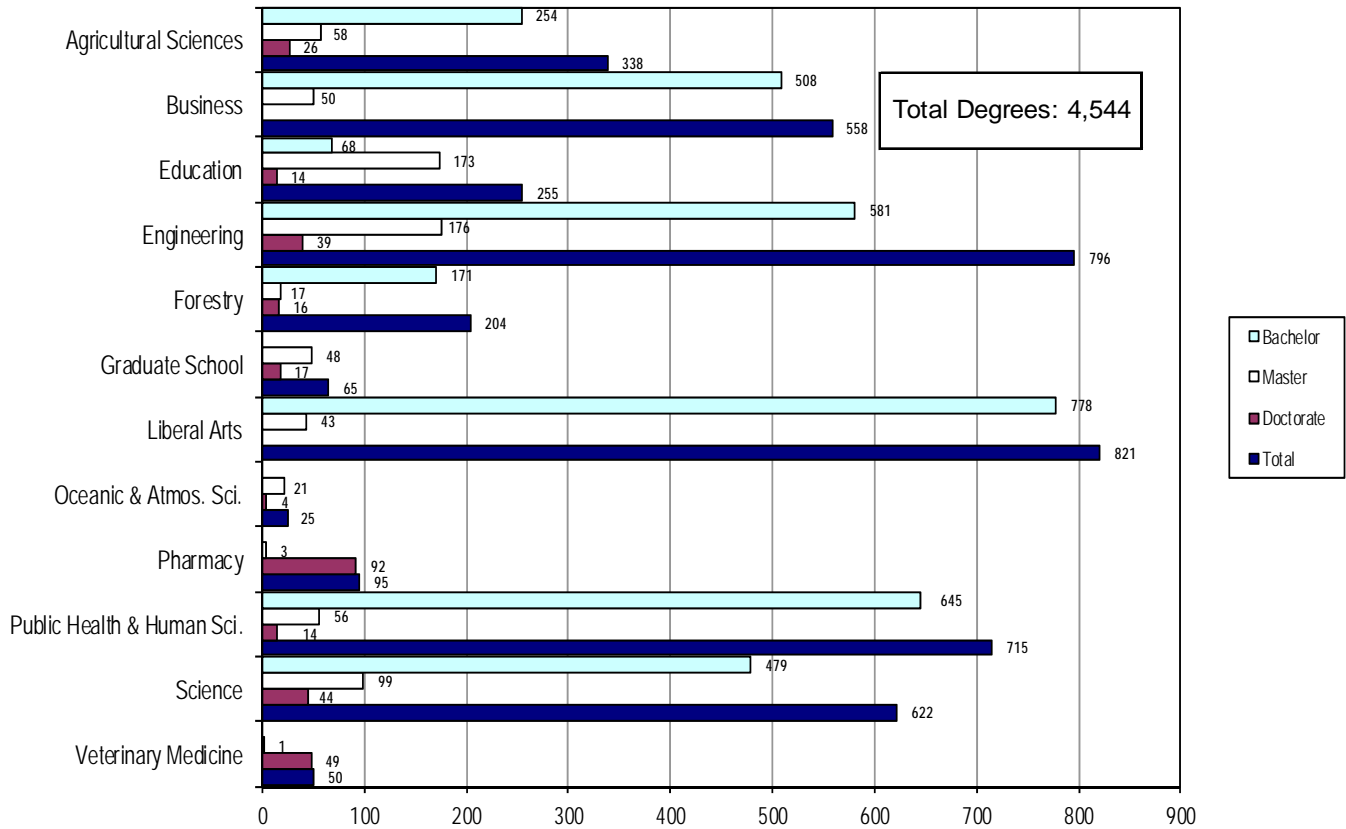

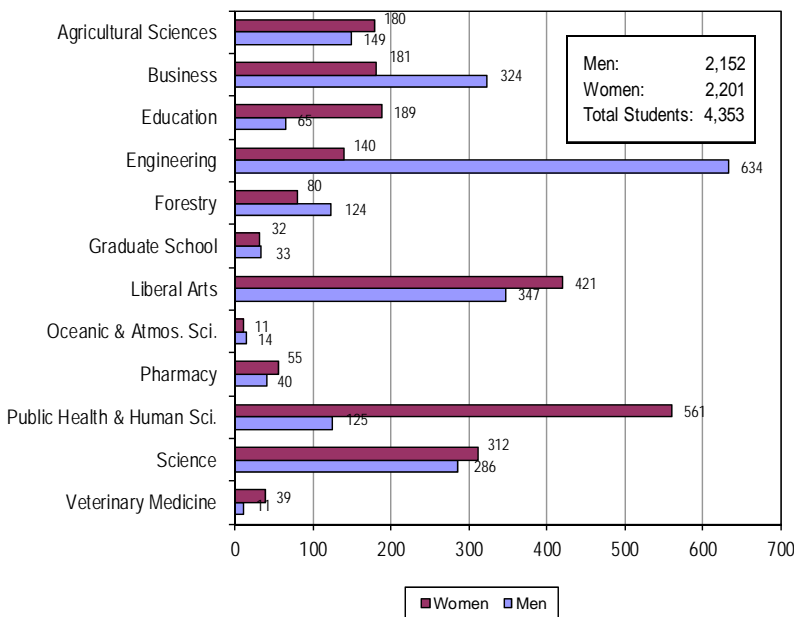
Degrees Conferred by Academic Unit and Degree Type



