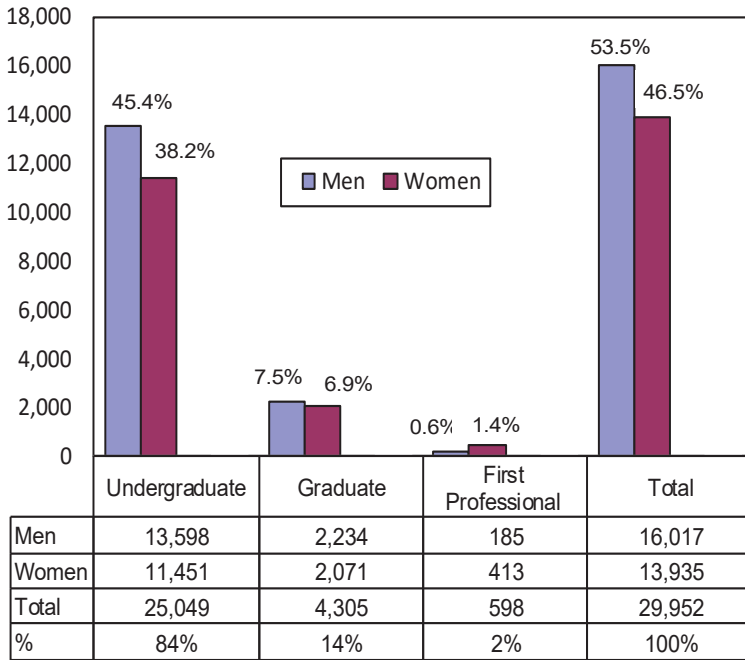

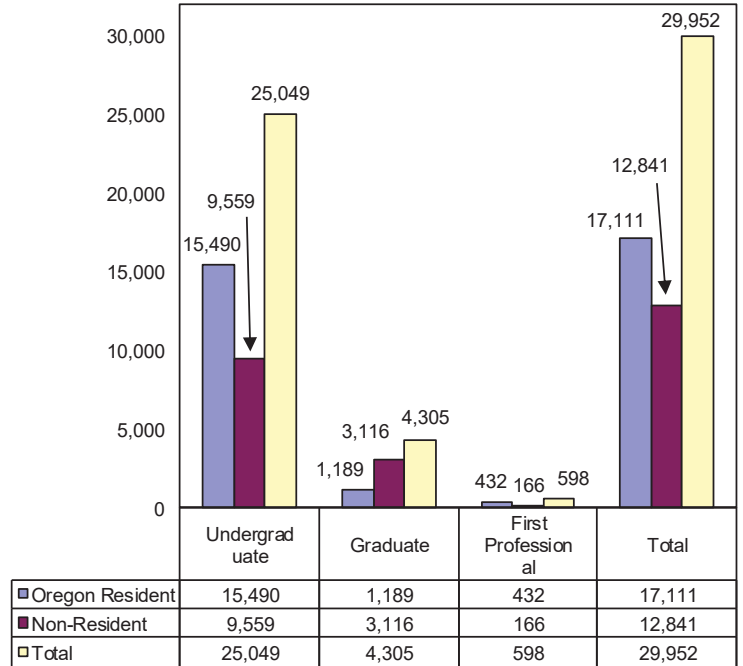

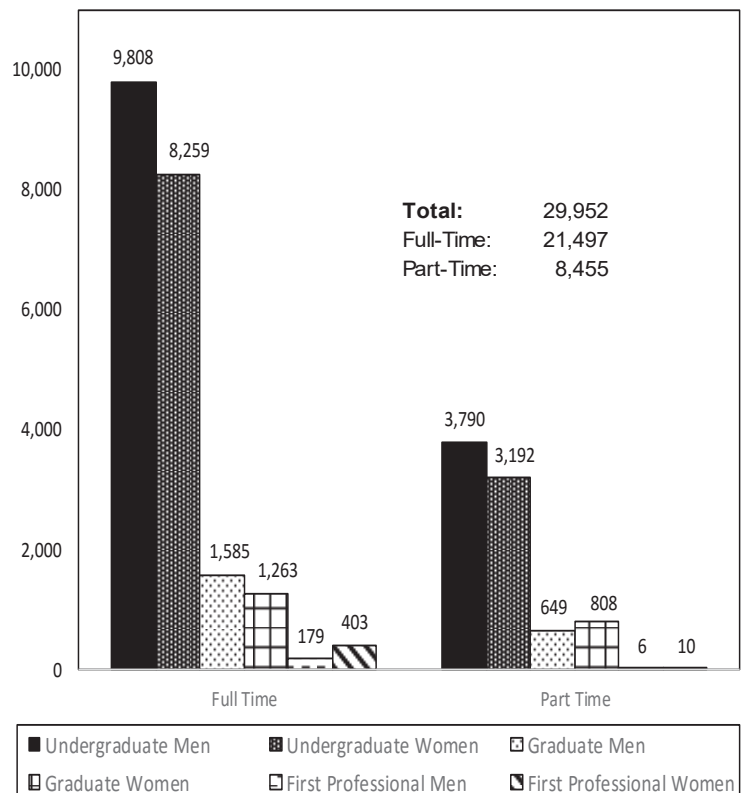

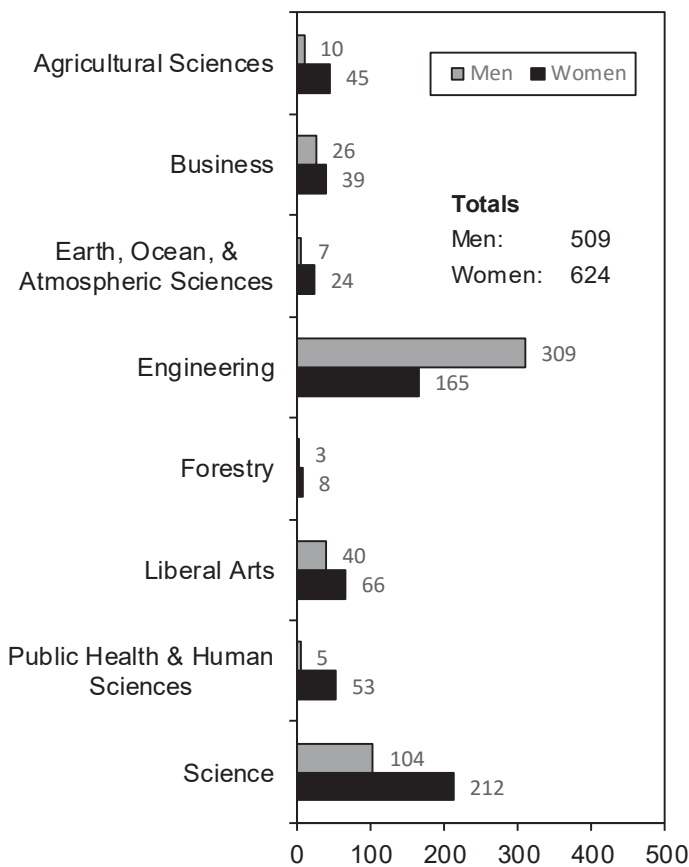

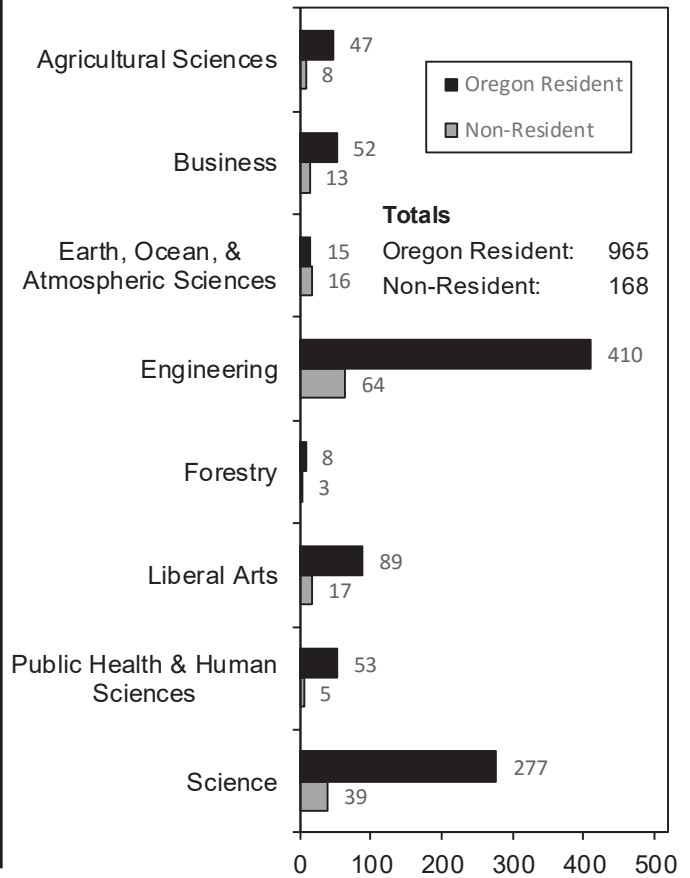

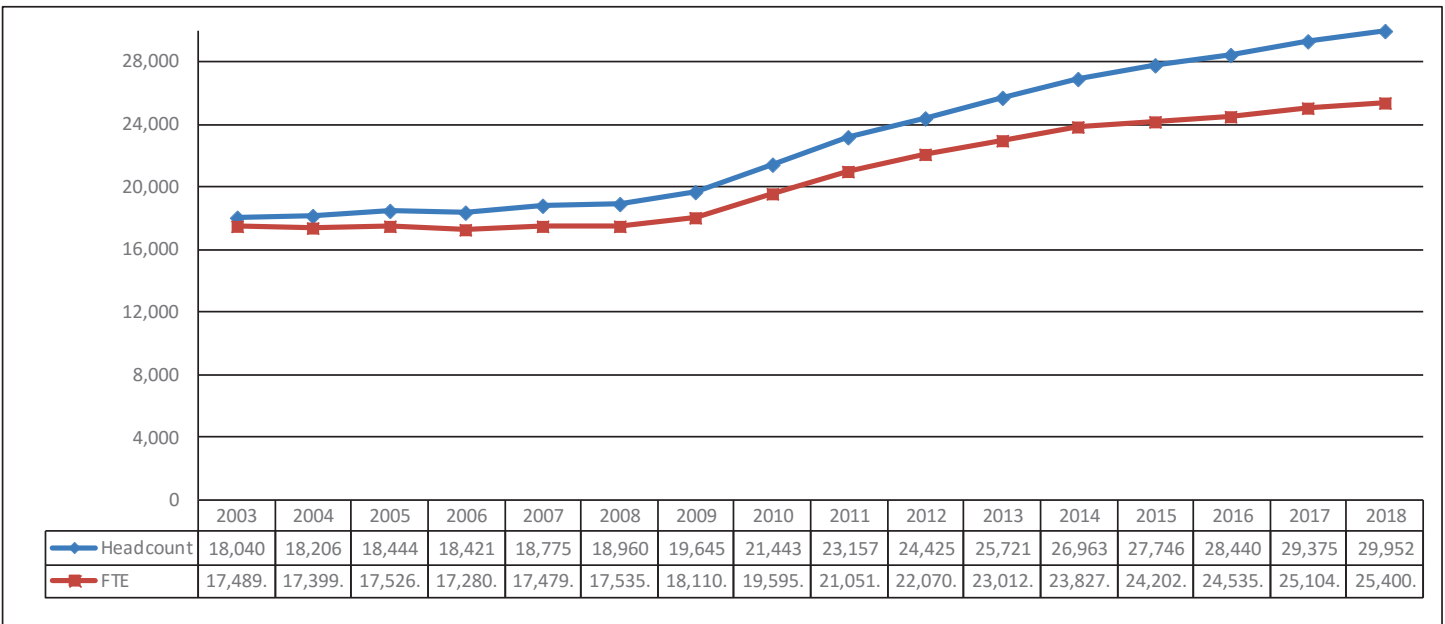

## Highlights

- When Winter 2017 and Winter 2018 are compared, the total enrollment increased by 577 students, or 2.0% (from 29,375 to 29,952). At the same time, the total student FTE increased by 296.5, or 1.2% (from 25,104.2 to 25,400.7), and the student credit hours increased by 4,363, or 1.2% (from 355,765 to 360,128).
