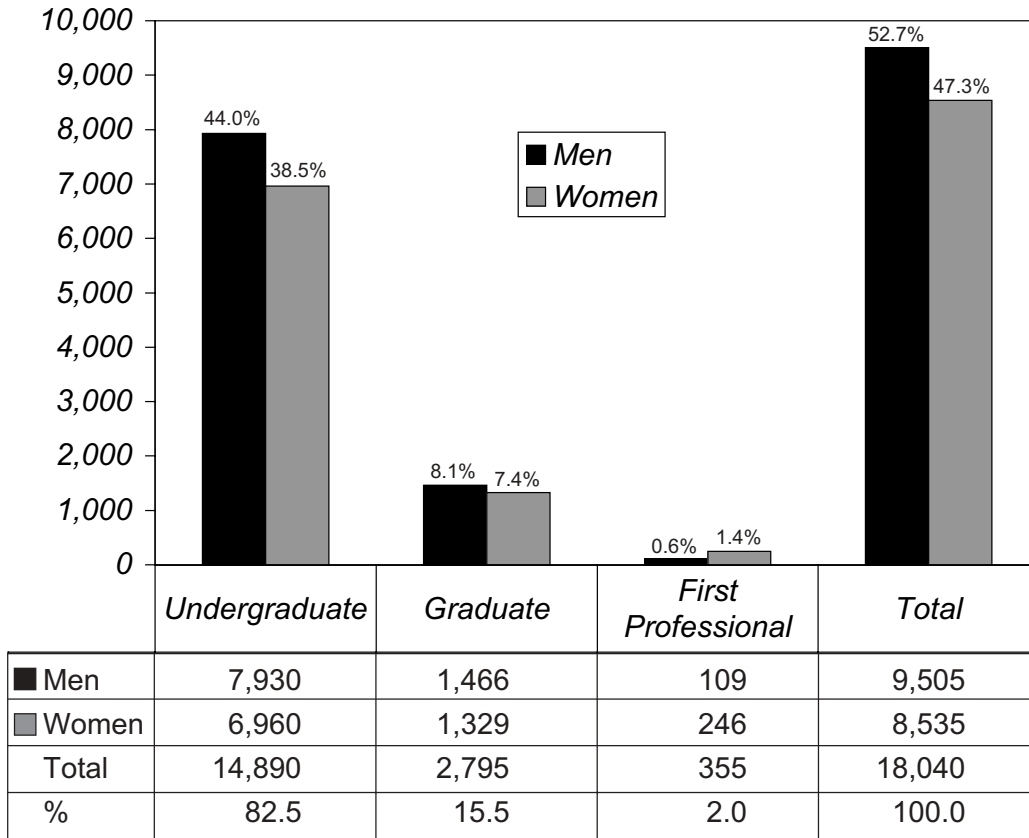

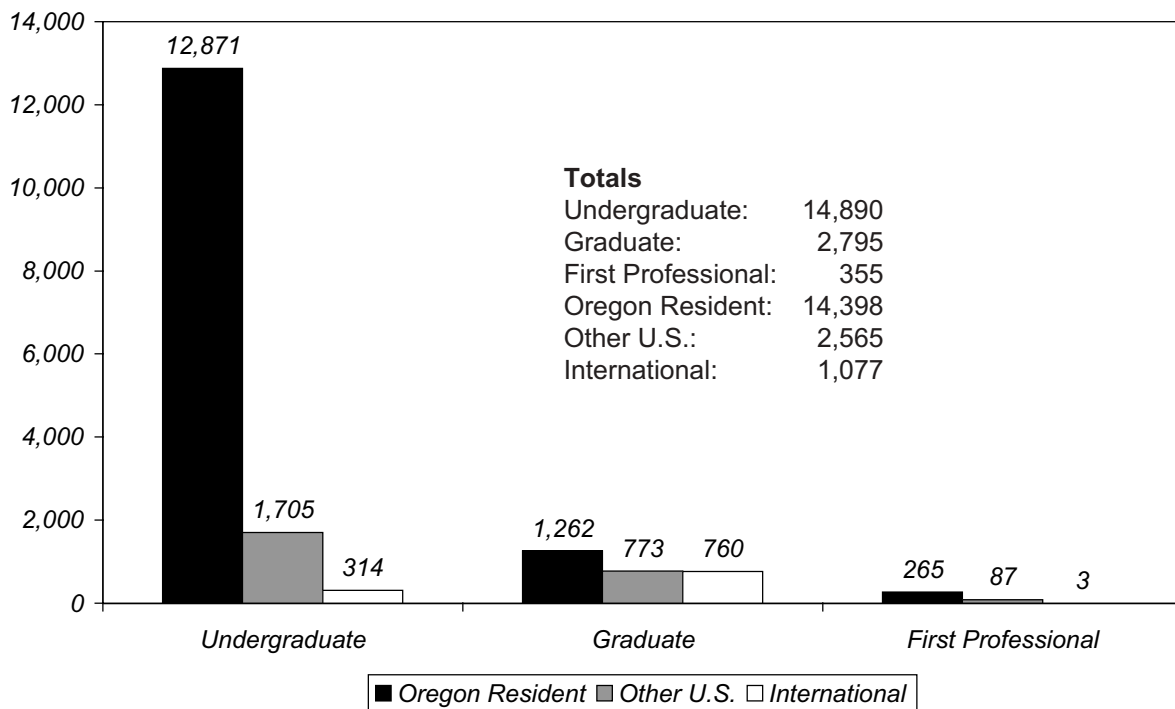

### Enrollment by