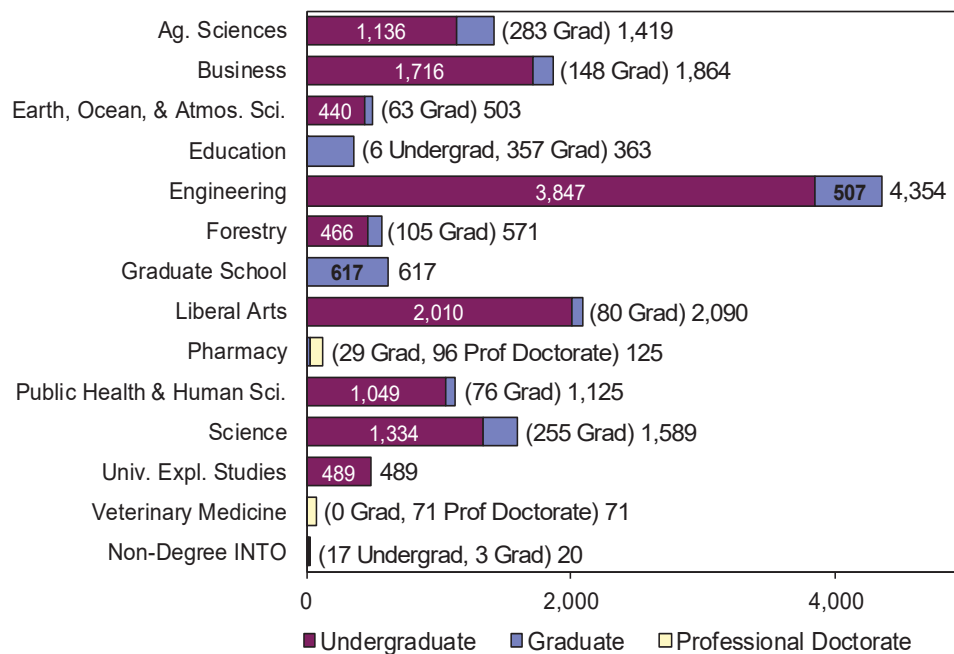

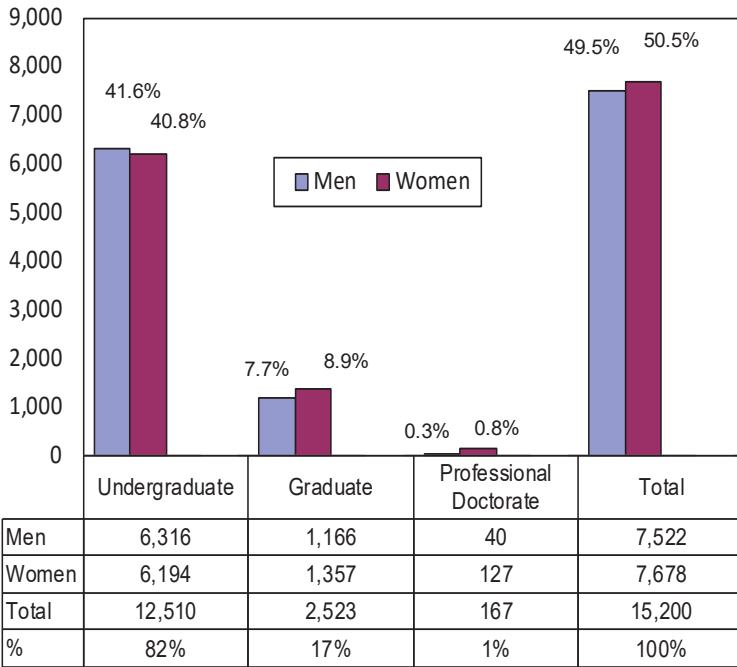

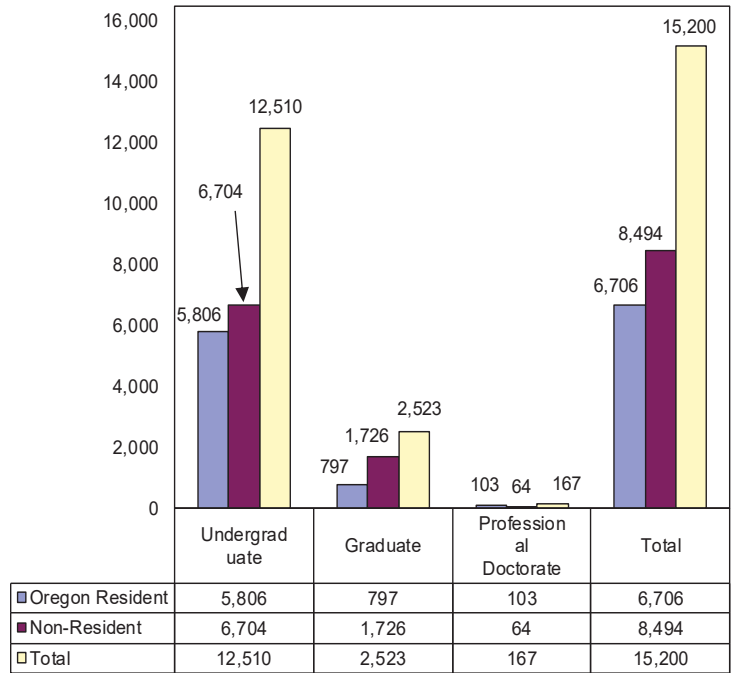

## Enrollment by Sex—Binary and Student Level

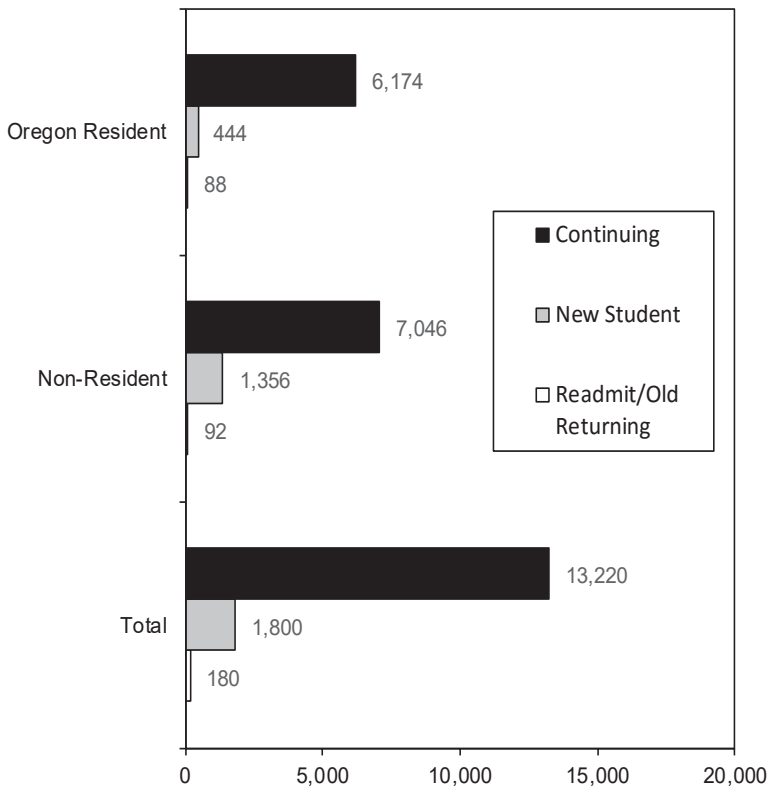


