

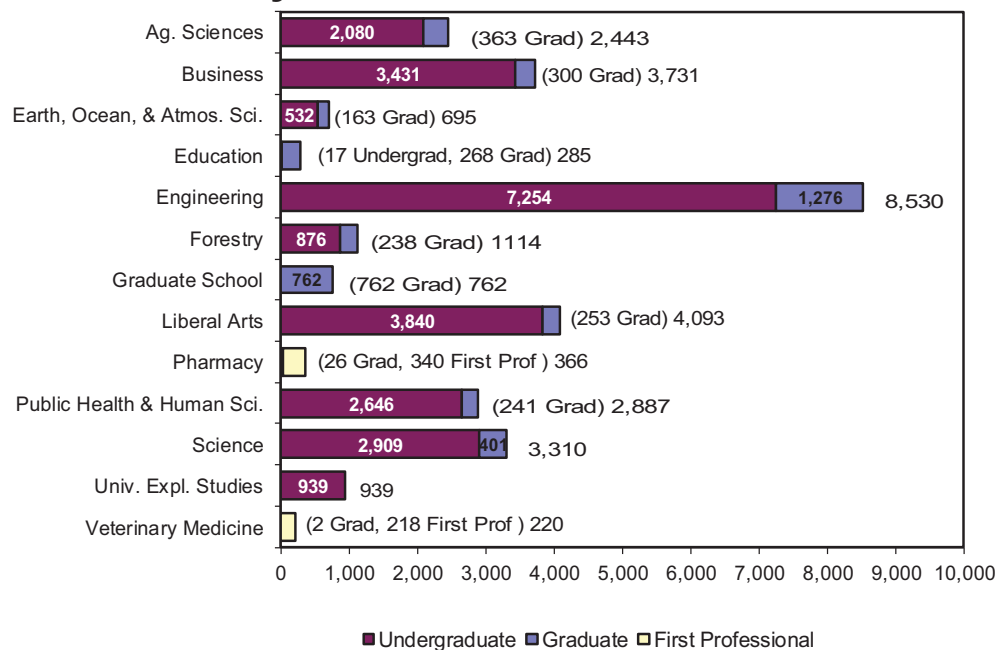

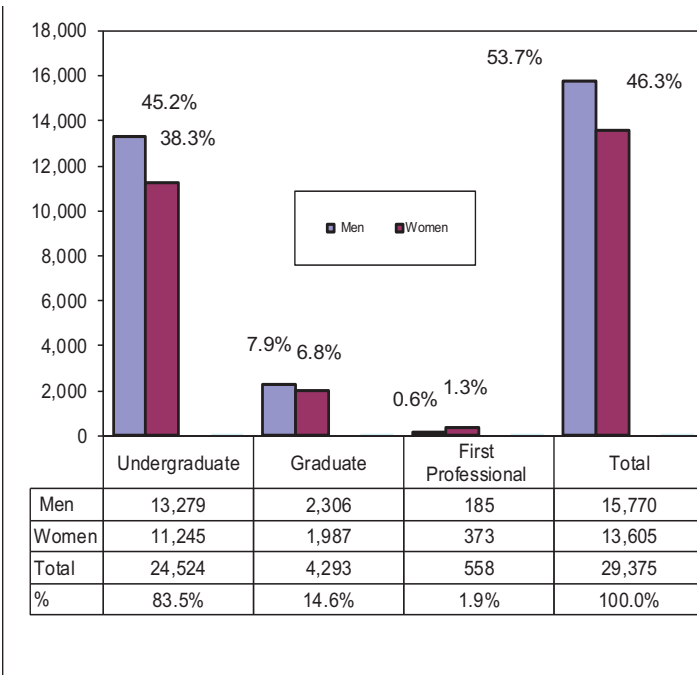

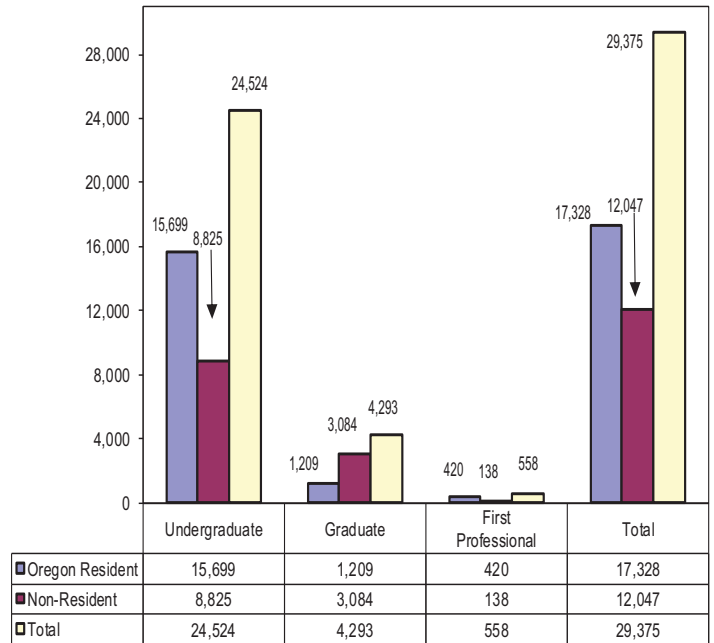

By Residency* and Student Level

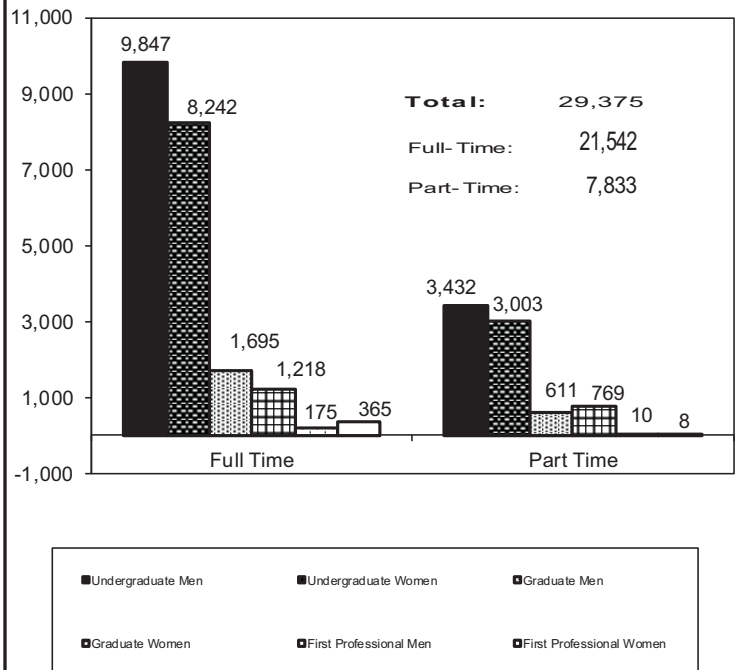

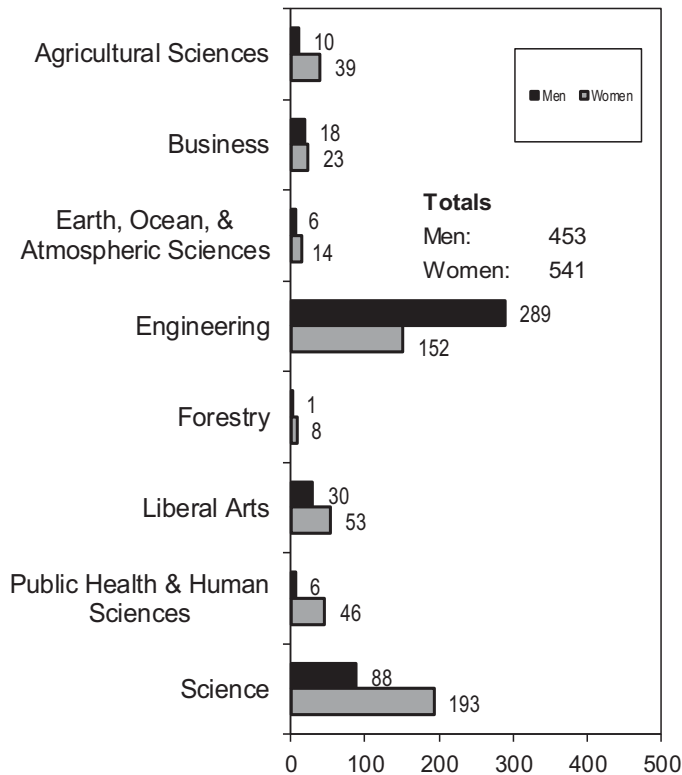

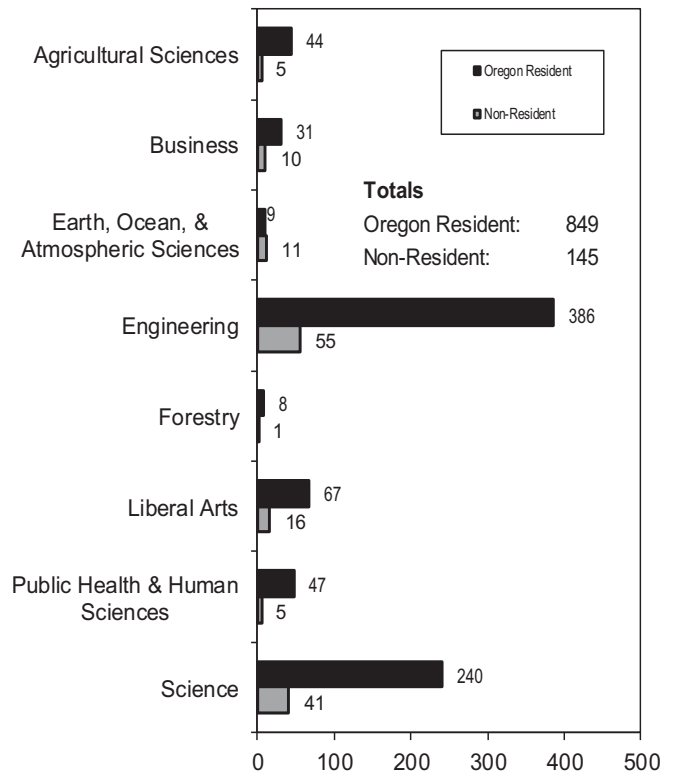

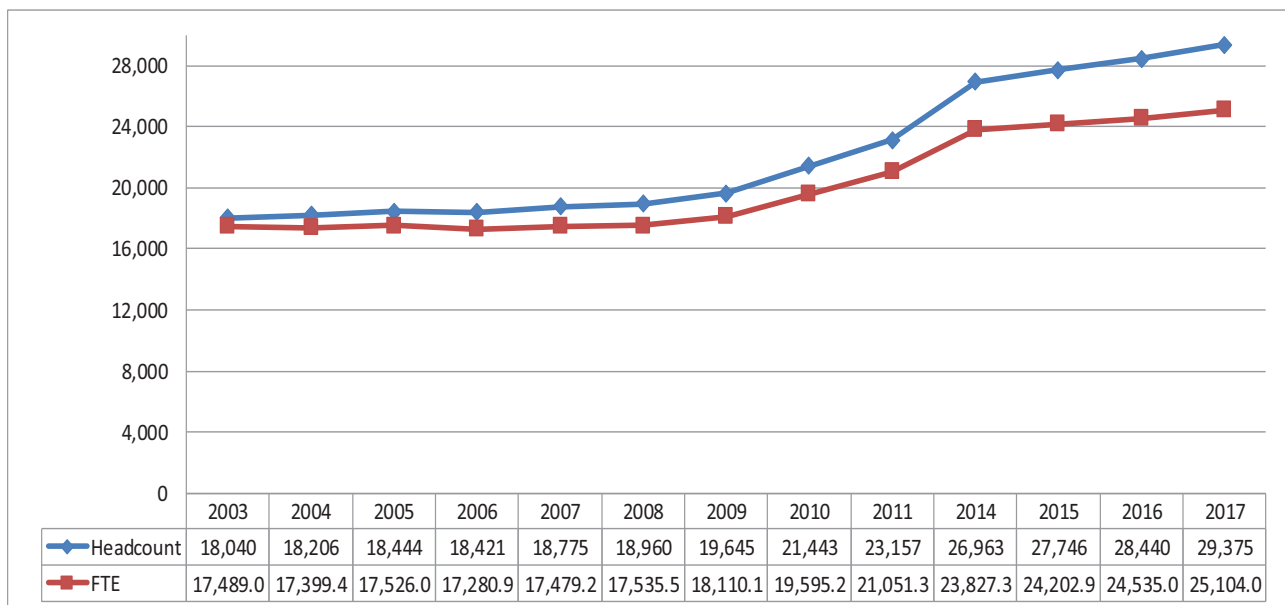

Highlights

- When Winter 2016 and Winter 2017 are compared, the total enrollment increased by 935 students, or 3.3% (from 28,440 to 29,375). At the same time, the total student FTE increased by 569.2, or 2.3% (from 24,535.0 to 25,104.2), and the student credit hours increased by 8,072, or 2.3% (from 347,693 to 355,765).
- When compared to Winter 2016, the undergraduate enrollment increased by 780 students, or 3.3% (from 23,744 to 24,524); the graduate