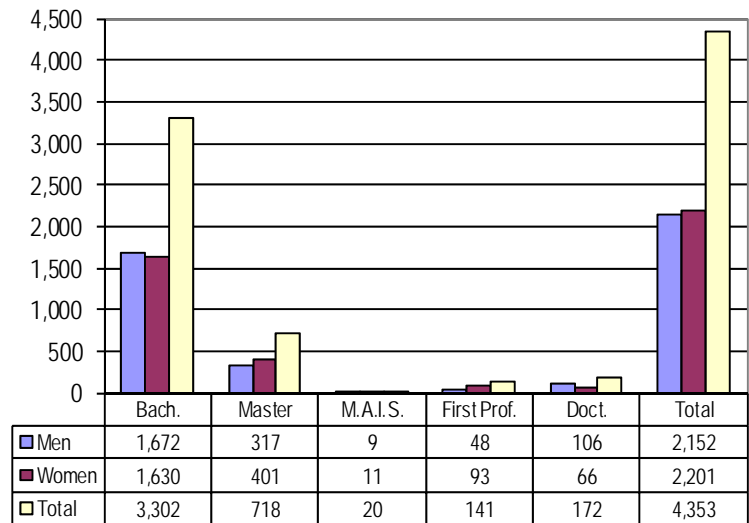

By Academic Unit and Gender



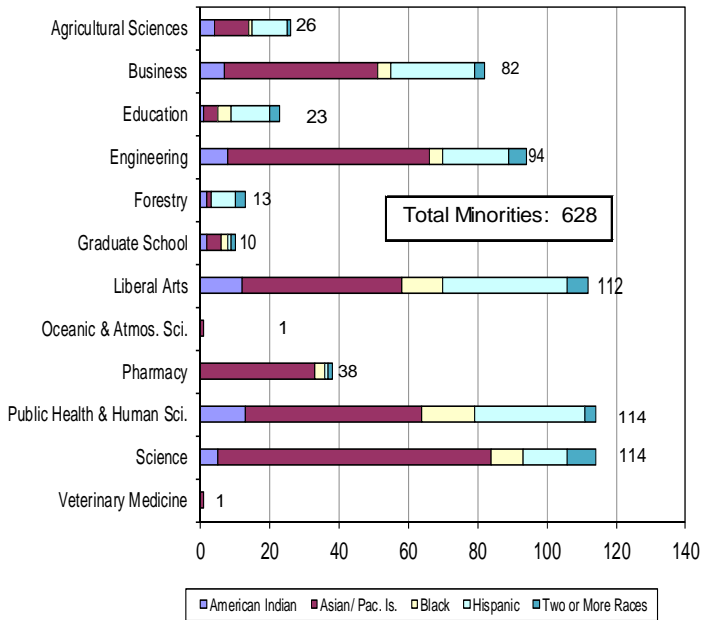
By Gender and Degree Type



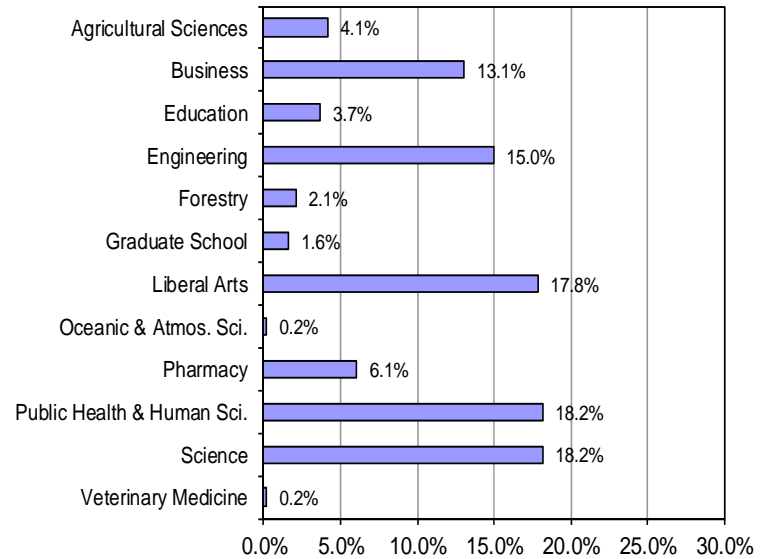

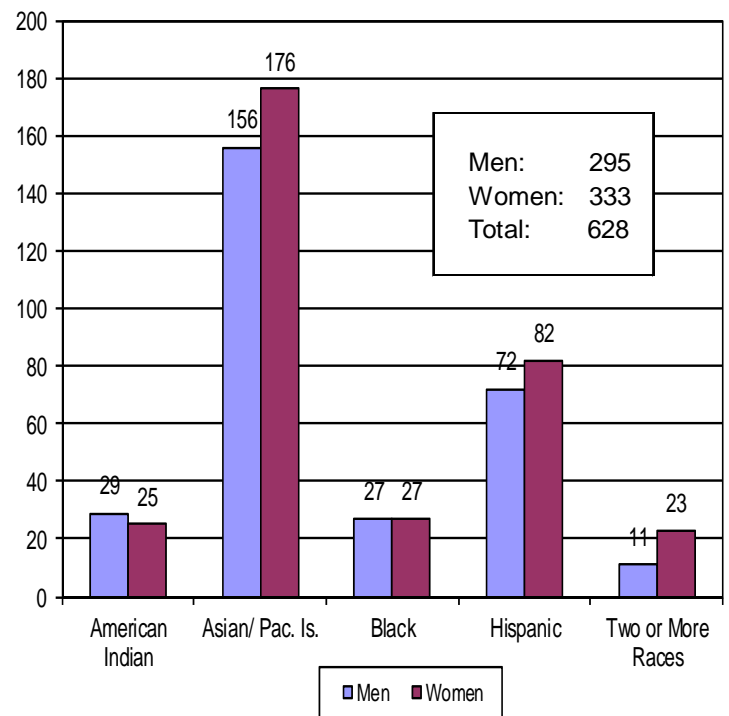

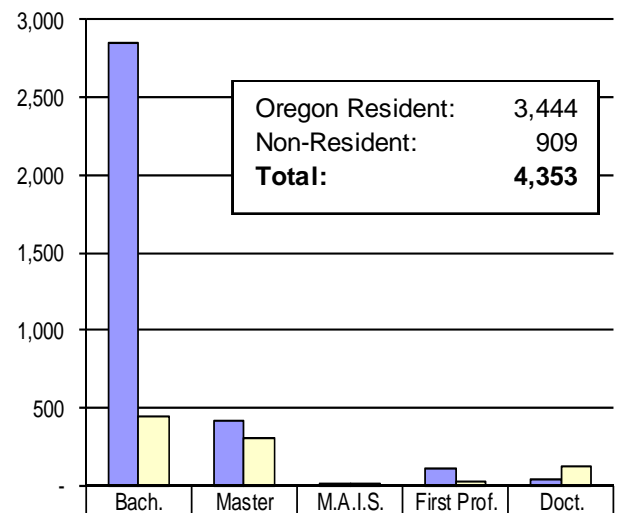

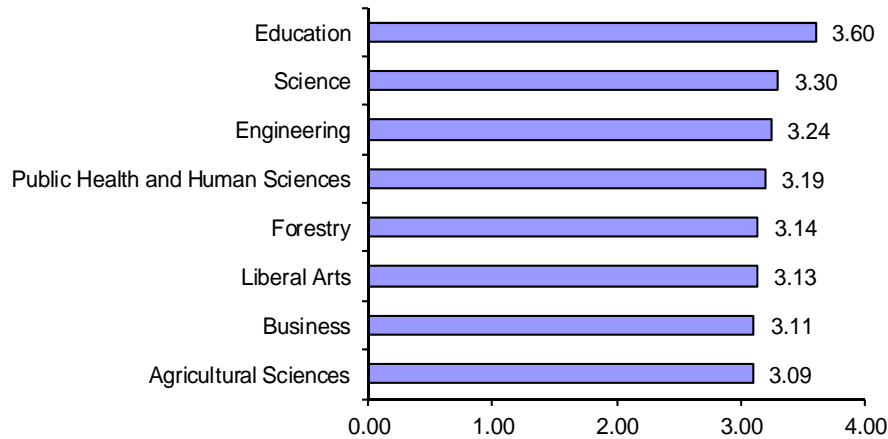

Grade Point Average of Graduates

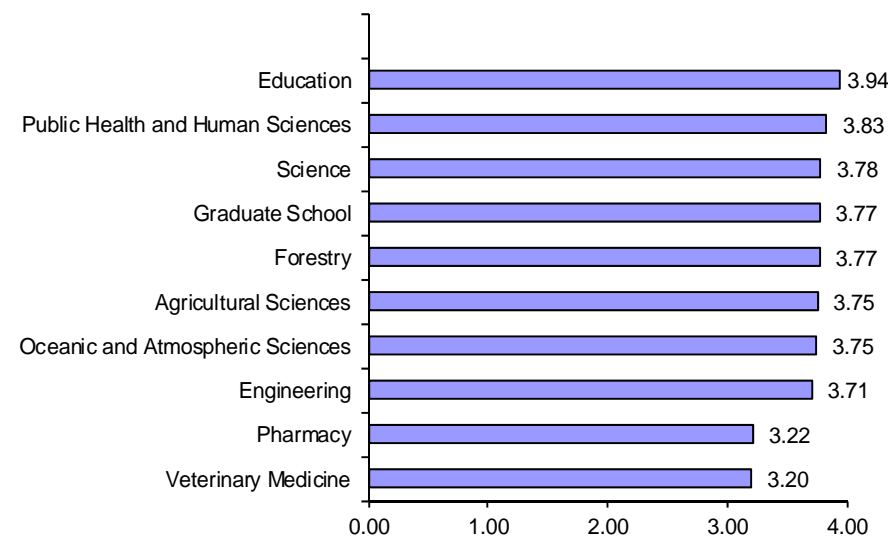

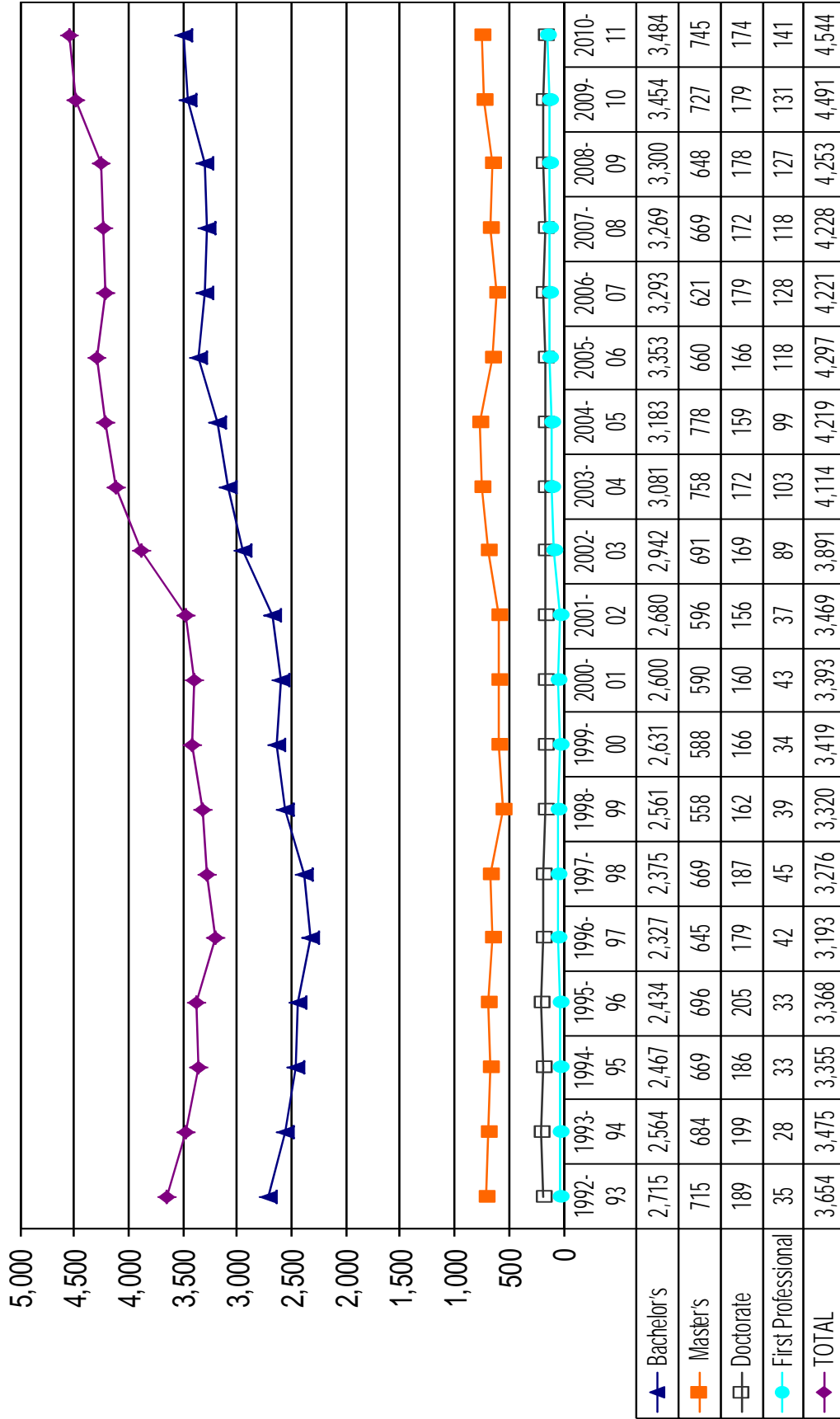
