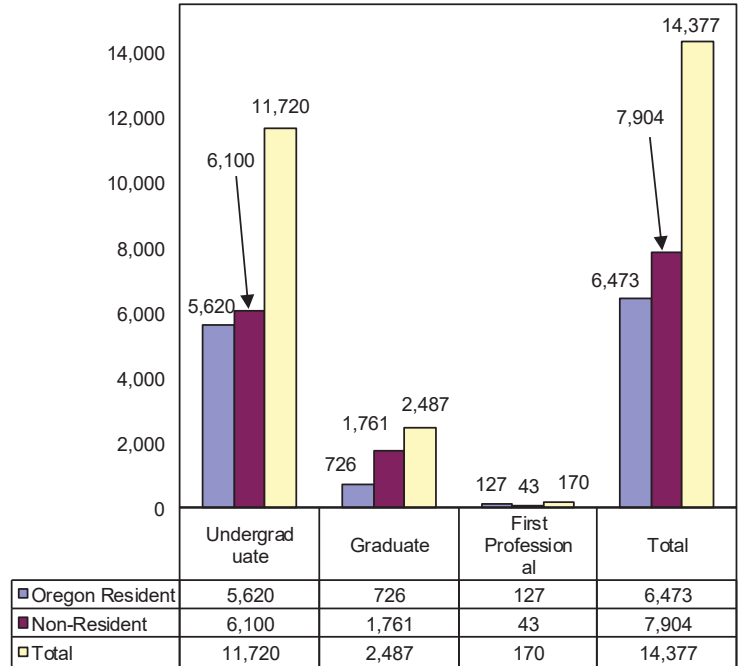

Enrollment by Sex—Binary and Student Level

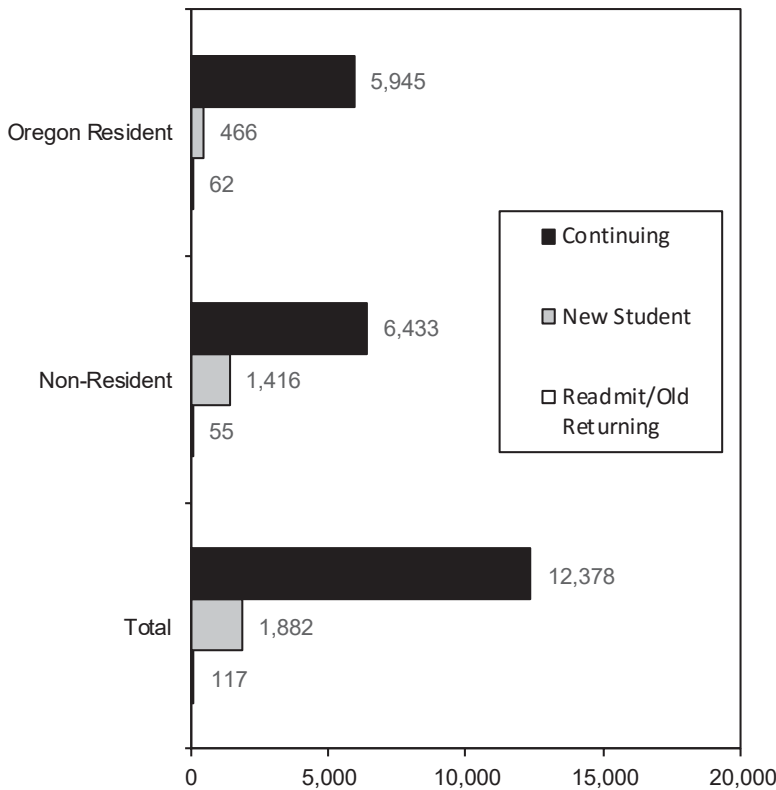


By Residency* and Student Level



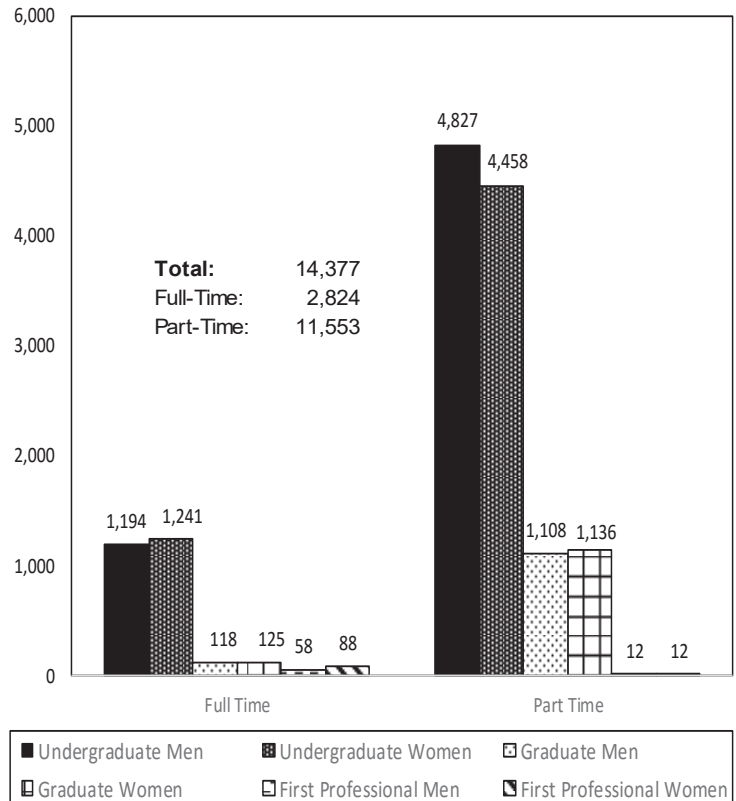

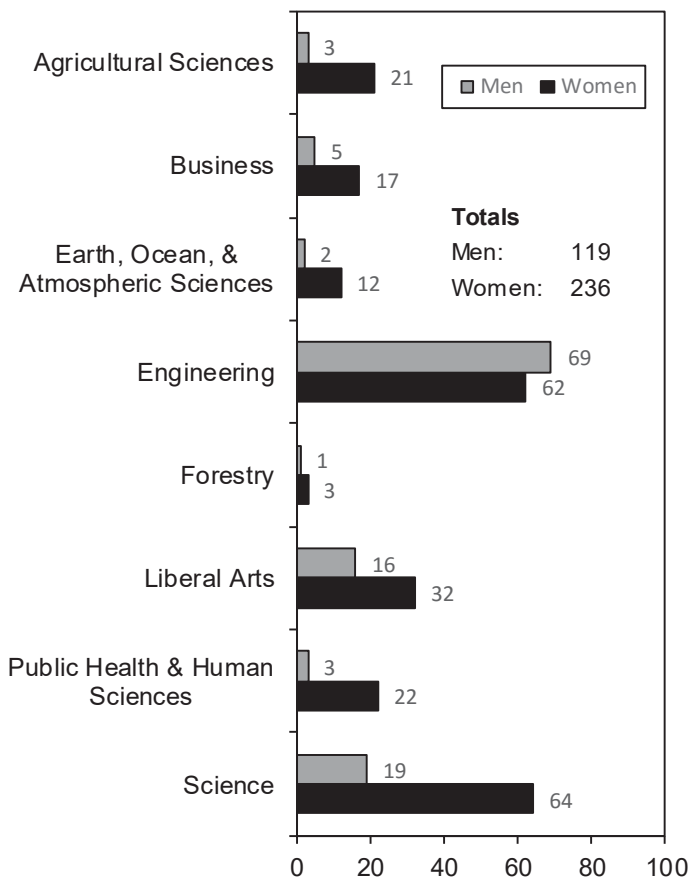

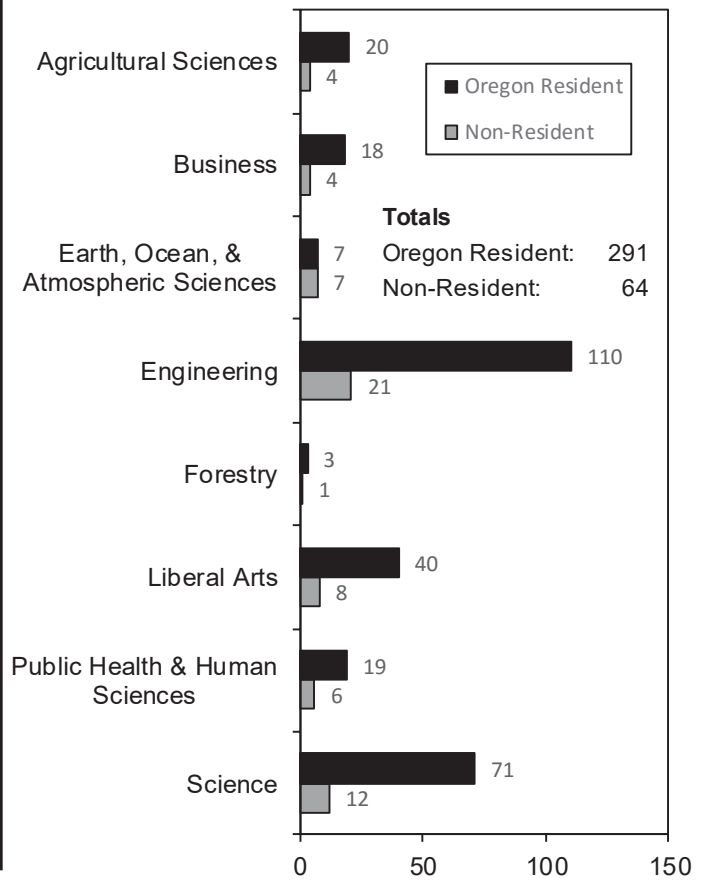

Highlights

- The Summer Session 2018 total enrollment of 14,377 was 328 more than Summer 2017 - an increase of 2.3%.
- There were more male students than female students in Summer 2018. Female