- When compared to Winter 2017, the undergraduate enrollment increased by 525 students, or 2.1% (from 24,524 to 25,049); the graduate enrollment increased by 0.3% (from 4,293 to 4,305); the first professional enrollment increased by 7.2% (from 558 to 598).
- When compared to Winter 2017, Oregon residents decreased by 1.3%; non-residents increased by 6.6%.
- International student enrollment decreased by 2.5%.
- For Winter 2018, the percentage of U.S. minority students was 24.7% of the total enrollment. The number of minority students increased by 5.5% when compared to Winter 2017 (from 7,016 to 7,399).
- The College of Engineering, College of Liberal Arts, and College of Business had the largest student enrollments (8,590, 4,132, and 3,657 respectively) when compared to the other academic units.
- OSU Extended Campus had 13,378 students, an increase of 11.8% compared to Winter 2017. These students took 74,623 credits, of which 29.1% were from the College of Liberal Arts, while 17.0% were from the College of Engineering.
- During Winter 2018, a total of 1,060 students received services from OSU Cascades Campus.
- Other increases that occurred when comparing Winter 2017 and Winter 2018 are as follows:
  - Part-time students: 7.9%
  - Female students: 2.4%
  - Male students: 1.6%
- Other decreases that occurred when comparing Winter 2017 and Winter 2018 are as follows:
  - Full-time students -0.2%