Doctorate and First Professional

Highlights

■ The number of degrees awarded during the 2010-11 academic year was 4,544. In all, OSU has awarded 209,005 degrees through 142 annual commencements.

■ Compared to 2009-10, the total number of degrees awarded increased by 1.2%. The number of Bachelor degrees increased by .9%; First Professional degrees increased by 7.6%; Masters degrees increased by 2.5%; and Doctoral degrees decreased by -2.8%.

■ 5 students received three degrees; and 181 students received two degrees.

■ The College of Liberal Arts awarded the largest number of degrees (821) when compared to the other academic units.

■ The average age for Bachelor, Master, M.A.I.S, First Professional, and Doctorate degree recipients was 25.2, 30.9, 32.7, 29.1, and 35.3, respectively.

■ The College of Science had the largest percentage of U.S. minority graduates: 18.2%.

■ The number of U.S. minority graduates was 628 or 14% of all graduates in 2010-11. More U.S. minority women (333) than men (295) earned degrees in 2010-11 at OSU.

■ 79.1% of the graduates were Oregon residents; 20.9% of the graduates were non-residents.

■ The grade point average (GPA) for students receiving Bachelor, Master, M.A.I.S, First Professional, and Doctorate degrees was 3.19, 3.73, 3.77, 3.21, and 3.78, respectively.