students accounted for 49.1% of total students, while male students accounted for 50.9%.
- 80.4% of students were enrolled on a part-time basis.
- The College of Engineering had the largest unduplicated student enrollment (4,161) when compared to the other academic units.
- About 45.0% of the total student credit hours were from the College of Liberal Arts (25.4%) and the College of Science (19.6%).
- OSU Extended Campus had a total enrollment of 9,797 students. These students were enrolled for 57,174 credit hours. About 31.2% of those credit hours were from the College of Liberal Arts.
- 141 new undergraduate students from high school enrolled for courses.
- The percentage of U.S. minority students was 24.2%.

■ For Summer 2018, more students (7,303) enrolled in the Eight Week Session (June 25 - August 17). The Eleven Week Session (June 25 - September 7) had 6,252 students (second-largest enrollment).

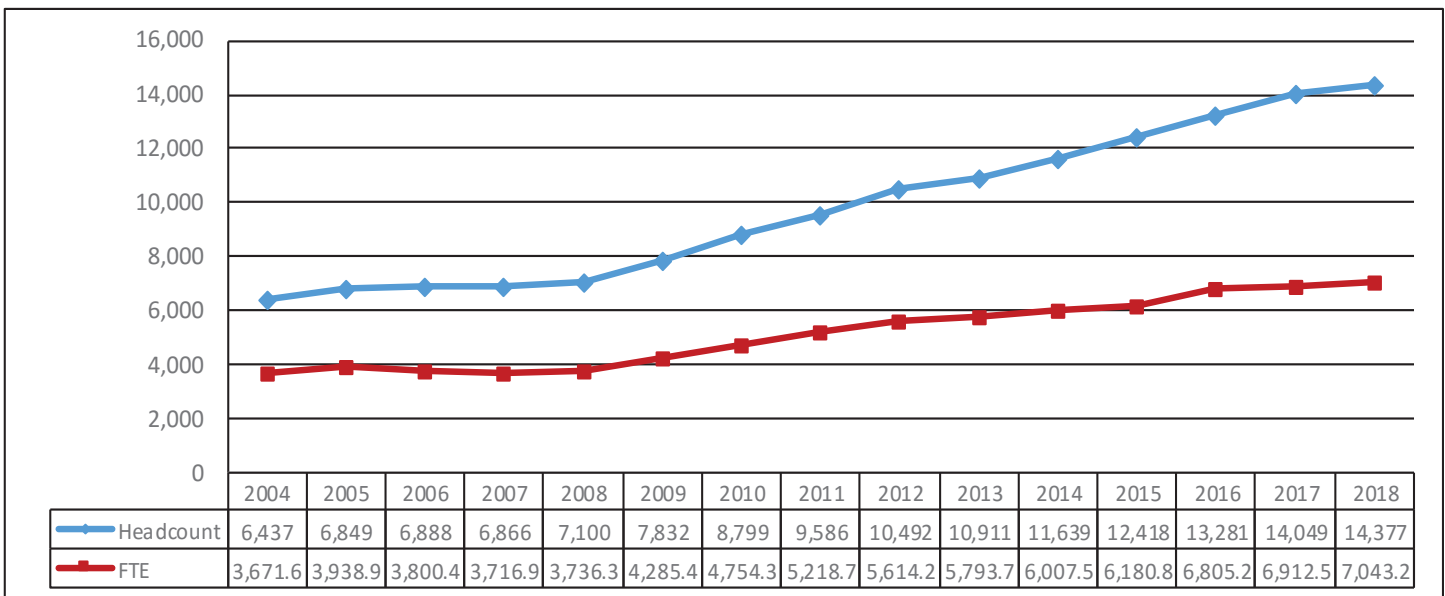