enrollment increased by 4.1% (from 4,125 to 4,293); the first professional enrollment decreased by 2.3% (from 571 to 558).
- When compared to Winter 2016, Oregon residents increased by 0.0%; non-residents increased by 8.4%.
- International student enrollment increased by 6.3%.
- For Winter 2017, the percentage of U.S. minority students was 23.9% of the total enrollment. The number of minority students increased by 7.7% when compared to Winter 2016 (from 6,513 to 7,016).
- The College of Engineering, College of Liberal Arts, and College of Business had the largest student enrollments (8,530, 4,093, and 3,731 respectively) when compared to the other academic units.

- OSU Extended Campus had 11,964 students, an increase of 15.1% compared to Winter 2016. These students took 65,591 credits, of which 31.7% were from the College of Liberal Arts, while 17.4% were from the College of Engineering.
- During Winter 2017, a total of 1,117 students received services from OSU Cascades Campus.
- Other increases that occurred when comparing Winter 2016 and Winter 2017 are as follows:
 - Part-time students: 9.9%
 - Graduate students age 25 and older: 5.6%
 - Undergraduate students age 25 and older: 5.6%
 - First Professional students under age 25: 4.8%
 - Male students: 3.5%
 - Female students: 3.0%
 - Undergraduate students under age 25: 2.7%
 - Full-time students: 1.1%
- Other decreases that occurred when comparing Winter 2016 and Winter 2017 are as follows:
 - First Professional students 25 and older: -6.4%
 - Graduate students under age 25: -1.2%