Residency and Student Level

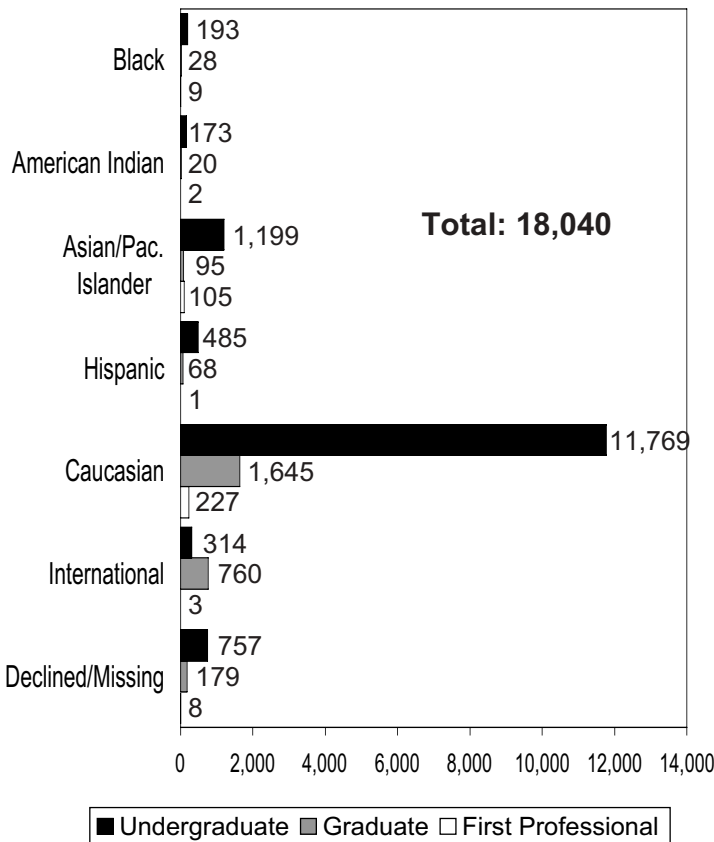

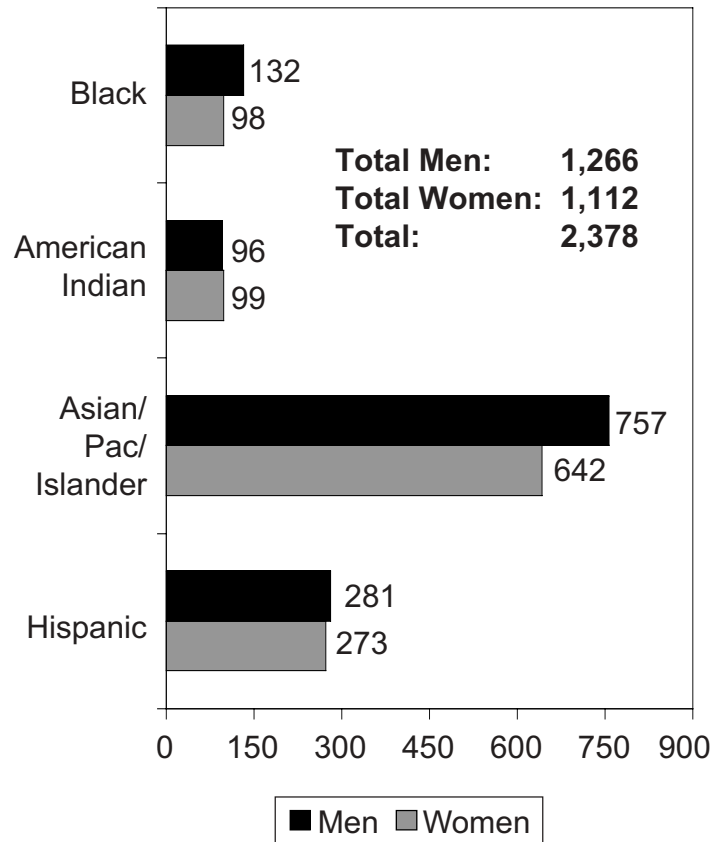