## By Residency\* and Student Level



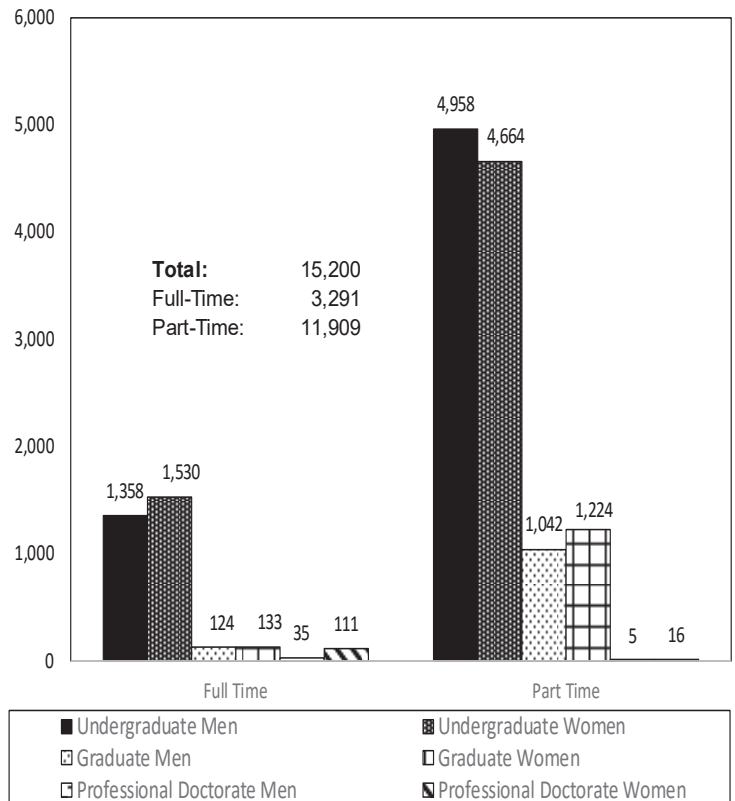

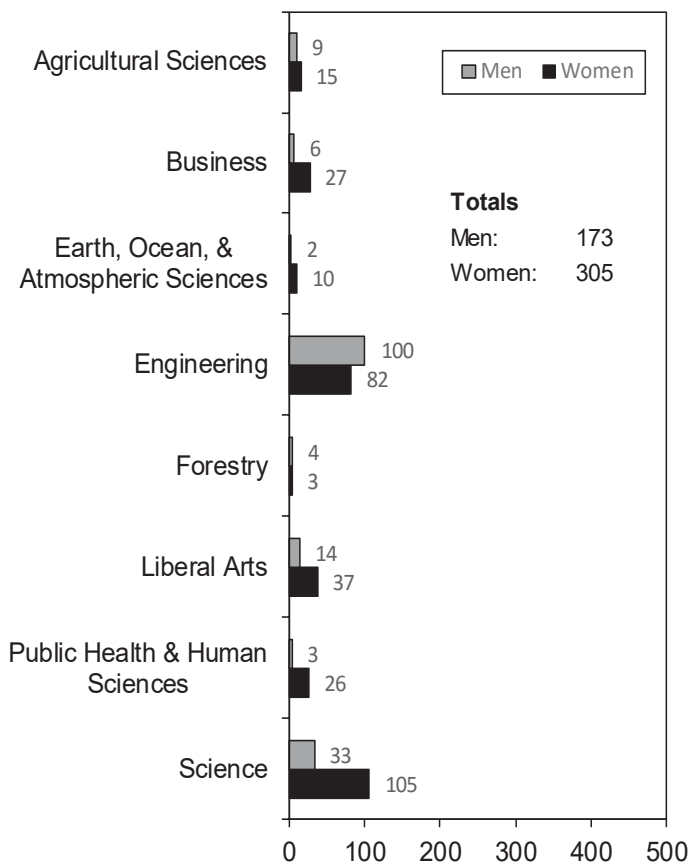

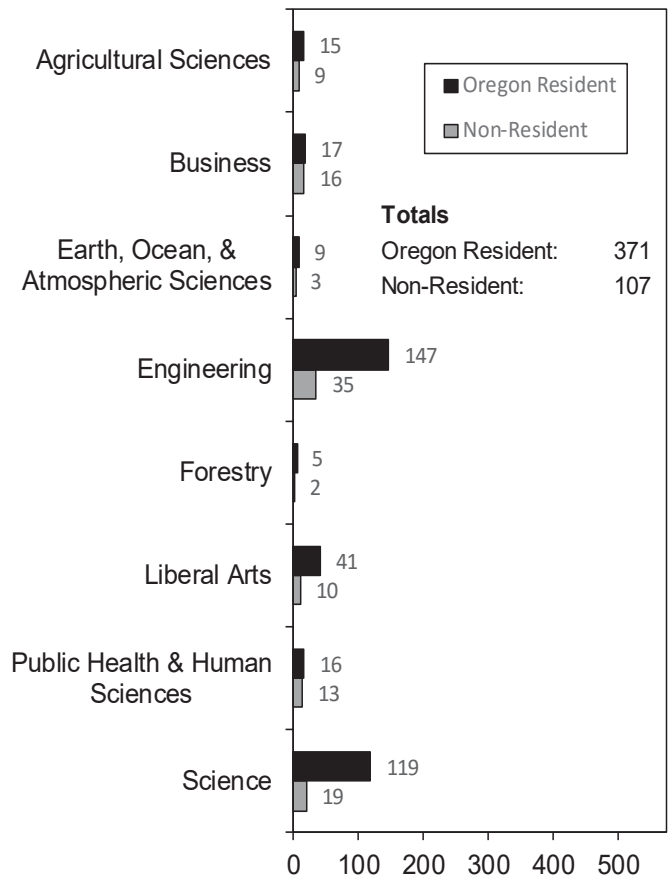

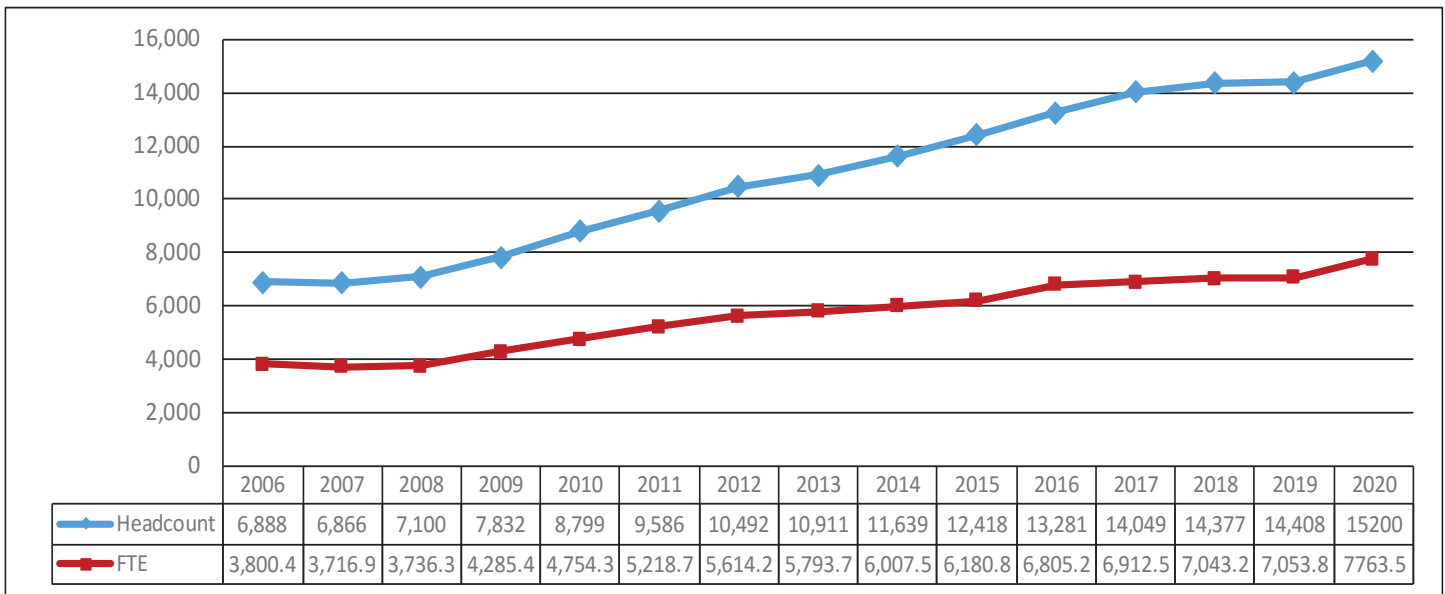

## Highlights

- Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Summer Term courses were offered by remote access.
- Main Campus headcount enrollment grew by 5.5% compared to last Summer, while FTE grew by 10.1%, driven largely by an increase in the number of students taking Ecampus courses.
- OSU Cascades saw an overall drop in headcount/FTE due to a decline in the number of graduate students, which an increase in undergraduate enrollment did not offset.
- College of Engineering continues to be the largest college – nearly 30% of headcount
